It is important to note that, the statistics contained herein exclude informal cross border trade which was suspended in April 2020 due to the outbreak of COVID-19 that led to the closure of borders. This affected small scale cross border trade and hence the Informal Cross border Trade surveys.

## Introduction

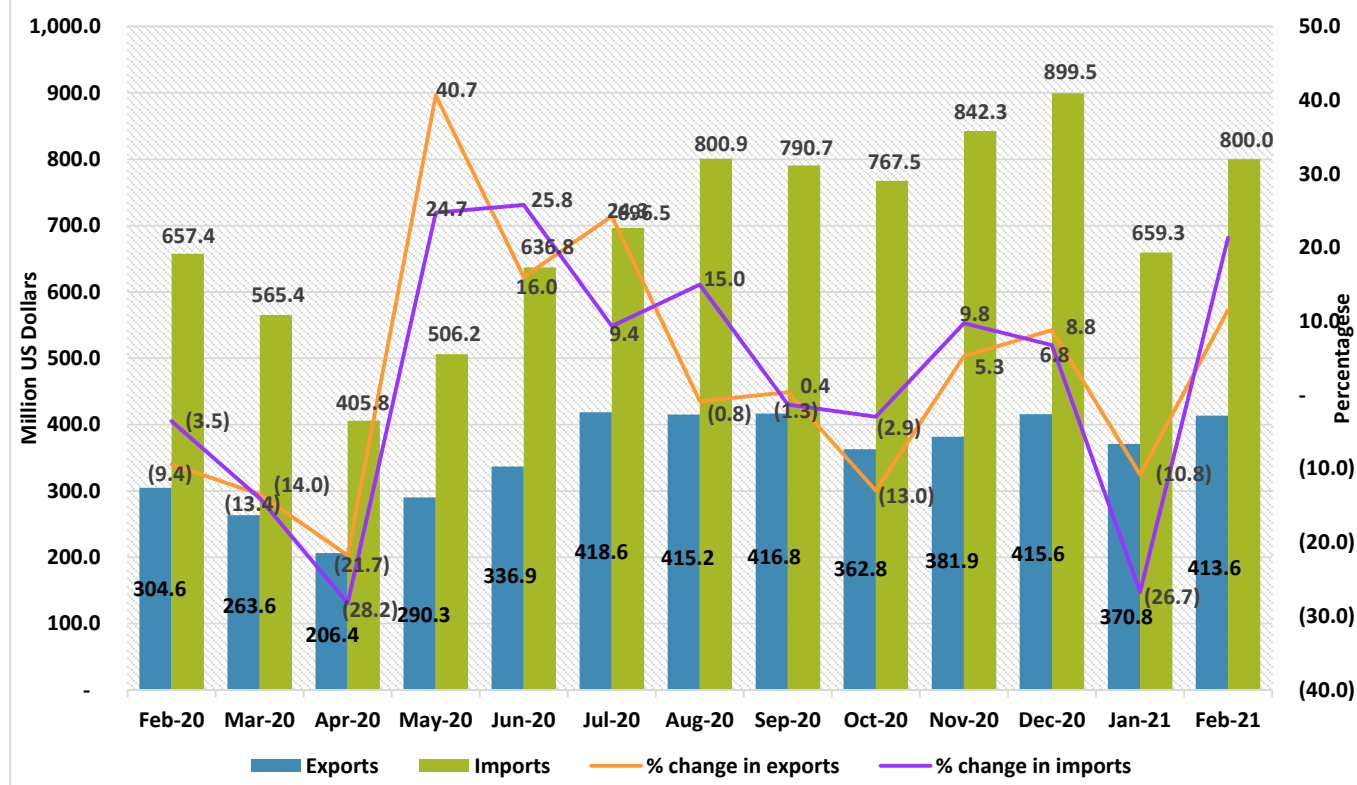
The bulletin presents International Merchandise trade statistics (exports and imports flows) between Uganda and the rest of the world as compiled from Customs and Non-Customs data sources. **International merchandise trade** statistics record all goods which add to, or subtract from, the stock of material resources of a country by entering (as imports) or leaving (as exports) its economic territory. The data compiled from customs and commodity authorities is herein referred to as Formal exports and imports.

The compilation of International Merchandise Trade Statistics is based on the General Trade System and coded according to Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System 2017 (HS2017) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev4) commodity nomenclatures as prescribed in the International Merchandise Trade Statistics manual 2010 (IMTS2010).

