

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FOREWORD

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten baskets of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index was rebased from 2005/2006 to 2009/2010, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS IV) that was conducted from May 2009 to April 2010. During the rebasing exercise, Kampala was further decomposed into three baskets from the two that has been existing. In addition, Fortportal Centre was incorporated into the Index. The rebased CPI is now classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP). This is a shift from the Central Product Classification (CPC) that was used in the earlier series.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten baskets mentioned above and indices are available from the EA level.

ACRONYMS AND DEFINITIONS

COICOP: Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose, is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyse individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

CPI: Consumer Price Index - a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

CPI basket: A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

Elementary aggregate (EA): The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

Inflation: A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.

Jevons price index: An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the unweighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

Laspeyres price index: The Laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

Outlet: The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue, a website etc. Also referred to as a "retail outlet", although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers

Outlier: A term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect

Price relative: A measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

Reference base: The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2009/10.

Weight: The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity or value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

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1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF CPI FOR MARCH 2021

1.1 Annual Inflation

The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending March 2021 is recorded at 4.1 percent compared to the 3.8 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. The increase in Annual Headline inflation is mainly attributed to the Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation that increased to minus 0.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 4.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This rise was mainly driven by Annual Inflation for Vegetables that recorded 0.6 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 4.7 percent recorded in February 2021. In particular, the Annual Inflation for Vegetables cultivated for their fruit, increased to 2.5 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to the minus 12.6 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Annual Fruits Inflation increased to minus 0.8 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 3.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. See table 1.

The Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation increased to minus 0.8 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 2.6 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. The increase in Annual EFU Inflation is attributed to Solid fuels Inflation that increased to minus 0.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 3.8 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Specifically, Charcoal Inflation increased to 0.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 3.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Firewood Inflation increased to minus 13.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 15.6 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition Annual Petrol Inflation increased to minus 0.7 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 1.8 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021, see Table 1, 2 and 7.

The Annual Core Inflation for the year ending March 2021 decreased to 5.3 percent compared to the 5.6 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. The decrease in Annual Core Inflation is attributed to Annual Services Inflation that registered 10.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 10.6 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Specifically, the Annual inflation for Transport services decreased to 53.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 56.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition Annual Other Goods Inflation that registered 2.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 2.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. See Table 1 and 7.




Figure 1: Uganda Headline Index and Annual Inflation for 3 major components, March 2020—March 2021: (2009/2010 = 100)

The twelve months' series for the Headline Index and the Annual Inflation for the three major components are shown in Figure 1.

1.2 Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical areas

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups reveal that Arua registered the highest Annual Inflation of 7.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 this was lower than the 5.7 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. This was driven by Annual Inflation for Food and non-alcoholic beverages Inflation that increased to 10.5 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 7.5 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Annual inflation for Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased to minus 3.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 7.5 percent registered for the year ended February 2021, see Table 8.

The second highest Inflation was registered in the basket of Kampala High Income that registered an Inflation of 4.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to the 5.0 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. This was driven by Annual Inflation for Food and non-alcoholic beverages Inflation that increased to minus 0.4 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 2.3 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Annual inflation for Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased to minus 1.6 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 2.4 percent registered for the year ended February 2021.




Figure 2: Annual Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical Areas for the year ending February 2021 and March 2021

The least Annual Inflation was registered in Gulu at 2.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 1.9 percent for the year ended February 2021. The low inflation in the Centre was due to the Annual Transport Inflation that declined to 23.3 Percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 26.3 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Annual Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation declined to 1.7 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to the 3.2 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. *Annual Inflation figures for all the ten consumption baskets are shown in Figure 2 and Table 8.*

1.3 Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation for March 2021 rose by 0.3 percent the same rate recorded in February 2021.

The rise in the Monthly Headline Inflation is attributed to Monthly Food Crops and Related Items Inflation that registered a 1.5 percent rise in March 2021 from the 2.2 percent rise in February 2021. The increase is due to Monthly Vegetables Inflation that registered 3.3 percent increase for the month of March 2021 from the 7.8 percent rise registered in February 2021. In particular, Monthly Inflation for Vegetables cultivated for their fruit increased by 5.0 percent in March 2021 from the 18.6 percent rise recorded in February 2021, See Table 1.

