COMMENTARY

This is the 95rd issue of the Key Economic Indicators, reflecting the performance of the economy during the first quarter of 2014/15 financial year.

Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP)

QGDP Constant Prices


Seasonally Adjusted Estimates

The Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP) at constant prices grew by 1.2 percent in Q1 of 2014/15 which is about the same as the revised growth of 1.2 percent for Q4 2013/14.

Sectoral Performance

Agriculture sector Value Added grew by 1.8 percent in Q1 of 2014/15 compared to 0.0 percent growth in Q4 of 2013/14. The main contributor to this growth was Food crop growing, Livestock rearing and Forestry activities which have a combined contribution of 86 percent to Agriculture sector Value Added.

Figure 1: Seasonally adjusted QGDP estimates at constant 2009/10 prices, billion shillings 2012/13 - 2014/15




The Industry Sector Value Added registered a growth of 0.3 percent in Q1 of 2014/15 compared to a growth of 3.5 percent (revised) in Q4 2013/14. This was mainly due to growth in Value Added for manufacturing activities. The decline in Value Added for construction was not enough to offset the growth in other activities of Industry.

On the other hand, Value Added for the Service Industry grew by 1.8 percent in Q1 of 2014/15 compared to a growth of 0.4 percent (revised) in Q4 2013/14. Trade & Repairs, Information & Communication, Real Estate, Public Administration, Human Health, Education, Professional activities, Arts contributed to the growth in this sector. The decline in Transport, Financial services, and Administrative support activities was not enough to offset the growth in the other activities of the Industry.

Trend-cycle estimates

Trend cycle Value Added grew by 1.1 percent from Shs. 11,733 billion in Q4 2013/14 to Shs.11,868 billion in Q1 2014/15. There was a significant difference in the seasonally adjusted and the trend-cycle estimates due to a strong irregular component.

Figure 2: Seasonally Adjusted and Trend-Cycle Movements 2011/12 - 2014/15




QGDP at Current Prices

Seasonally Adjusted Estimates

QGDP in current prices grew by 2.1 percent from Shs.16,380 billion in Q4 of 2013/14 to Shs.16,725 billion in Q1 of 2014/15. It should be noted that 0.9 percent of the growth was due to an increase in prices during the quarter.


Inflation

The Annual headline inflation rates for the year ending July, August and September 2014 were 4.3, 2.8 and 1.4 percent respectively. The main driver for the decline in inflation in the first quarter of 2014/15 was Food Crop sub group prices which decreased by 3.4 percent compared to a 2.5 increase in the previous quarter. The overall index decreased by 0.2 percent compared to a 0.9 percent increase recorded in the previous quarter (See Table 24).

Figure 4: Consumer Price Index monthly percentage changes January 2013–September 2014




Core inflation rates for the year ending July, August and September 2014 were 3.0, 3.1 and 2.0 percent respectively. (See Table 25)

Exchange Rate

The average shilling official mid-rate in the Inter-bank foreign exchange Markets (IFEM) during the first quarter of 2014/15 depreciated further by 2.9 percent compared to 1.8 percent depreciation in Q4 2013/14. The average value of the Shilling depreciated from 2,548 per US dollar in the fourth quarter of 2013/14 to an average of Shillings 2,622 per US dollar in the first quarter of 2014/15; representing a 2.9 percent depreciation in the shilling in Q1 of 2014/15 compared to Q4 2013/14. Likewise, the bureau mid-rate depreciated by 2.8 percent during the same period from an average of Shillings 2,544 per US dollar in the third quarter of 2013/14 to an average of Shillings 2,616 per US dollar in the first quarter of 2014/15 (See Table 14).


Figure 5: Official and Bureau Middle Rate, 2012 - 2014



Tax Revenue collections

The total revenue collections by Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) in the first quarter of 2014/15 decreased by 8.8 percent compared to an increase of 11.9 percent registered in the fourth quarter of 2013/14. The collections decreased from shs 2,290 billion in the fourth quarter of 2013/14 to shs 2,088 billion in the first quarter of 2014/15.

Figure 6: Uganda Revenue Authority collections, 20012/13 – 2014/15, ('million shillings)




During the first quarter of 2014/15, Domestic tax decreased by 23.5 percent of which PAYE decreased by 9.6 percent; VAT (international trade) increased by 17.4 percent; Customs duty on petroleum increased by 1.1 percent; Value Added Tax (domestic) decreased by 2.8 percent; Excise duty increased by 6.4 percent (See table 10).

Producer Price indices (PPI)

The combined PPI for the month of Sept 2014 declined by 1.1 percent in September from a 0.9 percent decline in August and 0.5 percent increase for July 2014. Comparing similar months, the combined PPI for the month of Sept 2013 decreased by 3.1 percent compared to a 0.4 and 0.7 percent increases in the month of Aug and July respectively in 2013. For the first quarter of 2014/15, the combined PPI decreased by 0.2 percent compared to an increase of 0.7 percent registered in the fourth quarter of 2013/14.

The PPI for local production of manufactured goods decreased by 1.2 percent in the first quarter of 2014/15, compared to a 1.1 decrease in the previous quarter. Comparing similar quarters, the index decreased by 0.1 percent in the first quarter of 2013/14 compared to a 1.2 percent increase in the similar quarter of 2014/15.

The PPI for export of manufactured goods decreased by 3.4 percent in the first quarter of 2014/15 compared to a 7.9 percent increase in the previous quarter. However, compared to the similar quarter of 2013/14, the producer price index remained stable (See Tables 15 – 18).

Production and export of principle agricultural products


Production

Coffee production declined further by 18.1 percent from a 4.4 percent decline recorded in the previous quarter. Coffee procurement decreased from 60,150 tons in the fourth quarter of 2013/14 to 49,278 tons in the first quarter of 2014/15. Tea production decreased by 33.5 percent from a 66.0 percent increase in quarter four 2013/14. This was a result of a reduction in quantity produced from 19,753 tons in the previous quarter to 13,145 tons in quarter one 2014/15. (See table 21).

Exports

Coffee exports declined further by 11.0 percent from an 18.9 percent decline in the previous quarter. This was in correspondence to a quantity reduction to 47,416 tons from 53,277 tons in the fourth quarter of 2013/14. Coffee export earnings declined further by 11.6 percent from a 3.1 percent decline in the previous quarter.

In value, coffee exports fetched 97.0 million US dollars in the first quarter of 2014/15 compared to 109.8 million US dollars in the previous quarter.

Tea exports decreased by 23.7 percent from 18,061 tons fetching 26.2 million US dollars in the fourth quarter of 2013/14 to 13,779 tons fetching 19.7 million US dollars in the first quarter of 2014/15 (See Figure 5 and table 21).