In February 2021, total trade increased by 17.8 percent to US\$ 1,213.5 million from US\$ 1,030.1 million recorded in January 2021. Total exports increased by 11.5 percent in February 2021 to US\$ 413.6 million from US\$ 370.8 million recorded in January 2021. Total imports flows increased by 21.3 percent to US\$ 800.0 million in February 2021 from US\$ 659.3 million registered in January 2021.

Annually, trade flows in February 2021 increased by 26.1 percent from US\$ 962.0 million recorded in February 2020. Imports increased by 21.7 percent in February 2021 compared to US\$ 657.4 million registered in February 2020 while Exports increased by 35.8 percent in February 2021 in comparison to US\$ 304.6 million registered in February 2020 see Figure 1 and Table 1 below.

Figure 1: Exports and Imports from February 2020 to February 2021



The total imports bill increased from US\$ 657.4 million in February 2020 to US\$ 800.0 million in February 2021.

The trade deficit increased to US\$ 386.4 million in February 2021 compared to a deficit of US\$ 288.5 million recorded in January 2021, Figure 1 above and Table 1 below.

## Performance of Formal Commodity Exports

Gold and Gold compounds continued to be the leading exported commodity whose earnings slightly increased to US\$ 175.1 million in February 2021 from US\$ 173.9 million received in January 2021, contributing 42.3 percent to total exports in February 2021 compared to a 46.9 percent contribution registered in January 2021.

Coffee was the second most export revenue generating commodity with US\$ 50.5 million which accounted for 12.2 percent of total exports

in February 2021. This was higher than the January 2021 export earnings of US\$ 39.7 million.

Cocoa beans products was the third most exported commodity accounting for 3.0 percent of total exports.

Fish and Fish products, Maize, Tea, Sugar & sugar confectionaries, Cement, Animal/vegetable fats and oils, Petroleum products, Iron and steel and Tobacco commodities, were also among Uganda's leading exports, see Table2 below.

## **Formal Exports by Region and Country of destination**

Middle East was the leading destination of Uganda's formal exports throughout the period under review followed by EAC, European Union, Other Africa, and Asia.

In February 2021, formal exports to Middle East increased slightly by 0.4 percent from US\$ 179.6 million, accounting for 43.4 percent of formal exports compared to US\$ 178.9 million registered in January 2021. The leading country of destination was United Arab Emirates with revenues worth US\$ 177.7 million representing 43.0 percent of total export earnings.

The East African Community (EAC) was the second with US\$ 97.5 million in February 2021 compared to US\$ 82.5 million revenues received in January 2021

Within the EAC, the major countries of destination for the period under review were; Kenya and South Sudan fetching US\$ 48.2 million and US\$ 39.7 million respectively in February 2021 compared to US\$ 43.7 million and US\$ 28.7 million recorded in January 2021.

Exports to other African countries increased to US\$ 41.9 million in February 2021 compared to US\$ 35.9 million recorded in January 2021. D.R Congo and Sudan were the major countries of destination in the region, however their combined market share declined to 6.7 percent in February 2021 compared to 7.3 percent registered in January 2021.

Exports to Europe increased to US\$ 64.6 million in February 2021 from US\$ 48.3 million recorded in

