

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FOREWORD

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten centres of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index has been rebased from 2009/2010 to 2016/2017, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS VI) that was conducted from July 2016 to June 2017. The rebased CPI is classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP 2018) This is a shift from the COICOP 1999 that was used in the earlier series. COICOP 2018 is more detailed than the previous (1999) version, responding to the users' need for more detail, and addresses several other issues that required revision of the classification. The new COICOP of 2018 reflects the significant changes in goods and services in some areas, improved links of COICOP to other classifications, and addresses emerging statistical and policy needs of regional and international users.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten centres mentioned above and rebased indices are available from July 2017 to date at EA level.

ACRONYMS AND DEFINITIONS

COICOP: Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose, is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyse individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

CPI: Consumer Price Index - a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

CPI basket: A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

Elementary aggregate (EA): The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

Inflation: A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.

Jevons price index: An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

Laspeyres price index: The Laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

Outlet: The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue, a website etc. Also referred to as a "retail outlet", although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers

Outlier: A term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect

Price relative: A measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

Reference base: The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2016/17.

Weight: The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity or value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

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1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF UGANDA CPI FOR JULY 2024

1.1 Annual Headline Inflation





Figure 1: Annual Headline, Core, Food crops and EFU Inflation: July 2022 – July 2024.

The Annual Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Uganda for the 12 months to July 2024 is registered at 4.0 percent compared to 3.9 percent registered in the year ended June 2024 as shown in Table 1 and figure 1 below.

This is largely attributed to the Annual Core Inflation recorded at 4.0 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 3.8 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. The main driver to Annual Core Inflation was the Annual Services Inflation registered at 6.5 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 6.1 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. This was mainly due to Passenger transport services Inflation that increased to 8.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 7.0 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. Accommodation services inflation increased to 4.8 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 4.4 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. Recreation, sports and culture services inflation increased to 7.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 5.8 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. In addition, Annual Other Goods Inflation registered 2.0 percent in the year ending July 2024, same rate as recorded in the year ended June 2024. This was mainly due to the prices of Secondhand vehicles that registered minus 0.7 percent in July 2024 compared to minus 3.0 percent in June 2024. Refined oil prices registered minus 3.4 percent in July 2024 compared to minus 5.7 percent recorded in June 2024.

Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation stood at 2.0 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 0.5 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. This was mainly attributed to increase in the prices of cooking bananas by 3.6 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to minus 10.4 percent registered in June 2024. Irish potatoes prices increased by 17.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 1.6 percent registered in June 2024. Cabbage prices increased by 32.5 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 14.4 percent registered in June 2024. Dry beans prices increased to minus 5.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 14.4 percent registered in June 2024. Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation is recorded at 6.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 10.3 percent registered in the year ending July 2024. This was mainly due to Liquid energy fuels inflation recorded at 5.1 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 5.3 percent in the year ended June 2024. Specifically, Petrol prices increased by 8.8 percent in July 2024 compared to 9.0 percent in June 2024 and Diesel prices increased by 1.5 percent in July 2024 compared to 2.0 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. In addition, Solid fuels inflation increased to 13.3 percent in July 2024 compared to 21.1 percent registered in June 2024. Specifically, charcoal prices increased by 12.5 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 20.6 percent in the year ended June 2024 and firewood prices increased by 15.9 percent in the year ended June 2024 and firewood prices increased by 15.9 percent in the year ended June 2024.

1.2 Annual Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), the main drivers to the registered inflation were 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' inflation that increased to 0.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to minus 0.4 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. 'Transport' inflation increased to 6.3 percent in the year ending July 2024 from the 5.4 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' inflation increased to 7.2 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 5.8 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. 'Insurance and Financial Services' inflation registered 4.6 percent in the year ending July 2024 the same rate registered in the year ending July 2024 the same rate registered in the year ending July 2024 the same rate registered in the year ended June 2024. However, 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' inflation registered 3.8 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 6.2 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. 'Health' inflation registered 7.2 percent for the year ending July 2024 compared to 7.9 percent registered for the year ended June 2024. 'Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods' inflation registered 4.8 percent for the year ending July 2024 compared to 5.2 percent registered for the year ended June 2024. 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation registered 4.1 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 4.5 percent registered in the year ended June 2024. 'Clothing and Footwear' inflation registered 4.6 percent in the year ending July 2024 compared to 4.7 percent recorded in the year ended June 2024. 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' inflation registered 3.7 percent for the year ending July 2024 compared to 3.8 percent registered for the year ended June 2024, see Table 3 below.

