



Basic Vaccination Coverage

Percent of children age 12-23 months vaccinated




Antenatal Care Coverage

Percentage of women age 15-49 who had a live birth in the 2 year before the survey (for the most recent birth)








The Uganda Demographic and Health Survey 2022 (UDHS 2022) provides data for monitoring the Health and population of Uganda. The survey is based on a nationally representative sample that provides estimates at the National level, for urban and rural areas, for each of the 14 sub regions.


Total Fertility Rate

Average number of Children per woman by UDHS survey years




Childhood Mortality

Deaths per 1000 live births for the 5 year period before survey




Life Expectancy at Birth

Average number of years a new born can expect to live




Contraceptive Use

Percentage of currently married women age 15-49 who were using any method and those using modern method of family planning.




Nutritional Status in Children

Percent of children aged 6-59 months




Teenage Child Bearing
