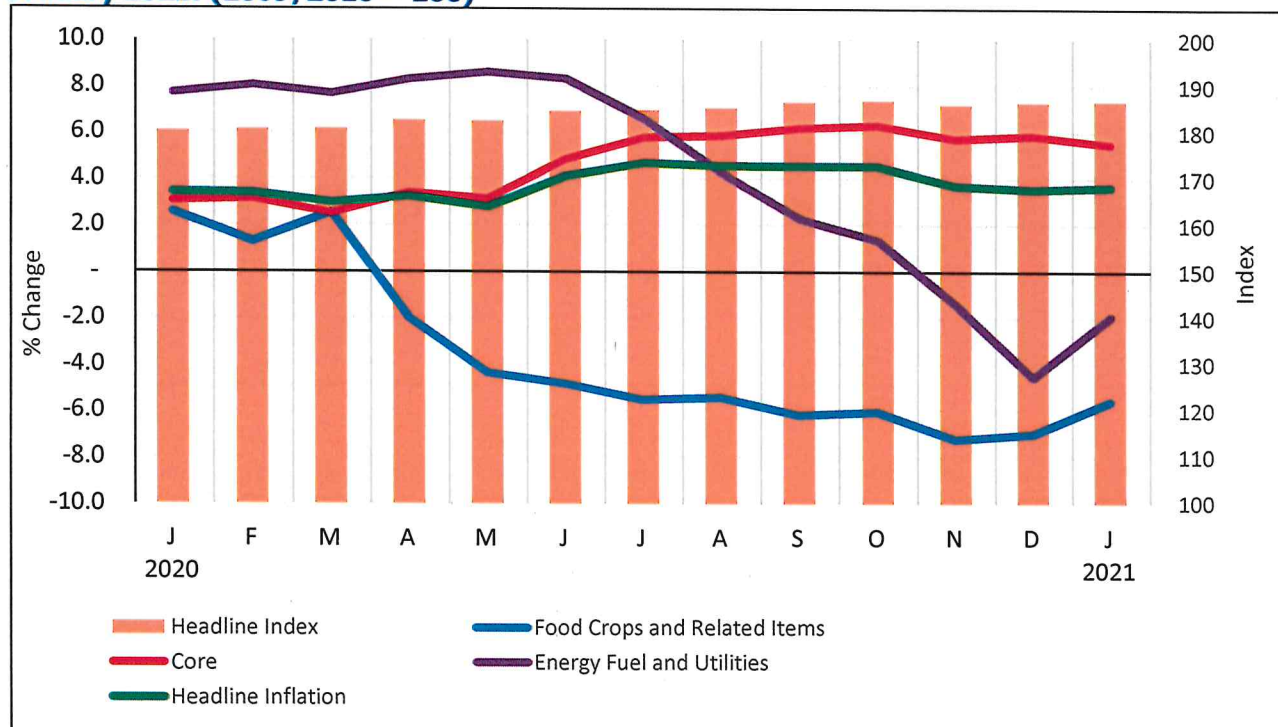
1.1 Annual Inflation

The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending January 2021 is recorded at 3.7 percent compared to the 3.6 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. The increase in Annual Headline inflation is mainly attributed to the Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation that increased to minus 1.9 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 4.6 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. The increase in Annual EFU Inflation is attributed to Solid fuels Inflation that increased to minus 2.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 8.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Specifically, Charcoal Inflation increased to minus 1.5 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 8.0 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. However, Firewood Inflation declined to minus 17.4 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 14.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020, see Table 1, 2 and 7.

The Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation increased to minus 5.6 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 7.0 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This rise was mainly driven by Annual Fruits Inflation that registered a minus 2.5 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 6.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In particular, the Annual Inflation for Bananas increased to minus 11.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to the minus 18.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. However, Annual Inflation for Vegetables recorded a minus 7.4 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 7.3 percent recorded in December 2020, see table 1.