1.3 Monthly Inflation.

The Monthly Headline Inflation for July 2024 recorded 0.0 percent the same rate registered for the month of June 2024, Table 4 below.

Monthly Core Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in July 2024 from the 0.3 percent rise registered in June 2024. The main driver for the rise in Core Inflation was monthly Services Inflation that recorded a 0.3 percent increase in July 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded in June 2024. In addition, monthly Other Goods Inflation registered an increase of 0.1 percent in July 2024 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in June 2024.

In addition, Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation recorded a rise of 0.1 percent in July 2024 the same rate registered in June 2024. The rise in EFU inflation was mainly due to monthly Solid fuels Inflation that increased by 1.6 percent in July 2024 from the 0.9 percent rise recorded in June 2024. Specifically, Firewood prices increased by 3.2 percent in July 2024 from the 2.4 percent rise recorded in June 2024 and Charcoal prices increased by 0.8 percent in July 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in June 2024. However, Electricity charges registered a decrease of 1.5 percent in July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024. Petrol prices decreased by 0.6 percent in July 2024 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in June 2024, Diesel prices registered a decrease of 1.3 percent in July 2024 from the 1.2 percent drop recorded in June 2024.

However, monthly Food Crops and Related Items Inflation decreased by 1.6 percent in July 2024 from the 2.5 percent drop recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to monthly Vegetables, Tubers, Plantains, Cooking Bananas and Pulses Inflation that decreased by 1.8 percent in July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Specifically, Cooking bananas prices decreased by 4.7 percent in July 2024 from the 14.5 percent drop recorded in June 2024, Onions prices decreased by 10.9 percent in July 2024 from the 6.5 percent rise recorded in June 2024 and Fresh beans prices decreased by 4.0 percent in July 2024 from the 1.6 percent drop recorded in June 2024. In addition, Mango prices decreased by 12.5 percent in July 2024 from the 19.6 percent drop recorded in June 2024 and monthly Bogoya prices decreased by 9.5 percent in July 2024 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in June 2024.


1.4 Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), monthly Recreation, Sport and Culture Inflation increased by 1.3 percent in July 2024 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in June 2024. Monthly Transport Inflation increased by 0.4 percent in July 2024 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in June 2024. Monthly Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation increased by 0.4 percent in July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024. Monthly Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods inflation increased by 0.4 percent in July 2024 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded in June 2024. Monthly Clothing and Footwear Inflation increased by 0.1 percent in July 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded in June 2024. Monthly Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Inflation increased by 0.1 percent in July 2024 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in June 2024.

However, Monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation decreased by 0.6 percent in July 2024 from the 0.8 percent drop recorded in June 2024. Monthly Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics Inflation decreased by 0.1 percent in July 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in June 2024. see Table 6 below.

1.5 Annual Headline Inflation by CPI Geographical Center




Figure 2: Annual Inflation by CPI Geographical Center for the 12 months to June 2024 and July 2024

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups revealed that Kampala High Income Group registered the highest inflation at 5.4 percent for the year ending July 2024 compared to 5.2 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly driven by Annual 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' inflation that increased to 2.4 percent in July 2024 compared to 1.3 percent registered in June 2024. In addition, Annual 'Transport' inflation increased to 7.3 percent in July 2024 compared to 6.5 percent registered in June 2024, see Figure 2 below.

The second highest Annual Inflation was registered in Fortportal Centre at 4.1 percent for the year ending July 2024 compared to 3.9 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly driven by Annual 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' inflation that increased to 6.5 percent in July 2024 compared to 2.6 percent registered in June 2024. In addition, Annual 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' inflation increased to 2.4 percent in July 2024 compared to 1.4 percent registered in June 2024.

The least Annual Inflation was registered in Mbale Centre at 1.9 percent for the year ending July 2024 compared to 1.8 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to the annual 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' inflation that registered 1.6 percent in July 2024 compared to 2.3 percent registered in June 2024. In addition, Annual 'Clothing and Footwear' inflation registered 2.0 percent in July 2024 compared to 3.2 percent registered in June 2024.

ANNEX 1: ANNUAL INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 6.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased to 0.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to minus 0.4 percent registered in June 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Food Inflation that increased to 0.1 percent in July 2024 compared to minus 0.6 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation for the 12 months to July 2024 registered 2.5 percent compared to 3.8 percent recorded in June 2024.




Figure 4: Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation Trends; July 2022 – July 2024.

Figure 4 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation from July 2022 to July 2024.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics slowed down to 3.7 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 3.8 percent recorded in June 2024. This was attributed to the Annual Tobacco Inflation registered 18.0 percent in July 2024 compared to the 18.8 percent registered in June 2024.


