COMMENTARY

This is the 139th issue of the Key Economic Indicators, reflecting the performance of the economy during the first quarter (Jul-Sep 2025) of 2025/26 financial year.

HIGHLIGHTS

Quarter one 2025/26 Gross Domestic Product Performance

Original unadjusted estimates constant prices

Year on Year Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP) for the first quarter (Q1) of 2025/26 grew by 4.8 percent compared to the growth of 6.2 percent(revised) registered in Q1 of the previous year.

Sectoral Performance

Year on Year gross value added for the agriculture sector grew by 3.1 percent in Q1 of 2025/26 as compared to a growth of 6.3 percent(revised) in Q1 of the previous year. The growth in the agricultural sector was due to cash crop growing activities which registered growth of 7 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a growth of 16.5 percent(revised) in Q1 2024/25.

Year on Year gross value added for the industry sector grew by 6 percent in Q1 of 2025/26 compared to a growth of 5.1 percent (revised) in Q1 of the previous year. This growth was due to increase in manufacturing activities which grew by 4.8 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a growth of 6.2 percent recorded in Q1 2024/25. In addition, Construction activities grew by 11.7 percent in Q1 2025/26, compared to a growth of 9.3 percent(revised) recorded in Q1 2024/25.

The services sector Year on Year gross value added grew by 5.7 percent in Q1 of 2025/26 compared to a growth of 6 percent (revised) in Q1 of the previous year. This growth was mainly driven by increase in trade & repairs activities and transport & storage activities which grew by 6.2 percent and 7.6 percent respectively in Q1 of 2025/2026.

Seasonally adjusted estimates

Quarter on quarter GDP grew by 1.6 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to 0.8 percent (revised) decline in Q4 2024/25. In terms of sectors, agriculture declined by 0.7 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a decrease of 2.3 percent (revised) in Q4 2024/25. Industry grew by 3.6 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a growth of 0.4 percent (revised) in Q4 2024/25. Services grew by 1.5 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a decline of 1.5 percent (revised) recorded in Q4 2024/25.

Sectoral Performance

Quarter on Quarter value added in the agriculture sector declined by 0.7 percent in Q1 2025/2026 compared to a decline of 2.3 percent in Q4 of 2024/2025. The value added for the sector recorded a decrease from 9,494 billion shillings in Q4 2024/2025 to 9,423 billion shillings in Q1 2025/26. This was mainly due to a decrease in food crop growing activities.

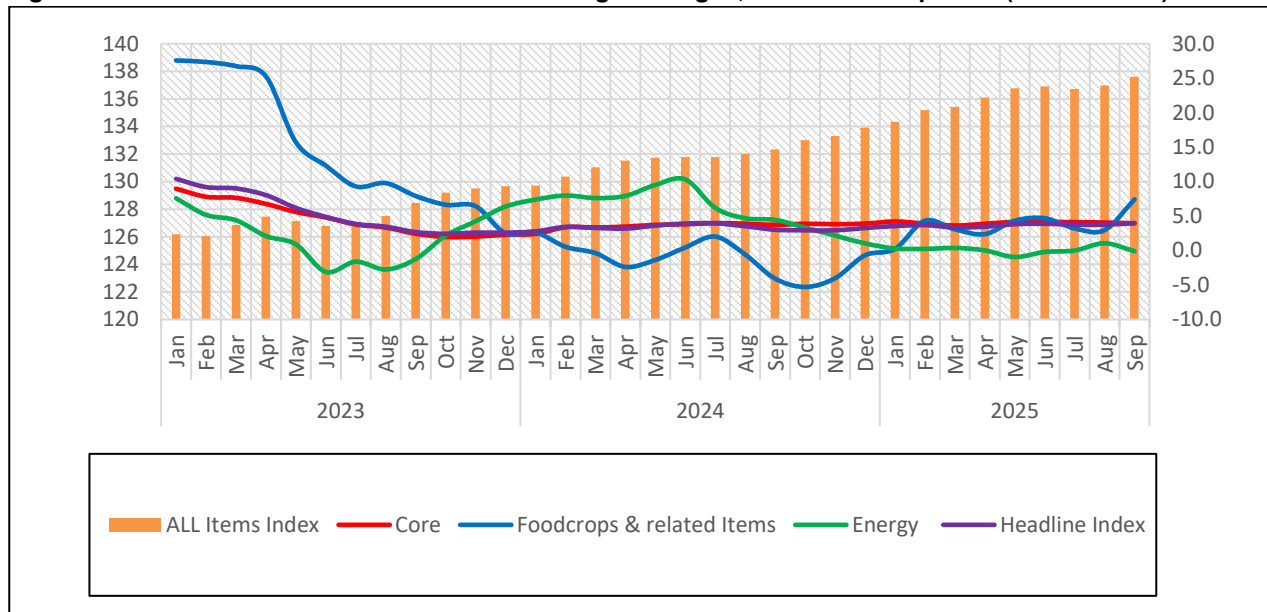
Quarter on quarter industry sector value added grew by 3.6 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a growth of 0.4 percent recorded in Q4 2024/25. Industry sector value added increased from 10,782 billion shillings in Q4 2024/25 to 11,165 billion shillings in Q1 2025/26. This was due to an increase in Mining and quarrying activities.