The Annual Core Inflation for the year ending January 2021 decreased to 5.5 percent compared to the 5.9 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. The decrease in Annual Core Inflation is attributed to Services Inflation that registered 10.6 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 11.2 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Specifically, Passenger transport by road Inflation registered 61.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 64.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Other Goods Inflation registered 2.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 2.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. See Table 1 and 7. *The twelve months' series for the Headline Index and the Annual Inflation for the three major components are shown in Figure 1.*

Figure 1: Uganda Headline Index and Annual Inflation for 3 major components, January 2020–January 2021: (2009/2010 = 100)



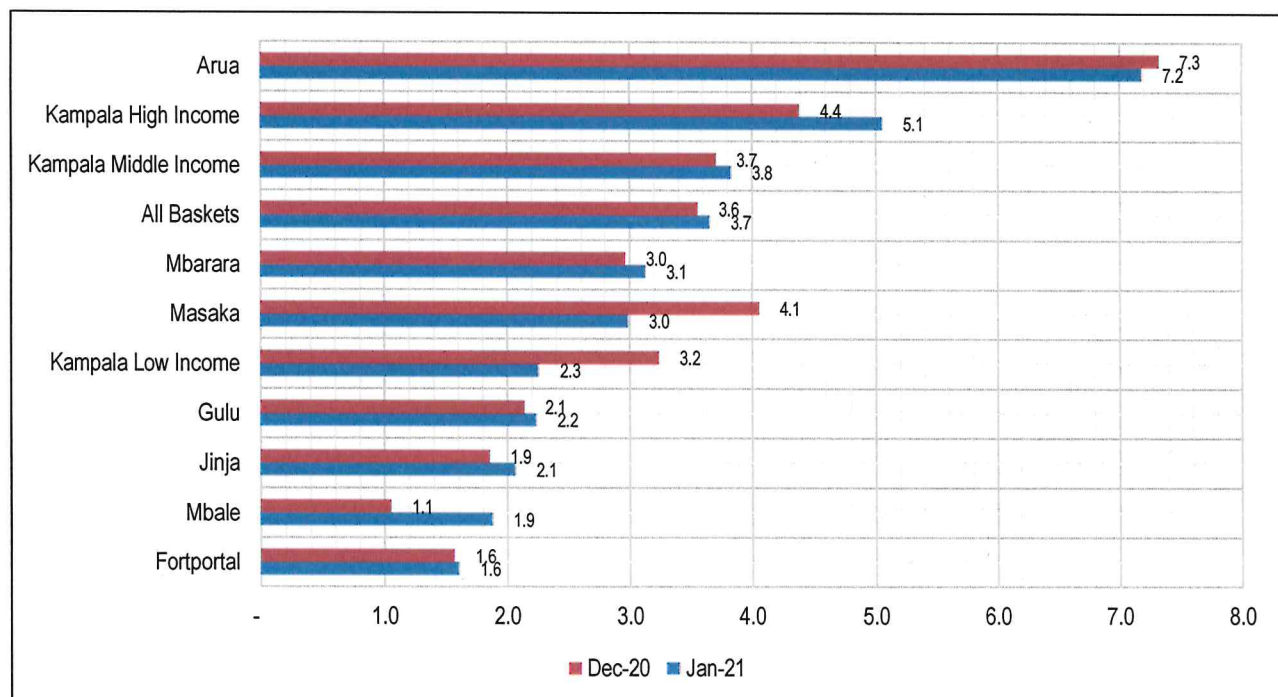
1.2 Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical areas

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups reveal that Arua registered the highest Annual Inflation of 7.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 this was lower than the 7.3 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. This was driven by Annual Transport Inflation that increased to 24.9 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 21.9 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Annual Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation increased to 10.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 9.3 percent registered for the year ended December 2020, see Table 8.

The second highest Inflation was registered in the basket of Kampala High Income that registered an Inflation of 5.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to the 4.4 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. The main driver was Annual Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that rose to minus 0.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 3.8 percent registered for the year ended December 2020, In addition, Annual Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation rose to minus 1.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 1.9 percent registered for the year ended December 2020.