In addition, Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that slowed down to 2.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 2.3 percent recorded in June 2024.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Clothing and Footwear Inflation registered 4.6 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.7 percent recorded in June 2024 . This was mainly attributed to Clothing Inflation that registered 4.7 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.8 percent recorded in June 2024 .

In addition, Footwear Inflation registered 4.4 percent in July 2024 compared to 4.6 percent recorded in June 2024 .

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling, Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels Inflation registered 3.8 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 6.2 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly attributed to Annual Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that registered 7.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 11.5 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling inflation registered 2.8 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 9.8 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, Annual Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling Inflation increased to 0.4 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to minus 2.8 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 1.8 percent in July 2024 compared to 1.7 percent recorded in June 2024.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance slowed down to 4.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.5 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets Inflation that registered 3.5 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.9 percent recorded in June 2024. In addition, Annual Household textiles inflation registered 8.6 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 9.9 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Household Appliances Inflation slowed down 4.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.2 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation decreased to minus 0.7 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to July 2024 compared to July 2024 compared to July 2024 compared to 9.9 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.2 percent recorded in June 2024. 06 Health

The Health Division comprises of Medicines and Health Products, Outpatient Care Services, Inpatient Care Services and Other Health Services.

The Inflation for Health slowed down to 7.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 7.9 percent registered in June 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Medicine and Health Products Inflation that registered 3.3 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.0 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, Annual Other Health Services Inflation increased to 6.8 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.9 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Outpatient Care Services Inflation registered 7.6 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Inpatient Care Services Inflation registered 16.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024.

07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment and Passenger Transport Services.

The Inflation for Transport increased to 6.3 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.4 percent recorded in June 2024 . This was mainly attributed to Annual Passenger Transport Services Inflation that increased to 8.2 percent in July 2024 compared to 7.0 percent recorded in June 2024 . In addition, Annual Purchase of vehicles Inflation increased to 2.6 percent in July 2024 compared to 1.3 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Operation of Personal Transport Equipment inflation increased to 5.7 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.4 percent registered in June 2024.

08 Information and Communication

Information and Communication includes Information and Communication Equipment, and Information and Communication Services.

The Annual Inflation for Information and Communication registered 1.3 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. This was mainly attributed to Annual Information and Communication Equipment Inflation that increased to 0.7 percent in July 2024 compared to 0.4 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, the increase Annual Inflation for Information and Communication inflation was offset by Information and Communication Services Inflation that slowed down to 1.5 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 1.6 percent recorded in June 2024.

09 Recreation, Sport and Culture

Recreation, Sport and Culture comprises of Other Recreational Goods, Gardens and Pets, Recreational Services, Cultural Services, Newspapers, Books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

The Annual Inflation for Recreation, Sport and Culture increased to 7.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.8 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Cultural Services Inflation that increased to 8.4 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 5.7 percent recorded in June 2024. In addition, Annual Package Holidays inflation registered 11.9 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 3.4 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Recreational Services Inflation increased to 8.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 7.7 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation increased to 4.6 percent in July 2024 compared to 4.5 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, Annual Gardens and Pets inflation registered 14.6 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 17.9 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Other Recreational Goods Inflation registered 1.7 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 2.5 percent recorded in June 2024.

10 Education Services

Education Services comprises of Early Childhood and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education Not Defined by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education Services registered 12.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Early Childhood and Primary Education inflation that registered 18.3 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Post-Secondary Non-Tertiary Education inflation registered 8.4 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Post-Secondary Non-Tertiary Education inflation registered 8.4 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Secondary Education Inflation registered 9.8 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Education Not Defined by level slowed down to 0.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Tertiary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024.

11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services

Restaurants and Accommodation Services comprises of Food and Beverage Serving Services and Accommodation Services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Accommodation Services registered 4.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Food and Beverage Serving Services Inflation that slowed down to 3.8 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.0 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, this was offset by Annual Accommodation Services Inflation that increased to 4.8 percent in July 2024 compared to 4.4 percent recorded in June 2024.

12 Insurance and Financial Services

Insurance and Financial Services comprises of Insurance and Financial Services.

The Annual Insurance and Financial Services Inflation for the 12 months to July 2024 registered 4.6 percent the same rate recorded in June 2024. Annual Financial Services Inflation registered 5.0 percent in July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024.

Annual Insurance Services Inflation registered 0.4 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 0.8 percent recorded in June 2024.

13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods comprises of Personal Care, Personal Effects n.e.c, Social Protection and Other services n.e.c.

