UBOS STAFF COVID\_19 INFORMATION SERIES NO. 8 (2020)



• As of April 02,2020 the number of COVID\_19 confirmed cases stands at 45.

- A total of 1,026 persons are under institutional quarantine.
- 962 contacts of previously confirmed cases are under follow up.



• All the COVID\_19 confirmed cases remain in stable condition and to date, Uganda has not registered any COVID\_19 related deaths.

# TRACING THE SOURCES OF COVID\_19

- Majority of the confirmed cases (33) have come from travellers returning from abroad.
- There is howeve,r no evidence as to whether the domestic cases (12) were as a result of secondary contact with

on-going active transmissions.

COVID\_19 EMERGES AS THE NEW 'FRONTLINE'FOR UPDF MEDICAL DOCTORS...






**B**rig. Dr. Stephen Kusasira from the UPDF Directorate of Medical Services will going foward be supporting the Director General of Health Services (MoH) in captaining the technical teams against the spread of the corona virus pandemic.

- Lt. Col. Dr. Henry Kyobe who is a senior epidemiologist is the new incident commander for COVID\_19, taking over from Mr. Atek Kagirita (MoH) who going foward will serve in a deputising capacity.
- A total of 82 UPF medical personnel are already on the frontline in different fields of case management, surveillence and logisics management.



- The 'lockdown' will help us to supress the risk of transmission as it breaks down the chain of constant community interface. Experience from countries such as Japan and South Korea has already underlined social distancing as an effective response to breaking down the transmission chain.
- Without a national lockdown, it is estimated that Uganda would have 18,878 confirmed cases and 566 COVID\_19 related deaths by April 30, 2020.
- A passenger manifest of all travellers during the period March 07 – 22 is being followed up with intent of corrolating it with their health record submissions at the time of travel.
- A number of isolation centers have been established (with others under consideration) to manage all the emerging and / or suspected COVID\_19 cases.

Across the EAC, the number of COVID\_19 confirmed cases have surged to 262 in less than a month. Of these, there have been only 04 deaths and 06 recoveries.



## GOVERNMENT LAUNCHES 'TONSEMBERERA' CAMPAIGN...

 A sentization campaign 'Tonsemberera' (a.k.a keep your distance) has been launched targeting the entire population to rise in unison against the further spread of the COVID\_19 pandemic. The campaign howeverdoes not in anyway 'water down' all the other hitherto identified behavioural change initiatives aimed at 'arresting' the virus.



"UBOS is leading from the front by way of availing data to the government response machinery. The data is required to inform the planning and distribution of food rations to the vulnerable sections of the population beginning with the greater Kampala sub region.
