Uganda to develop a Plan for National Statistical Development (PNSD)

OVERVIEW

The first PNSD Bulletin [July 2005] expounded the rationale and Frequently Asked Questions about the PNSD, the National Statistical System [NSS], and the draft Road Map. The PNSD will be a **framework for strengthening statistical capacity across the entire NSS for results-based management**. UBOS has for the past three years been fulfilling its mandate based on a 5 year Corporate Plan (2002-2007). However, the corporate plan has almost exclusively focused on UBOS activities. It has not provided for a holistic approach to data production in the NSS, including the system's institutional and technical administrative framework, financing, human resources, and methods to data users and utilization for decision-making. This has led to a NSS characterized by a weak capacity and low level of institutional coordination.

The PNSD is anticipated to address issues of structure, sustainability and modification of relationships between key actors in the NSS, harmonization and implementation of planned activities financed by government and development partners. It will be a 5-10 year plan covering the entire NSS, presenting priorities for statistics and building capacity needed to meet the priorities in a more coordinated, synergistic and efficient manner. The PNSD design Process started in July, and the draft plan is estimated to be ready by January 2006. To date, sensitization of key stakeholders within and outside the UBOS has been conducted and will continue throughout the entire design process.

PROGRESS

The UBOS management met and presented the PNSD concept to the following officials and institutions;

- The Head Public Service
- Minister of State, Planning and Economic Development [in charge of Statistics] – Hon. Isaac Musumba.
- ♣ Sector representatives to the Producer Producer Committees (PPC's) [Producer – Producer, General Data Disseminating Systems (GDDS] and EAC – Technical Working Groups.]
- Ministry of Local Government
- Ministry of Health
- Ministry of Gender, Labour and Social Development

Further, a *Strategic Management Workshop* facilitated by *Prof. Ben Kiregyera* was conducted to enable stakeholders/line ministries understand the basic concepts of strategic planning and equip them with skills to support the development of the PNSD in their line ministries/institutions. The strategic management workshop was *officially opened by* Hon. Mwesigwa Rukutana, Minister of State for General Duties, Ministry of Finance Planning and Economic Development. One major recommendation from the training was that the UBOS Act (1998) should restructured to include all actors in the NSS ie. The Uganda Statistical System Act.

FORESEEN CHALLENGES

- Securing stakeholder buy-in into the PNSD
- Sequencing activities of the policy making cycle with the data production cycle

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- Institutional constraint along the data production chain of line ministries/routine data producing agencies
- Prioritization of statistical functions by line ministries and other government agencies