The least Annual Inflation was registered in Fort Portal at 1.6 percent for the year ending January 2021 which is the same rate as that registered for the year ended December 2020. The low inflation in the Centre was due to the Annual Transport Inflation that declined to 16.9 Percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 21.5 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation declined to 9.5 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to the 11.7 percent registered for the year ended December 2020. *Annual Inflation figures for all the ten consumption baskets are shown in Figure 2 and Table 8.*

1.3 Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation for January 2021 rose by 0.2 percent compared to the 0.3 percent rise recorded in December 2020.

The rise in the Monthly Headline Inflation is attributed to Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities Inflation increased by 2.8 percent during the month of January 2021 compared to the 2.4 percent drop recorded in December 2020. The increase was due to Monthly Solid Fuels Inflation that recorded a 6.7 percent rise in January 2021 compared to 5.3 percent drop recorded for December 2020. In addition, the Monthly Kerosene Inflation registered a 0.3 percent rise during the month of January 2021 from the earlier 0.3 percent increase recorded in December 2020, see Table 1 & 2.

The Monthly Food Crops and Related Items Inflation increased by 1.1 percent for the month of January 2021 compared to the 0.2 percent drop registered in December 2020. The increase is due to Monthly Vegetables Inflation that registered 1.7 percent increase for the month of January 2021 from the 1.0 percent drop registered in December 2020, see Table 1.

The Monthly Core Inflation that registered a 0.2 percent drop in January 2021 from the 0.6 percent rise in December 2020. The drop in Monthly core Inflation was due to the monthly services Inflation that dropped by 0.9 percent in January 2021 compared to the 0.6 percent rise recorded in December 2020. However, Other goods Inflation further increased by 0.3 percent in January 2021 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded in December 2020. *The detailed Monthly Inflation figures by COICOP Division are presented in Section 2 of the explanatory notes in the annex.*

ANNEX 1: ANNUAL INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

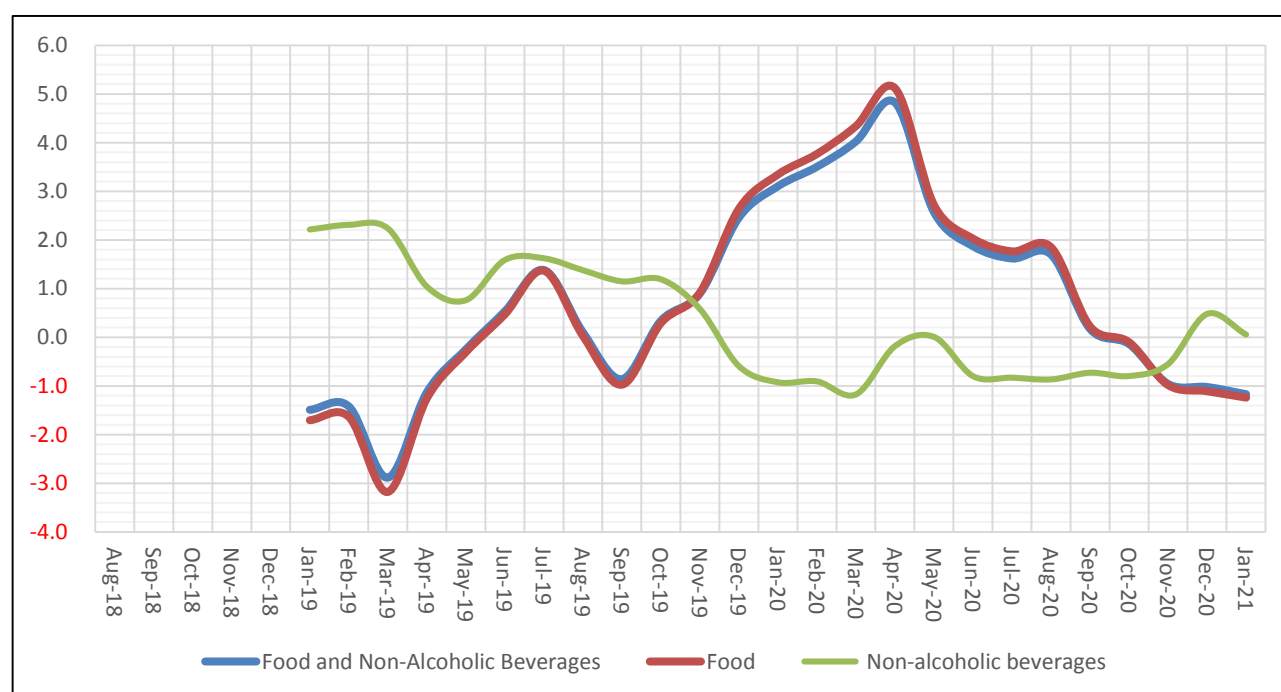
The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 3.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages registered minus 1.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 1.0 recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Annual Food Inflation that dropped to minus 1.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 1.1 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