The value added for the services sector increased by 1.5 percent in Q1 2025/26 compared to a decline of 1.5 percent registered Q4 of 2024/25. The services sector value added increased from 17,899 billion shillings in Q4 2024/25 to 18,164 billion shillings in Q1 2025/26. This was due to a increase in trade and repairs services.

Consumer Price Index (CPI)

Four categories of Consumer Price Indices (CPI) are produced by the Bureau and they include; 1. Headline inflation (all items index), 2. Core inflation, 3. Food crops and related items index and, 4. Energy, Fuel and Utilities (EFU) inflation. Headline index includes all items in the basket. Core inflation excludes items that are so volatile to price changes like; food crops, fuel and utilities. Food crops and related items index includes all food items but excluding processed foods. EFU index includes fuel and utilities.

Figure 1: Consumer Price Index Annual Percentage Changes, Jan 2023 – Sep 2025 (2016/17=100)

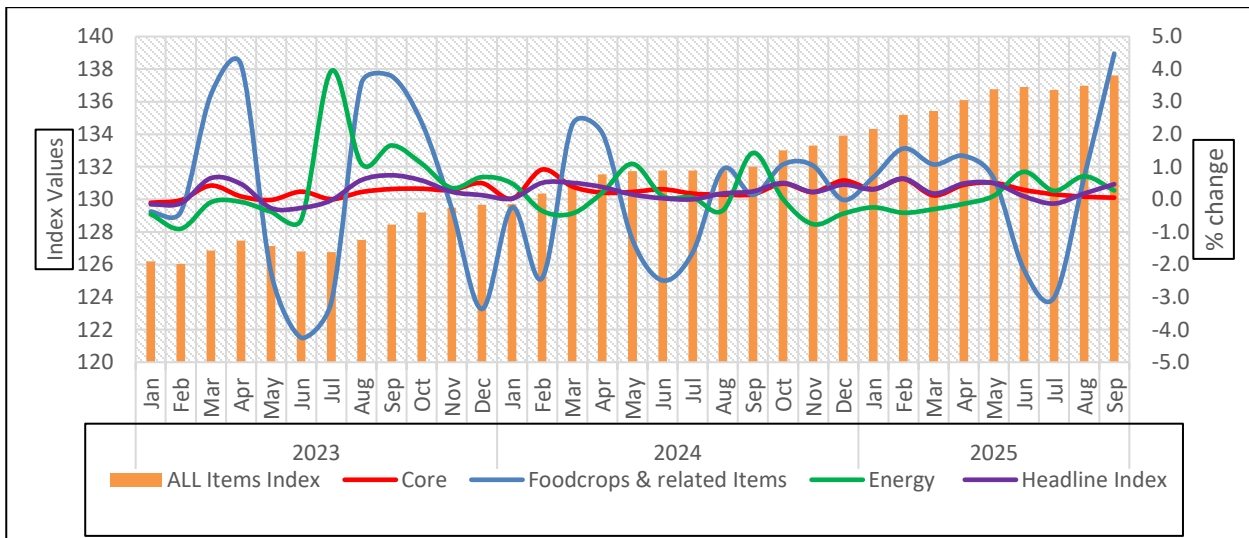


The annual headline inflation rates for the year ending July, August and September 2025 were 3.8, 3.8 and 4.0 percent respectively.

