

SEX RATIO




Sex Ratio is the proportion of males to females in a population expressed by the number of males per hundred females.

Sex ratio for Kampala Capital city is 80, this implies there are more females than males except in the Rubaga Division.

AGE DEPENDENCY RATIO

Age dependency ratio is a measure of the number of dependents age zero to 14 and over the age of 65, compared with the total population aged 15 to 64.




The age dependency ratio for Kampala Capital city is 64. It is highest in Rubaga and lowest in Nakawa division.



PHYSICAL VIOLENCE

Prevalence of Physical Violence among women age 10-59 years in the 12 months prior to the survey





Physical violence among women and girls age 10-59 is highest in Rubaga division at 26% and lowest in Kawempe division at 14%.



SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Prevalence of Sexual Violence among women age 10-59 years in the 12 months prior to the survey



Sexual violence among women and girls age 10-59 is highest in Central division at 32% and lowest in Kawempe Division at 6%.

Percentage of girls age 12-17 who are currently married



Child marriages among girls age 12-17 is highest in Kawempe Division at 3% and very minimal in the rest of the divisions at less than 1%.

Percentage of Sexually active women and girls age 10-59 who are currently using contraceptives




Contraceptive use among sexually active women and girls age 10-59 is highest in Makindye Division at 49% and lowest in Rubaga Division at 34%.

Prevalence of physical, Sexual or Psychological violence among ever-married women and girls aged 15-59 in the previous 12 months in Kampala capital city generally reduces with age and peaks among age 20-24 at 44%.