In addition, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation decreased to 0.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.5 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. *Figure 3 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation from January 2019 to January 2021.*

Figure 1: Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation Trends; January 2019 – January 2021.



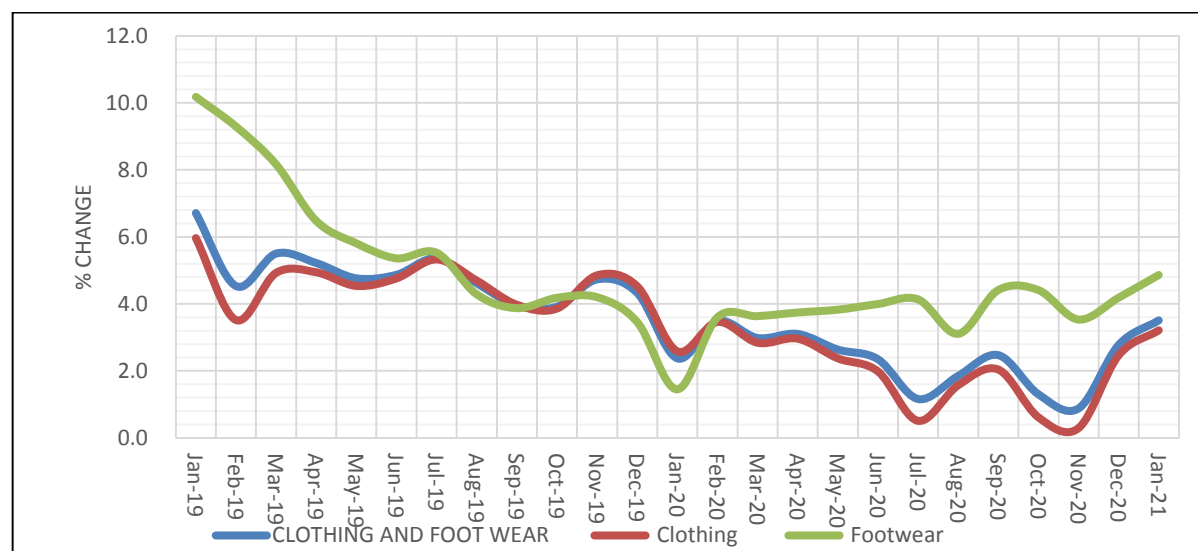
02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Annual Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics decreased to 2.9 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 3.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that decreased to 2.7 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 3.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. However, Annual Tobacco Inflation increased to 4.8 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 3.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased to 3.5 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 2.8 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Clothing Inflation that increased to 3.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 2.5 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Footwear Inflation increased to 4.9 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 4.2 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Figure 4 shows the trends of Clothing and Footwear Inflation from January 2019 to January 2021.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance & repair of the dwelling, Water Supply, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

