COVID_19 FORCES UGANDA INTO TOTAL LOCKDOWN

- People to people movement including those using private vehicles, bodabodas, tuk-tuks, etc is prohibited for 14 days.
- Shopping malls, arcades and hardware shops are suspended starting 1st of April, 2020.
- All the non-food shops (stores) are closed. Only stores selling agricultural products, veterinary products, detergents and pharmaceuticals are to remain open.
- The supermarkets remain open but must observe a social distance of 4 metres.
- Saloons, lodges and garages are suspended.
- Construction sites are to remain open but must encamp their workers for 14 days.
- Cargo transport within, between and outside Uganda remain uninterrupted.
- Gatherings of more than 5 people are Suspended.
- Save for cargo transporters, there will be curfew starting at 7 pm going forward.

UBOS RELEASES INFLATION FIGURES

The Annual Headline inflation for the year ending March 2020 is recorded at 3.0 percent compared to the 3.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2020. The decrease in Annual Headline inflation is largely attributed to the Annual Core Inflation that is registered at 2.5 percent for the year ending March 2020 compared to the 3.1 percent registered for the year ended February 2020.