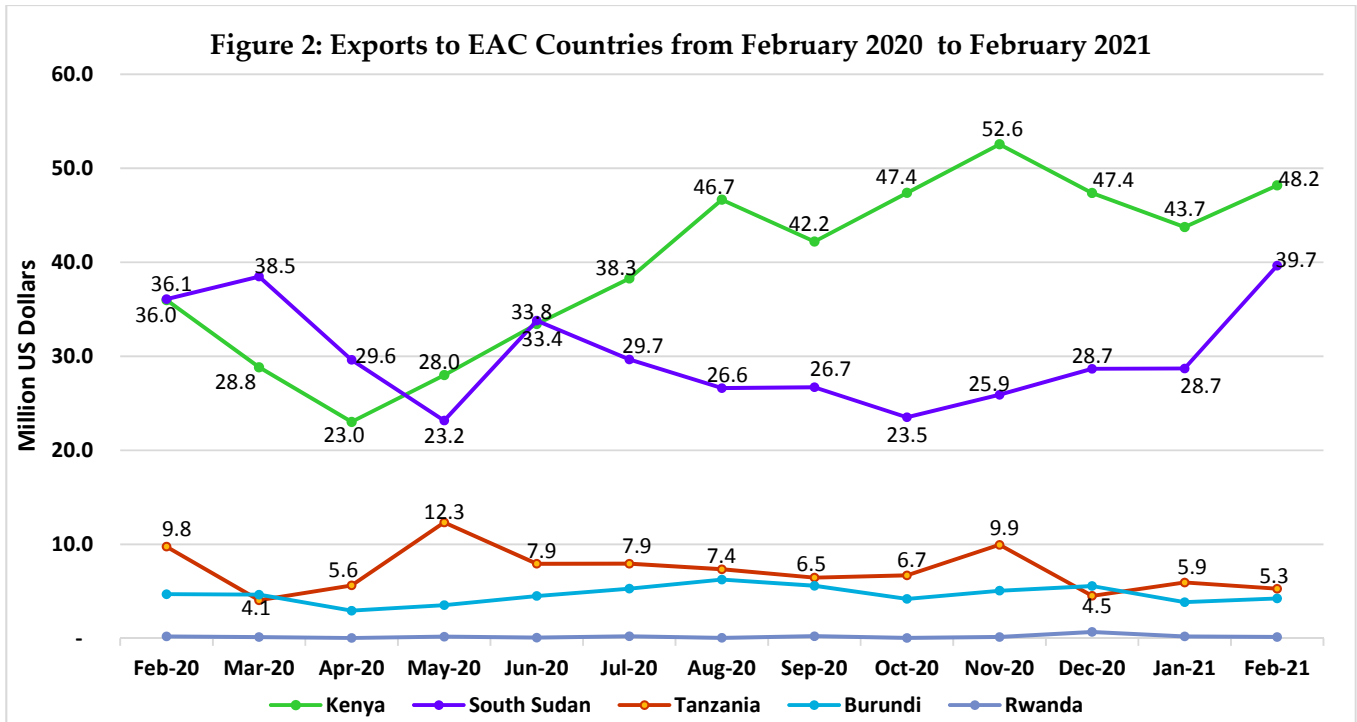
January 2021. Most countries in this region performed well with the exports to Italy increasing to US\$ 15.1 million in February 2021 compared to US\$ 12.7 million registered in January 2021. Germany, Netherlands, Belgium and Spain were also among the leading countries of destination in the region for the period under review.

The Asian region had a share of 5.9 percent, resulting from export revenues worth US\$ 24.3 million in February 2021 compared to US\$ 19.8 million recorded in January 2021. India, China, Hong Kong and Indonesia were among the leading destinations of Uganda's exports.

Exports destined to North America/Caribbean were US\$ 4.9 million in February 2021. Specifically, these were destined to the United States. See Annex Table 6.

## **Formal Exports to East African Community (EAC) Countries**

Kenya was the leading destination of Uganda's exports among the East African Community (EAC) member states in February 2021 generating revenue of US\$ 48.2 million and accounting for 11.7 percent of total exports. This was 10.1 percent increase in the export earnings to Kenya in comparison to US\$ 43.7 million earned in January 2021. South Sudan was the second country of destination, contributing 9.6 percent to Uganda's exports in February 2021 in comparison to the contribution of 7.7 percent recorded in January 2021. Trade activities between Uganda and Rwanda are still low throughout the period under review, see Figure 2 below and Annex Table 6.



### Performance of Formal Commodity Imports

Gold, non-monetary (excl. gold ores and concentrates) continued being the main imported Commodity into the country though its import bill decreased to US\$ 151.8 million in February 2021 from US\$ 154.8 million recorded in January 2021. The proportion of Gold to total imports stood at 19.0 percent in February 2021 compared to 23.5 percent registered in January 2021.

Petroleum products (petrol, diesel, paraffin, aviation fuel and related materials) followed as the most imported products. Its imports bill increased by 9.4 percent in February 2021 in comparison to January 2021. The imports bill was US\$ 85.3 million in February 2021 from US\$ 78.0 million recorded in January 2021. Petroleum

products contributed 10.7 percent to the total imports bill in February 2021 in comparison to 11.8 percent recorded in January 2021.

Road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles) was the third most imported commodity with their imports bill increasing to US\$ 54.7 million in February 2021 from US\$ 40.7 million registered in January 2020.

Iron and steel, medical and pharmaceutical products, plastics in primary forms, cereals & cereal preparations and fixed vegetable fats and oils, crude, refined or fractionated amongst others were among the leading imported goods, see Table 3 below.