The Inflation for the 12 months ending Sep 2025 was registered at 4.0 compared to the 3.8 percent registered in the year ending August 2025. This was largely attributed to an increase in prices of commodities under core inflation that was registered at 4.0 percent in the year ending Sep 2025, compared to the 4.1 percent was registered in the year ending August 2025.

Annual core inflation rates were 3.8 ,3.8 and 4.0 percent during the months of July, August and September 2025 respectively (see table 27).

Figure 2: Consumer Price Index Monthly Percentage Changes Jan 2023 – Sep 2025 (2016/17=100)



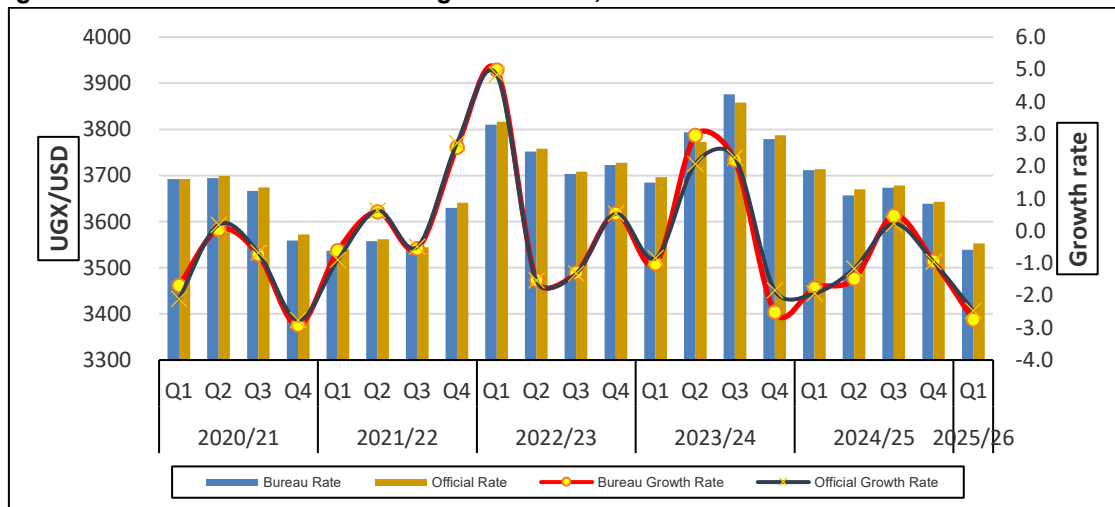
Monthly headline inflation rates for the months of July, August and September 2025 were -0.1, 0.2 and 0.5 percent respectively. The main driver for the increase in inflation was the monthly core inflation that increased by 0.2, 0.1 and 0.1 percent in the months of July, August and September respectively.

Monthly Core inflation rates for the months of July, August and September were 0.2, 0.1 and 0.1 percent respectively. Core inflation excludes food crops and related items and energy price variations.

Exchange Rate

The official mid-rate for the Uganda currency per US dollar averaged at 3,553 (UGX/ 1 USD) during the first quarter of 2025/26 from an average of 3,643 (UGX/ 1 USD) registered in the previous quarter. The changes reflect a appreciation of 2.5 percent in the value of the shilling against the US dollar.