The Monthly Core Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of March 2021 compared to the 0.2 percent rise registered in February 2021. The increase is due to Monthly Other Goods Inflation that registered 0.5 percent increase for the month of March 2021 from the 0.2 percent rise registered in February 2021, See Table 1 & 7.

The Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities Inflation increased by 1.0 percent during the month of March 2021 compared to the 0.1 percent drop recorded in February 2021. The increase was due to Monthly Solid Fuels Inflation that recorded a 2.2 percent rise in March 2021 compared to 0.2 percent drop recorded for February 2021. In addition, the Monthly Petrol Inflation further increased by 0.5 percent during the month of March 2021 from the earlier 0.1 percent drop recorded in February 2021, See Table 1 & 2. The detailed Monthly Inflation figures by COICOP Division are presented in Section 2 of the explanatory notes in the annex.


The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 3.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased to 1.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 0.9 recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Annual Food Inflation that increased to 1.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.9 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation registered to 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 the same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. *Figure 3 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation from March 2019 to March 2021.*

Figure 3: Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation Trends; March 2019 — March 2021.




02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Annual Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics decreased to 2.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 3.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that decreased to 2.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 3.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Annual Tobacco Inflation decreased to 3.7 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 3.7 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Inflation for Clothing and Footwear decreased to 1.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 2.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Clothing Inflation that decreased to 1.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 2.5 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Footwear Inflation decreased to 1.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 2.1 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. 04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance & repair of the dwelling, Water Supply, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

The Annual Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels increased to minus 0.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 1.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. The increase was attributed to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that increased to minus 1.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 3.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Maintenance & Repair of the Dwelling Inflation increased to 3.4 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 2.2 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 0.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 the same rate as that recorded for the year ended February 2021. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services relating to the dwelling Inflation recorded a minus 0.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 the same rate as that recorded for the year ended February 2021.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Annual Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance increased to 0.5 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. The increase was due to Household Appliances Inflation increased to 1.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 1.5 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings increased to minus 1.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 2.5 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Household Textiles Inflation registered 2.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 1.6 recorded for the year ended February 2021. Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation increased to 5.4 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 4.6 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

However, Goods and Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation decreased to minus 0.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.1 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation decreased to 2.7 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 3.9 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

06 Health

The health Division comprises of Medical Products, Appliances & Equipment, Outpatient Services, and Hospital Services.

The Annual Health Inflation registered 4.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 the same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Annual Outpatient Services Inflation increased to 6.6 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 6.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Annual Hospital Services Inflation that also increased to 17.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 17.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This increase was offset by Annual Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment Inflation that decreased to 0.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Transport and Personal Equipment and Transport Services.

Annual Transport Inflation decreased to 25.4 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 28.9 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was mainly attributed to Purchase of Vehicles Inflation that decreased to 8.6 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 18.0 percent registered for the year ended February 2021. Transport services Inflation dropped to 53.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 56.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. However, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment Inflation increased to 0.4 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to minus 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

08 Communication

Communication includes Postal services, Telephones and Telefax equipment and Telephone and Telefax services.

The Annual Communication Inflation registered to 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 the same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Annual Telephone and Telefax Equipment Inflation registered 0.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 same as that recorded for the year ended February 2021. Telephone & Telefax Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. Annual Postal Services Inflation registered to 0.0 percent same as that recorded for the year ended February 2021.

09 Recreation and Culture

Recreation and Culture comprises of Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment, Recreational & Cultural services, Newspapers, books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

Annual Inflation for Recreation and Culture decreased to 0.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Recreational & Cultural Services Inflation that decreased to 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation decreased to 0.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.6 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Package Holidays Inflation decreased to minus 0.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.3 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

However, Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation increased to 0.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 0.0 that recorded for the year ended February 2021.

10 Education

Education comprises of Pre-Primary and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education not definable by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education registered to 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Secondary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Pre-Primary and Primary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021.

Tertiary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the year ending March 2021 the same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. Education not definable by level recorded 0.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

Restaurants and Hotels comprises of catering services and accommodation services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels increased to 1.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 1.1 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Catering Services Inflation that increased to 1.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 1.6 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. Accommodation services Inflation registered 0.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous goods and services comprises of Personal Care such as hairdressing salons and personal grooming establishments, Personal Effects such as Jewellery, clocks and watches, Insurance and Other services such as passport fees, photocopying and radio announcements.

The Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation for the year ending March 2021 decreased to 1.4 percent compared to 1.9 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. This was due to Personal Care Inflation that decreased to 0.9 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 1.5 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021. In addition, Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation decreased to 2.2 percent for the year ending March 2021 compared to 3.4 percent recorded for the year ended February 2021.

However, Insurance Inflation registered minus 0.1 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021. Other Services n.e.c Inflation registered 4.3 percent for the year ending March 2021 same rate recorded for the year ended February 2021.

ANNEX 2: MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages registered an increase of 1.4 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.9 percent rise recorded for February 2021. This was due to Food Inflation that increased by 1.5 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.9 percent rise recorded for February 2021. However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of March 2021 compared to 0.1 percent rise recorded for February 2021.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics decreased by 0.6 percent during the month of March 2021 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. This was mainly due to Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that registered 0.6 percent drop for the month of March 2021 from 0.6 percent rise recorded for February 2021. In addition, Tobacco Inflation dropped by 0.5 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded for the month of February 2021.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear registered a decrease of 0.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded for February 2021. This was due to Clothing Inflation that decreased by 0.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded for February 2021. In addition, Footwear Inflation registered a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded for February 2021.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels registered an increase of 0.7 percent for the month of March 2021 from 0.1 percent drop recorded for February 2021. This was attributed to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that recorded a 1.4 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from 0.2 percent drop recorded for the month of February 2021. In addition, Maintenance and repair of the dwelling Inflation registered an increase of 1.0 percent for the month of March 2021 from 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021.

Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services relating to the dwelling Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance registered 0.5 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of February 2021. This was due to Household Textiles Inflation registered an increase of 1.3 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. In addition, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation registered an increase of 2.1 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded for the month of February 2021. Furniture and Furnishings, Carpets and Other Floor Coverings Inflation registered an increase of 0.8 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded for the month of February 2021. Household Appliances Inflation registered an increase of 0.4 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of February 2021. However, Goods and Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation registered a 0.4 percent drop for the month of March 2021 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation registered a decrease of 0.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded for the month of February 2021.

06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health registered 0.1 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from 3.0 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. This was attributed to Outpatient Services Inflation that increased by 0.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from 4.8 percent recorded for the month of February 2021. Hospital Services Inflation that increased by 0.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from 12.1 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment recorded 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 from 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021.

07 Transport

Transport Inflation registered a decline of 1.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.5 percent drop recorded for the month of February 2021. This was due to Purchase of Vehicles Inflation registered a decrease of 1.4 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded during the month of February 2021. Transport Services Inflation recorded a decline of 1.9 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 1.2 percent drop recorded during the month of February 2021. However, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment Inflation registered 0.5 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of February 2021.

08 Communication

The Monthly Inflation for Communication registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021. Telephone and Telefax Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021. Telephone and Telefax Equipment Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021. Postal services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021.

09 Recreation and Culture

Monthly Recreation and Culture Inflation registered a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. This was due to Newspapers, Books and Stationery Inflation registered a decrease of 0.4 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. Package Holidays Inflation registered a decrease of 0.7 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded during the month of February 2021. Recreational and Cultural Services Inflation registered a decrease of 0.2 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of February 2021.

However, Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation registered an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021.

10 Education

Monthly Inflation for Education registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021. This was due to Pre-primary & Primary Education, Secondary Education, Tertiary Education and Education not defined by Level Inflation all registering 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 same as that recorded for the month of February 2021.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

The Monthly Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels registered a 0.7 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded during the month of February 2021. This was due to Catering Services Inflation that recorded a 0.9 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from 0.1 percent drop recorded during the month of February 2021. In addition, Accommodation Services Inflation registered 0.1 percent rise for the month of March 2021 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of February 2021.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation for the month of March 2021 registered a decrease of 0.1 percent from 0.4 percent rise recorded during the month of February 2021. This was due to Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation that registered a decrease of 1.0 percent during the month of March 2021 from the 2.9 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021. In addition, Personal Care Inflation recorded a decline of 0.1 percent for the month of March 2021 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of February 2021.

Insurance Inflation registered 0.0 percent during the month of March 2021 the same rate recorded for the month of February 2021. Other Services n.e.c Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of March 2021 the same rate recorded for the month of February 2021.