The Annual Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels increased to minus 0.9 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 2.5 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. The increase was attributed to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that increased to minus 2.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 6.0 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Maintenance & Repair of the Dwelling Inflation increased to 2.7 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 1.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

However, Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 0.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.7 recorded for the year ended December 2020. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services relating to the dwelling Inflation recorded a minus 0.8 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared minus 0.1 recorded for the year ended December 2020.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Annual Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance decreased to 0.4 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 1.0 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. The drop was due to Household Textiles Inflation decreased to 1.6 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 2.7 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation decreased to minus 0.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation decreased to 5.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 7.1 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings decreased to minus 2.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 1.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. However, Household Appliances Inflation increased to minus 0.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 0.8 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation increased to 4.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 3.7 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

06 Health

The health Division comprises of Medical Products, Appliances & Equipment, Outpatient Services, and Hospital Services.

The Annual Health Inflation decreased to 1.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 1.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Annual Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment Inflation decreased to 0.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.5 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Annual Hospital Services Inflation decreased to 4.7 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 5.1 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

Annual Outpatient Services Inflation recorded 2.4 percent for the year ending January 2021 the same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020.

07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Transport and Personal Equipment and Transport Services.

Annual Transport Inflation decreased to 28.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 28.2 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was mainly attributed to Transport services Inflation dropped to 57.8 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 59.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment Inflation decreased to 0.0 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 0.5 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

Purchase of Vehicles Inflation that increased to 12.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 8.4 percent registered for the year ended December 2020.

08 Communication

Communication includes Postal services, Telephones and Telefax equipment and Telephone and Telefax services.

The Annual Communication Inflation decreased to 0.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 1.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Annual Telephone and Telefax Equipment Inflation that dropped to 0.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 4.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Telephone & Telefax Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the year ending January 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020. Annual Postal Services Inflation recorded 21.9 percent same as that recorded for the year ended December 2020.

09 Recreation and Culture

Recreation and Culture comprises of Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment, Recreational & Cultural services, Newspapers, books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

Annual Inflation for Recreation and Culture increased to 0.7 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.6 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation that registered 0.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 0.6 that recorded for the year ended December 2020.

However, Recreational & Cultural Services Inflation decreased to 0.7 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 1.0 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Package Holidays Inflation declined to minus 0.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.4 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation registered 1.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020.

10 Education

Education comprises of Pre-Primary and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education not definable by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education registered 0.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020. Pre-Primary and Primary Education Inflation registered 0.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020.

Secondary Education Inflation registered 0.5 percent for the year ending January 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020. Tertiary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the year ending January 2021 the same rate recorded for the year ended December 2020. However, Education not definable by level recorded 0.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.0 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

Restaurants and Hotels comprises of catering services and accommodation services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels increased to 1.5 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.7 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Catering Services Inflation that increased to 2.0 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.8 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. However, Accommodation services Inflation decreased to 0.2 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.4 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous goods and services comprises of Personal Care such as hairdressing salons and personal grooming establishments, Personal Effects such as Jewellery, clocks and watches, Insurance and Other services such as passport fees, photocopying and radio announcements.

The Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation for the year ending January 2021 increased to 1.3 percent compared to 1.1 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. This was due to Personal Care Inflation that increased to 0.9 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 0.3 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. In addition, Insurance Inflation registered minus 0.1 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to minus 0.4 recorded for the year ended December 2020.

However, Personal Effects Inflation declined to 0.6 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 4.4 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020. Other Services n.e.c Inflation registered 4.3 percent for the year ending January 2021 compared to 4.5 percent recorded for the year ended December 2020.