The buying rate decreased from 3,630 shillings in Q4 2024/25 to 3,522 shillings in Q1 2025/26 showing an appreciation of 3.0 percent while the selling rate decreased from 3,648 shillings in Q4 2024/25 to 3,555 shillings in Q1 2025/26 showing an appreciation of 2.5 percent. (See table 19).

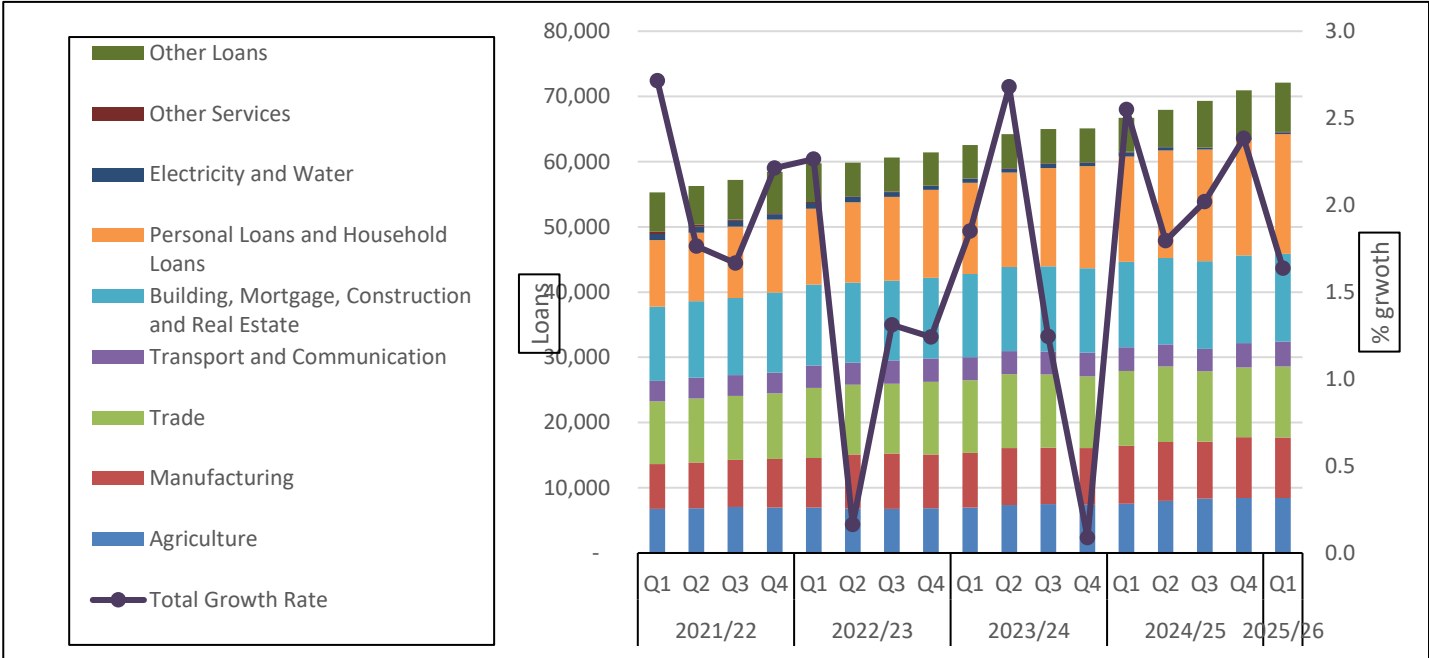
Commercial Bank Outstanding Loans

A loan is a liability provided by an entity (organization or individual) to another entity payable in a specified period or point in time at an agreed-on interest rate. Commercial banks outstanding loans are loan advances by commercial banks to the public (See figure 4).

During Q1 2025/26, total outstanding commercial bank loans and advances to the private sector increased by 1.6 percent from UGX 70.9 trillion in Q4 2024/25 to UGX 72.1 trillion in Q1 2025/26. Personal Loans and Household Loans took the biggest share of the loans and advances with 25.4 percent (18.4 trillion shillings) in Q1 2025/26.

