

SEX RATIO

Sex Ratio is the proportion of males to females in a population expressed by the number of males per hundred females.




The sex ratio for Obongi district is 93, this implies there are more females than males even across the Sub Counties.

Age dependency ratio is a measure of the number of dependents age zero to 14 and over the age of 65, compared with the total population aged 15 to 64.




The age dependency ratio for Obongi district is 98. It is highest in Aliba and lowest in Itula Sub County.

Prevalence of Physical Violence among women age 10-59 years in the 12 months prior to the survey





Physical violence among women and girls age 10-59 is highest in Aliba Sub County at 39% and lowest in Gimara Sub County at 4%.



SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Prevalence of Sexual Violence among women age 10-59 years in the 12 months prior to the survey






Child marriages among girls age 12-17 is highest in Itula Sub County at 3% and lowest in Obongi town Council at less than 1%.

Prevalence of physical, Sexual or Psychological violence among ever-married women and girls aged 15-59 in the previous 12 months in Obongi district is highest among age 50-54 at 43%. This pattern is different from the National level pattern where violence increase with age.