ANNEX 2: MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages registered an increase of 0.8 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded for December 2020. This was due to Food Inflation that recorded an increase of 0.9 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded for December 2020. Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same rate recorded for December 2020.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics registered a decrease of 0.3 percent during the month of January 2021 from the 0.5 percent drop recorded for the month of December 2020. This was mainly due to Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that registered a decrease of 0.6 percent for the month of January 2021 from the earlier 0.6 percent drop recorded for December 2020. However, Tobacco Inflation registered an increase of 1.7 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear registered an increase of 0.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 2.1 percent rise recorded for December 2020. This was due to Footwear Inflation registered an increase of 0.2 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for December 2020. In addition, Clothing Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 2.5 percent rise recorded for December 2020.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels registered an increase of 1.9 percent for the month of January 2021 from 1.5 percent drop recorded for December 2020. This was attributed to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that recorded an increase of 4.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from 3.4 percent drop recorded for the month of December 2020. In addition, Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 0.1 percent rise for the month of January 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of December 2020. Maintenance and repair of the dwelling Inflation registered an increase of 0.7 percent for the month of January 2021 from 0.4 percent drop recorded for the month of December 2020. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services relating to the dwelling Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same as that recorded for the month of December 2020.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance registered a drop of 0.5 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. This was due to Household Textiles Inflation registered a drop of 1.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. In addition, Goods and Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation registered a drop of 0.5 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation registered a drop of 1.6 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.9 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. Furniture and Furnishings, Carpets and Other Floor Coverings Inflation registered a decline of 0.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. However, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation registered an increase of 0.4 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of December 2020. Household Appliances Inflation registered an increase of 0.2 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.8 percent drop recorded for the month of December 2020.

06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 the same rate recorded for the month of December 2020. Outpatient Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 the same rate recorded for the month of December 2020. Hospital Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same as that recorded for the month of December 2020. Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 the same as that recorded for the month of December 2020.

07 Transport

Transport Inflation registered a drop of 2.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 2.3 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. This was due to Transport Services Inflation that recorded a drop of 3.8 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 2.2 percent rise recorded during the month of December 2020. In addition, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment Inflation registered a decrease of 0.7 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded during the month of December 2020. However, Purchase of Vehicles Inflation registered a rise of 0.8 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 5.0 percent increase recorded during the month of December 2020.

08 Communication

The Monthly Inflation for Communication registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same as that recorded for the month of December 2020. Telephone and Telefax Equipment Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same as that recorded for the month of December 2020. Telephone and Telefax Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of December same as that recorded for the month of December 2020. Postal services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same as that recorded for the month of December 2020.

09 Recreation and Culture

Monthly Recreation and Culture Inflation registered a rise of 0.2 percent for the month of January 2021 from 0.0 percent recorded for the month of December 2020. This was due to Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation registered that registered an increase of 0.7 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded for the month of December 2020. In addition, Newspapers, Books and Stationery Inflation registered an increase of 0.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of December 2020. However, Package Holidays Inflation registered a drop of 1.2 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded during the month of December 2020. Recreational and Cultural Services Inflation registered 0.1 percent drop for the month of January 2021 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020.

10 Education

Monthly Inflation for Education registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 same as that recorded for the month of December 2020. This was due to Pre-primary & Primary Education, Secondary Education and Tertiary Education all registering 0.0 percent for the month of December 2020. In addition, Education not defined by Level Inflation for the month of January 2021 registered an increase of 0.2 percent from 0.0 percent recorded during the month of December 2020.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

The Monthly Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels registered a rise of 0.4 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.2 percent increase recorded during the month of December 2020. This was due to Catering Services Inflation that recorded an increase of 0.5 percent for the month of January 2021 from 0.2 percent rise recorded during the month of December 2020. In addition, Accommodation Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation for the month of January 2021 registered an increase of 0.1 percent from 0.2 percent rise recorded during the month of December 2020. This was due to Personal Care Inflation that recorded a rise of 0.3 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. Insurance Inflation registered 0.0 percent during the month of January 2021 the same rate recorded for the month of December 2020. However, Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation registered a decrease of 2.7 percent during the month of January 2021 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded for the month of December 2020. Other Services n.e.c Inflation registered a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of January 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of December 2020.