Loans to building, mortgage, construction and real estate took the second biggest share decreased by 0.3 percent from UGX 13.5 trillion in Q4 2024/25 to UGX 13.4 trillion in Q1 2025/26. Manufacturing, which had registered growth in the previous quarter, registered a decline in Q1 2025/26. While trade which registered a decline in Q4 2024/25, registered a growth during in Q1 2025/26. 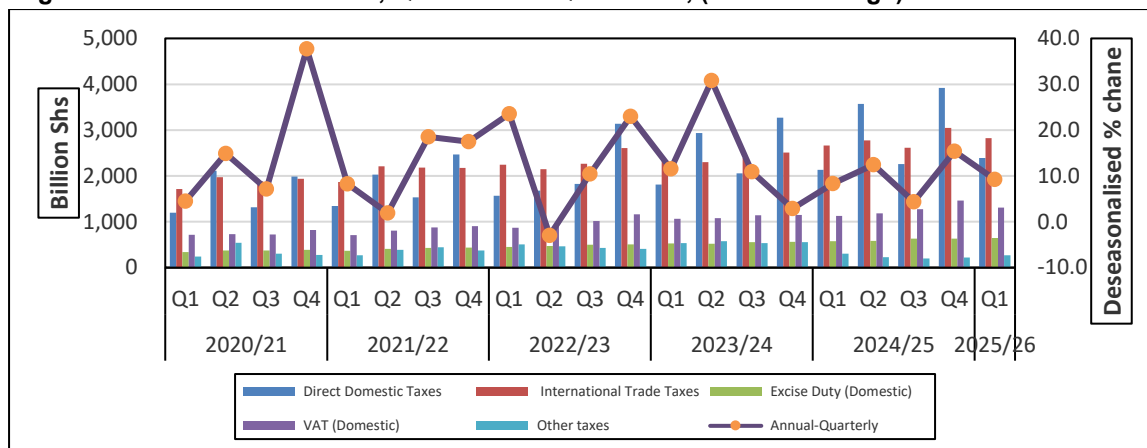


Tax Revenue collections

Total revenue collections during Q1 2025/26 (comparing similar quarters) increased by 9.2 percent from 6,811 billion shillings in Q1 2024/25 to 7,440 billion shillings in Q1 2025/26.

On comparing consecutive quarters, during Q1 2025/26 revenue collections decreased by 19.9 percent from an increase of 33.0 percent in Q4 2024/25 that is from 9,288 billion shillings in Q4 to 7,440 billion shillings in Q1 2025/26. (See table 15).

ii) Other Revenue includes Non-Tax Revenue such as Licenses and Fees.

