## **COMMENTARY**

This is the 106th publication of Key Economic Indicators, reflecting the performance of the economy during the fourth quarter of 2016/17 financial year (Apr – Jun 2017).

## **HIGHLIGHTS**

### **Quarter Four 2016/17 Gross Domestic Product Performance**

#### **Seasonally adjusted estimates**

The real Gross Domestic Product for the Fourth Quarter (Q4) of 2016/17 grew by 1.9 percent compared to the growth of 1.8 percent registered in the Third Quarter (Q3) of 2016/17

#### **Sectoral Performance**

Value added in Agriculture sector is estimated to have increased by 0.3 percent in Q4 of 2016/17 from an earlier increase of 4.0 percent (revised) in the previous Quarter. The main driver to this increase were Cash Crops growing activities which grew by 4.5 percent. On the other hand, there was a decline in value added for Food Crops growing activities by 0.2 percent and Fishing activities by 1.3 percent.

Value added in Industry sector increased by 0.3 percent in Q4 of 2016/17 compared to an increase of 1.8 percent (revised) in Q3 of 2016/17. The main driver to this growth were manufacturing activities which increased by 3.0 percent. However, there was a decline in value added for mining & quarrying (11.2 percent), construction (2.2 percent) and Electricity (6.0 percent) activities.

The Services sector Value added grew by 1.8 percent in Q4 of 2016/17 compared to an earlier growth of 2.6 percent (revised) in Q3 of 2016/17. The main drivers to this growth were trade & repairs (4.0 percent), education (4.4 percent) and information & communication (0.8 percent) activities. However, there was a decline in value added for accommodation & food service by 7.7 percent and public administration by 1.2 percent activities.

#### **Original unadjusted estimates**

The real Gross Domestic Product for Q4 of 2016/17 grew by 5.4 percent compared to the growth of 3.3 percent (revised) registered in Q4 of 2015/16

#### **Sectoral Performance**

Value added in Agriculture sector is estimated to have increased by 4.6 percent in Q4 of 2016/17 from an earlier decline of 0.5 percent (revised) in the Q4 of 2015/16. The main driver to this increase were food crops growing activities. In particular, food crops increased by 6.5 percent. On the other hand, there was a decline in value added for cash crops growing activities of 0.7 percent.


Value added in Industry sector grew by 2.8 percent in Q4 of 2016/17 compared to a growth of 3.9 percent (revised) in Q4 of 2015/16. The main drivers to this growth were construction (10.2 percent), water (6.7 percent) and electricity (5.4 percent). However, there was a decline in value added of mining & quarrying (7.3 percent) and manufacturing (2.2 percent) activities.

The services sector value added grew by 7.2 percent in Q4 of 2016/17 compared to an earlier growth of 4.6 percent (revised) in Q4 of 2015/16. The main drivers to this growth were information & communication, accommodation & food

## Inflation

Four categories of inflation are produced by the Bureau and these are; 1. Headline inflation (all items index), 2. Core inflation, 3. Food crops & related items inflation and 4. Energy, Fuel & Utilities (EFU) inflation. Headline inflation includes all items in the basket. Core inflation excludes items that are so volatile to price changes like; food crops, electricity, fuel and utilities. Food crops & related items inflation includes all food items excluding processed foods. Energy, Fuel & Utilities (EFU) inflation includes electricity, fuel and utilities.


**Figure 1: Consumer Price Index Annual Percentage Changes, Jan 2015 – Jun 2017 (2009/10=100)**



The Annual headline inflation rates for the year ending Apr, May and Jun 2017 were; 6.8, 7.3 and 6.4 percent respectively. The increase in prices was majorly attributed to Food and related items whose index grew by 21.6, 23.1 and 18.1 percent respectively.

Annual core inflation rates were 4.9, 5.1, and 4.9 percent during the months of Apr, May and Jun 2017 respectively (see table 29).

**Figure 2: Consumer Price Index Monthly Percentage Changes Jan 2015 – Jun 2017 (2009/10=100)**




Monthly inflation rates for the months of Apr, May and Jun 2017 were 0.4, 0.6 and -0.6 percent respectively. Food and related items index increased in the month of Apr by 2.9 percent and registered a decrease of 0.3 and 7.5 percent in May and June respectively.

Monthly Core inflation rates for the months of Apr, May and Jun 2017 were 0.1, 0.7 and 0.4 percent respectively. Core inflation excludes Food crops & related items and Energy price variations (See Table 31).

## Exchange Rate

The official mid-rate for the Uganda currency per US dollar averaged at 3,611(UGX/ 1 USD) during the fourth quarter of 2016/17 from an average of 3,598 (UGX/ 1 USD) registered in the third quarter. The changes reflect a depreciation of 0.4 percent in the value of the Shilling against the US dollar.

The buying rate increased from 3,577 shillings to 3,596 shillings in Q4 2016/17 showing a depreciation of 0.5 percent while the selling rate decreased from 3,709 shillings in Q3 2016/17 to 3,624 shillings per US dollar in Q4 2016/17 showing an appreciation of 2.3 percent. (See table 20).