The Annual Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation for the 12 months to July 2024 decreased to 4.8 percent compared to 5.2 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Other Services n.e.c Inflation registered 5.4 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 6.8 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Personal Effects NEC Inflation registered 7.1 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 7.8 percent recorded for June 2024.

Annual Personal Care Inflation registered 3.9 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 compared to 4.0 percent recorded in June 2024. Annual Social Protection Inflation registered 12.2 percent for the 12 months to July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024.

ANNEX 2: MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages decreased by 0.6 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.8 percent drop recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to the monthly Food Inflation that decreased by 0.7 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.8 percent drop recorded in June 2024.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation recorded a rise of 0.4 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent increase recorded in June 2024 .

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise registered for the month of June 2024. This was mainly due to Alcoholic beverages Inflation that decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in June 2024.

However, Tobacco Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in June 2024.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Clothing Inflation that registered a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded in June 2024. In addition, Footwear Inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in June 2024.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels registered 0.4 percent rise for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024. This was mainly attributed to Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation that recorded 0.6 percent rise for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024. In addition, Maintenance, Repair And Security Of The Dwelling Inflation increased by 0.5 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.3 percent drop recorded in June 2024. Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation increased by 0.5 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 2024. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 same rate registered in June 2024.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance increased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded for the month of June 2024.

This was mainly due to Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation that registered a rise of 0.6 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 2.9 percent rise registered in June 2024. In addition, Household Textiles inflation increased by 0.3 percent for the Month of July 2024 from the 1.3 percent rise recorded for June 2024.

Furniture Furnishings, and Loose Carpets inflation recorded a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024. Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent drop registered in June 2024.

However, Goods and Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation registered 0.0 percent in July 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded in June 2024. Household Appliances Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.4 percent rise recorded for the month of June 2024.

06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Medicines And Health Products Inflation that recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.7 percent rise registered in June 2024.

In addition, Other Health Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.1 percent increase registered in June 2024 .

Outpatient Care Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 the same rate registered in June 2024. Inpatient care services inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 the same rate recorded for the month of June 2024.

07 Transport

Transport Inflation increased by 0.4 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded for the month of June 2024. This was mainly due to Passenger Transport Services inflation that increased by 0.9 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in June 2024. In addition, Operation of personal transport equipment inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent drop registered in June 2024.

However, Purchase of vehicles Inflation registered 0.2 percent drop for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024.

08 Information and Communication

The monthly inflation for Information and Communication registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in June 2024. This was due to Information and communication services inflation that recorded 0.1 percent drop during the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024.

However, this was offset by Information and Communication Equipment inflation that recorded an increased by 0.2 percent during the month of July 2024 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in June 2024.

09 Recreation, Sport and Culture

Monthly Recreation, Sport and Culture inflation increased by 1.3 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in June 2024. This was mainly due to Cultural Services Inflation that increased by 2.5 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in June 2024.

In addition, Newspapers, books & stationery inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded in June 2024.

Gardens and Pets Inflation increased by 0.8 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of June 2024. Recreational services Inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of June 2024. Package Holidays Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.6 percent drop recorded in June 2024.

However, Other recreational goods inflation decreased by 0.8 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.7 percent drop recorded in June 2024.

10 Education Services

Monthly Inflation for Education Services registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.6 percent rise recorded in June 2024. This was due to Early Childhood and Primary Education Inflation that registered 0.0 percent for the month July 2024 from the 2.4 percent rise recorded in June 2024. In addition, Secondary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in June 2024. Post-secondary and non-tertiary education Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.4 percent increase recorded for the month of June 2024.

Tertiary education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the the month of July 2024 the same rate recorded for the month of June 2024. Education not Defined by level inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 the same rate recorded in June 2024.

11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services

The Monthly Inflation for restaurants and accommodation services registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of June 2024. This was due to Food and beverage serving services inflation that registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.3 percent rise registered in June 2024.

Accommodation services inflation registered a drop of 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.4 percent increase recorded for the month of June 2024.

12 Insurance and Financial Services

Insurance and Financial Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 same as that recorded for the month of June 2024. Financial Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of July 2024 the same rate recorded for the month of June 2024.

However, Insurance Inflation recorded 0.4 percent drop for the month of July 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of June 2024.

13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation increased by 0.4 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded for the month of June 2024.

Personal care Inflation increased by 0.5 percent for the month of July 2024 same rate recorded for the month of June 2024.

Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded for the month of June 2024.

Other services n.e.c inflation recorded a rise of 0.2 percent for the month of July 2024 from the 1.0 percent increase registered for June 2024.

Social protection inflation recorded 0.0 percent in July 2024 same as that recorded for the month of June 2024.