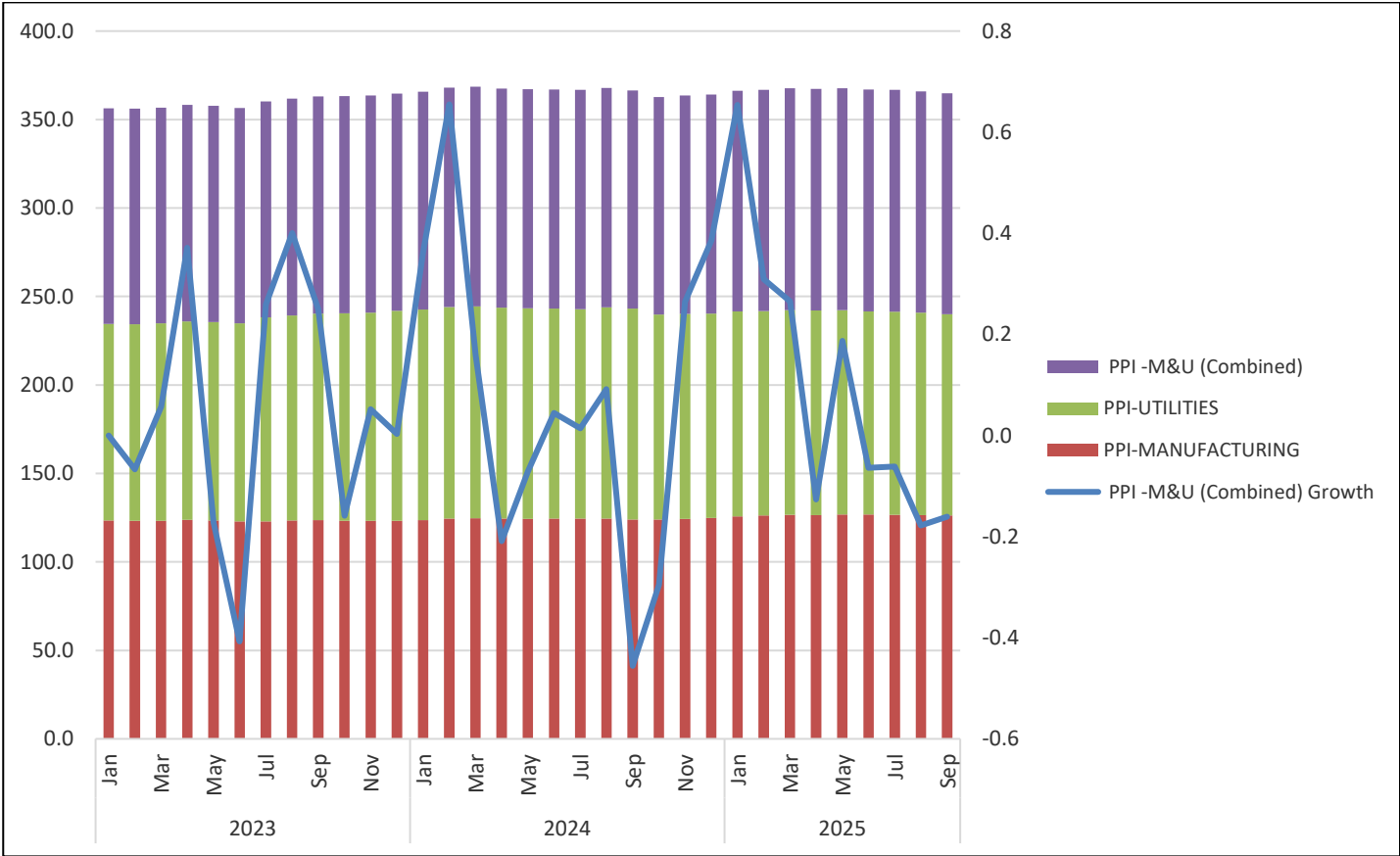
Producer Price Indices (PPI) – Manufacturing & Utilities

The Producer Price Index (PPI) for Manufacturing and Utilities has been rebased from the previous base period of 2009/10 to a new base period of 2016/17. This revised index has been expanded to include utilities such as water and electricity. The weights are derived from the 2016/17 Supply and Use Table (SUT).

The PPI for Manufacturing and Utilities encompasses three sectors based on the ISIC Rev. 4 framework: the Manufacturing Sector (C), Electricity Generation (D), and Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, and Remediation Activities (E).

The PPI M&U Monthly Headline Inflation for Sep 2025 decreased by 0.2 percent from the 0.2 percent decrease registered for the month of August 2025. This was mainly attributed to the monthly inflation for Manufacturing sector which decreased by 0.1 percent in September 2025 from 0.2 percent registered in August 2025. The monthly inflation for Utilities sector for the months of July, August and September were 0.0, -0.3 and -0.7 percent respectively.