## Commercial Bank Outstanding Loans, as at end of Month

A loan is a liability provided by an entity (organization or individual) to another entity payable in a specified period at an agreed on interest rate. Commercial banks outstanding loans are loan advances by commercial banks to the general public (See figure 4).

During Q4 2016/17, total outstanding commercial bank loans and advances to the private sector increased by 0.6 percent from UGX 34.2 trillion shilling in Q3 2016/17 to UGX 34.4 trillion shilling in Q4 2016/17. Building, Mortgage, Construction and Real estate category continued to take biggest share of the loans and advances with 21.1 percent (7.3 trillion), Trade loans increased from 6.3 trillion in Q3 to 6.5 trillion shilling in Q4 2016/17 representing 19.1 percent, Personal & household loans 17.8 percent (6.1 trillion), Manufacturing 12.9 percent (4.5 trillion) and Agriculture 10.9 percent (3.8 trillion) see table 15.




### Tax Revenue collections

Total revenue collections during Q4 2016/17 (Comparing similar quarters) increased by 10.3 percent from 3,187.4 billion shillings in Q3 2015/16 to 3,528.8 billion shillings in Q4 2016/17. The increase is majorly attributed to the increase in the level of economic activity; with direct domestic taxes increasing by 34.7 percent (1,255 billion shillings) in Q4 2016/17, Customs tax 5.4 percent amounting to 1,449 billion shillings in Q4 2016/17.

On comparing consecutive quarters, revenue collections increased by 10.7 percent in Q4 2016/17 from 3,187.5 billion shillings in Q3 2016/17 to 3,528.8 billion shillings registered in Q4 2016/17.

ii) Other Revenue includes Non-Tax Revenue such as Licenses and Fees.


## Producer Price Indices (PPI) – Manufacturing & Utilities

The PPI for Manufacturing was rebased from Jul – Sept 2004 base period to Jul – June 2009/10 base period. The new index expanded to PPI Manufacturing and Utility. Changes from the former include; classification of industries is based on ISIC rev 4 while weights are calculated basing on Supply and Use Tables (SUT) of 2009/10.

Manufacturing PPI is categorized into PPI for export market, PPI for local market and a combined PPI for both manufacturing and utilities.

The combined PPI for both Manufactured goods and Utilities increased by 0.8 percent in Q4 2016/17 following an increase of 2.6 percent registered in Q3 2016/17. Utilities increased by 4.1 percent while manufactured goods increased by 0.5 percent in Q4 2016/17. (See table 21)

**Figure 6: Producer Price Index for Manufacturing (combined), Q1 2014/15 – Q4 2016/17**




## Construction Sector Index (CSI)

Construction Sector Index is an indicator of the average cost movement over time of a fixed basket of representative goods and services relating to the construction industry. It covers material prices, wage rates & equipment hire rates.

The overall sector index increased by 0.9 percent during Q4 2016/17 following a 1.3 percent growth registered in Q3 2016/17.

All Buildings index increased by 2.5 percent in Q4 2016/17, while the Civil Works index increased by 3.1 during the same quarter. (See table 24).

### **Production and Export of Principal Agricultural Products**


The total export volume of principle agriculture products (Coffee, Tea, Cotton and Tobacco) decreased by 7.5 percent in Q4 2016/17. The exports decreased from 101,941 tons in Q3 2016/17 to 94,638 tons in Q4 2016/17. In value terms, the exports fetched 172.5 million US dollars in Q4 2016/17 following 186.5 million US dollars registered in Q3 2016/17.

Coffee procurement during Q4 2016/17 declined by 7.4 percent from 83,744 tons in Q3 2016/17 to 74,583 tons in Q4 2016/17. Coffee exports amounted to 72,062 tons during Q4 2016/17 following an export volume of 72,748 tons registered in Q3 2016/17 indicating a decline of 0.9 percent in Q4 2016/17 fetching 133.1 million US dollars during the last quarter of 2016/17.

Tea exports continued to decline by 29.1 percent from 15,231 tons in Q3 2016/17 to 10,801 tons in Q4 2016/17. These fetched 18.7 million US dollars during the last quarter of 2016/17.


**Figure 8: Value of Exports for Principal Agricultural Products, Q1 2014/15 – Q4 2016/17 (000 US \$)**

Cotton fetched 15.3 million US dollars in Q4 2016/17 compared to 20.6 million US dollars collected in the previous quarter while Tobacco fetched 5.3 million US dollars in Q4 2016/17. (See figure 8 and table 27).

### **Water Supplied**

Water supplied by National Water and Sewerage Corporation (NW&SC) in major urban centres/municipalities increased by 2.7 percent in Q4 2016/17 following an earlier increase of 2.6 registered in Q3 2016/17. In volume terms, water supplied increased from 23.9 million m<sup>3</sup> in Q3 2016/17 to 24.6 million m<sup>3</sup> in Q4 2016/17 (See table 50 and figure 9).

Centres that registered increases in water supply were Kampala Metropolitan (2.9 percent), Lira (10.5 percent), Mbale (6.6 percent), Mbarara (3.8 percent), Fort-portal (0.2 percent), and Masaka (0.1 percent) while Gulu and Jinja recorded declines of 12.5 and 1.2 percent respectively in Q4 2016/17 (See table 50).