Figure 6: Producer Price Index for Manufacturing (combined), Jan 2023- Sep 2025



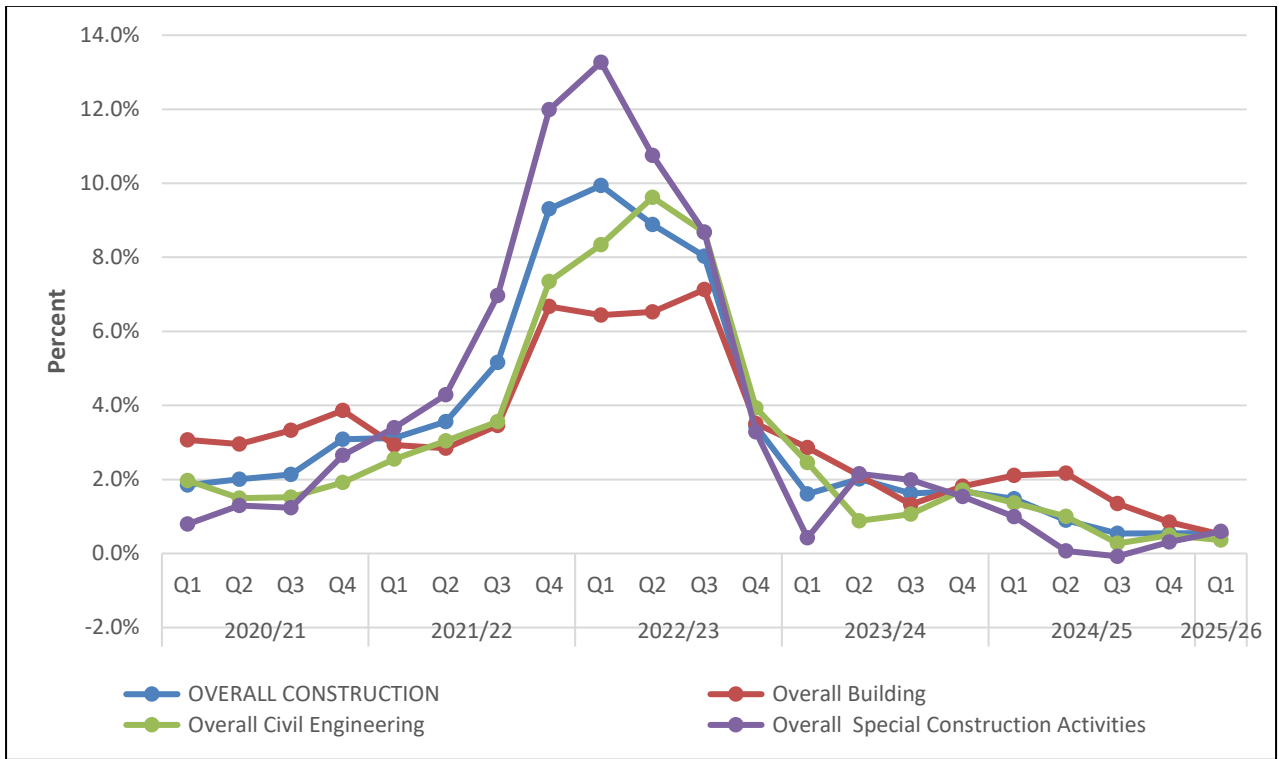
Construction Input Price Index (CIPI)

Construction Input Price Index (CIPI) is an indicator of the average cost movement over time of a fixed basket of representative goods and services that are inputs in the construction industry. It covers material prices, wage rates and equipment hire rates.

Comparing similar quarters, the overall sector index increased by 0.6 percent during Q1 2025/26 following a 1.5 percent growth registered in Q1 2024/25.

On comparing consecutive quarters, civil works registered an increase of 0.4 percent during Q1 2025/26 from a growth of 0.5 percent in the previous quarter while all building index increased by 0.5 percent during Q1 2025/26 compared to a growth of 0.8 percent during Q1 2025/26. (See table 22).

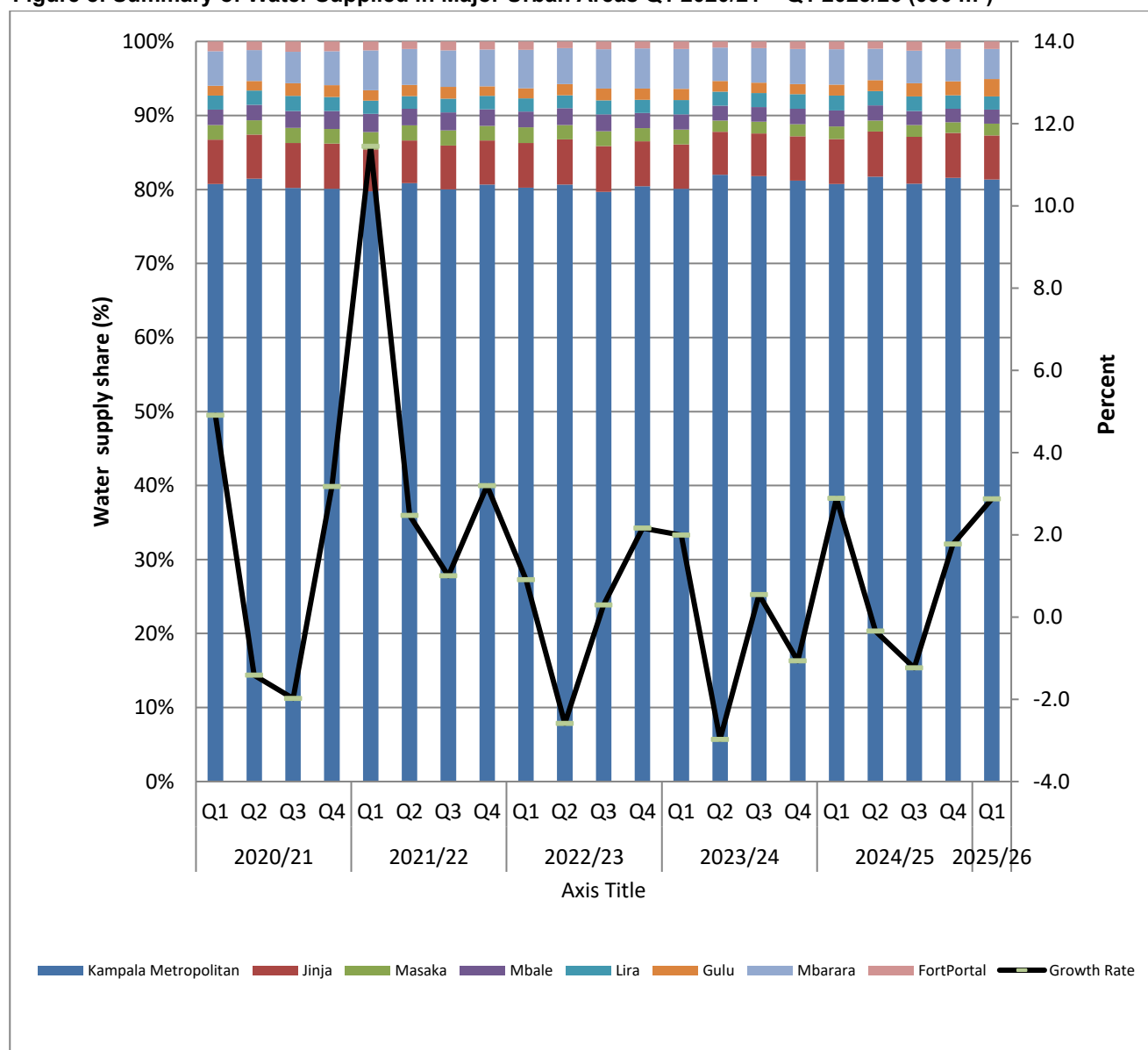
Figure 7: Construction Input Price Index, Annual percentage changes, Q1 2020/21 – Q1 2025/26



Water Supplied

Water supplied by National Water and Sewerage Corporation (NW&SC) in major urban centres/municipalities increased by 2.9 percent in Q1 2025/26 from an earlier increase of 1.8 percent registered in Q4 2024/25. In volume terms, water supplied increased from 32.6 million m³ in Q4 2024/25 to 33.5 million m³ in Q1 2025/26 (See table 41 and figure 8).