### Formal Imports by Region and Country of Origin

The Asian region was the main source of Uganda's merchandise imports. The region's import bill increased to US\$ 343.4 million in February 2021 from US\$ 243.9 million recorded in January 2021. China and India were the leading countries of origin for Uganda's imports in the region. These countries recorded an increase in expenses to US\$ 182.4 million and US\$ 69.0 million respectively in

February 2021 from US\$ 96.5 million and US\$ 59.5 million recorded in January 2021.

The East African Community (EAC) ranked the second accounting for 20.9 percent of the imports bill in February 2021. Expenses to the region increased slightly to US\$ 167.4 million in February 2021 from US\$ 163.4 million recorded in January 2021.

South Africa and Gambia were the leading sources of imports from Other Africa region whose import bills were US\$ 25.3 million and US\$

24.6 million respectively in February 2021 compared to US\$ 22.3 million and US\$ 28.8 million recorded in January 2021.

Netherlands was the main country of origin for imports from the European Union region with an import bill of US\$ 7.2 million in February 2021 from US\$ 12.7 million registered in January 2021. This was a decline of 43.3 percent in the imports from Netherlands in February 2021 in comparison to the import exports recorded in January 2021.

Imports from Middle East were US\$ 90.3 million contributing 11.3 percent to total imports in February 2021. United Arab Emirates was the main contributing country within this region accounting for 6.1 percent of total imports in February 2021 from 11.1 percent recorded in

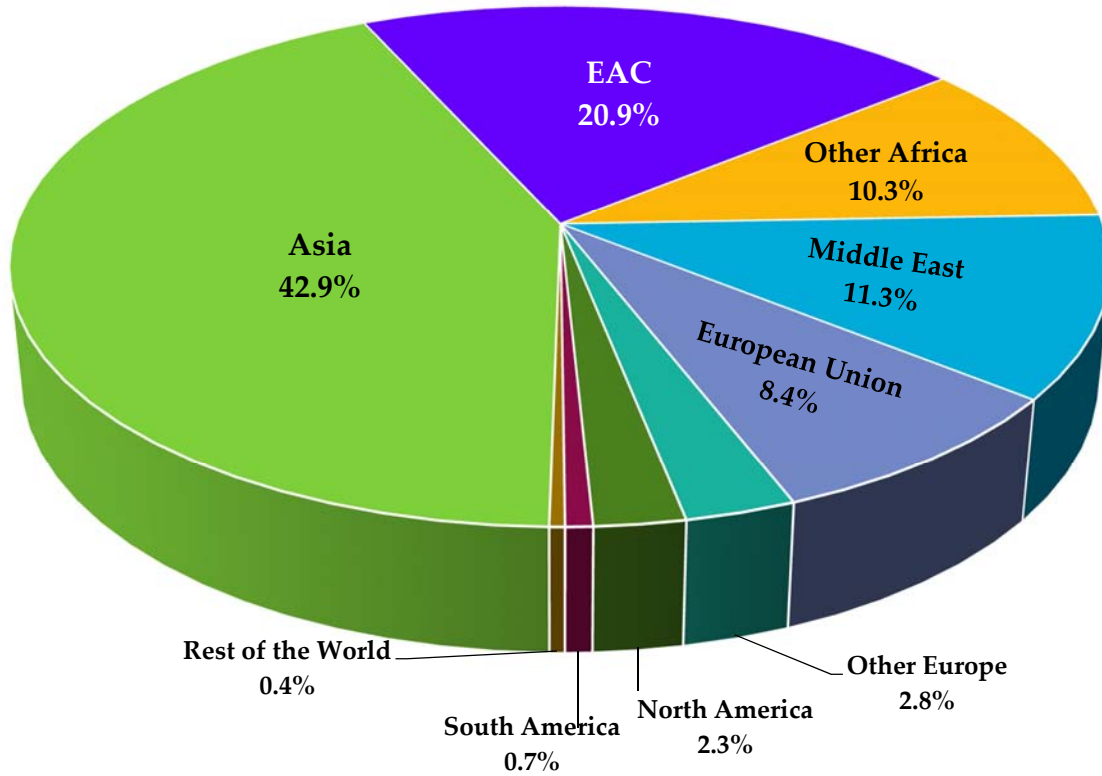
January 2021. However, its imports declined by 33.6 percent to US\$ 48.4 million in February 2021 from US\$ 72.9 million recorded in January 2021.

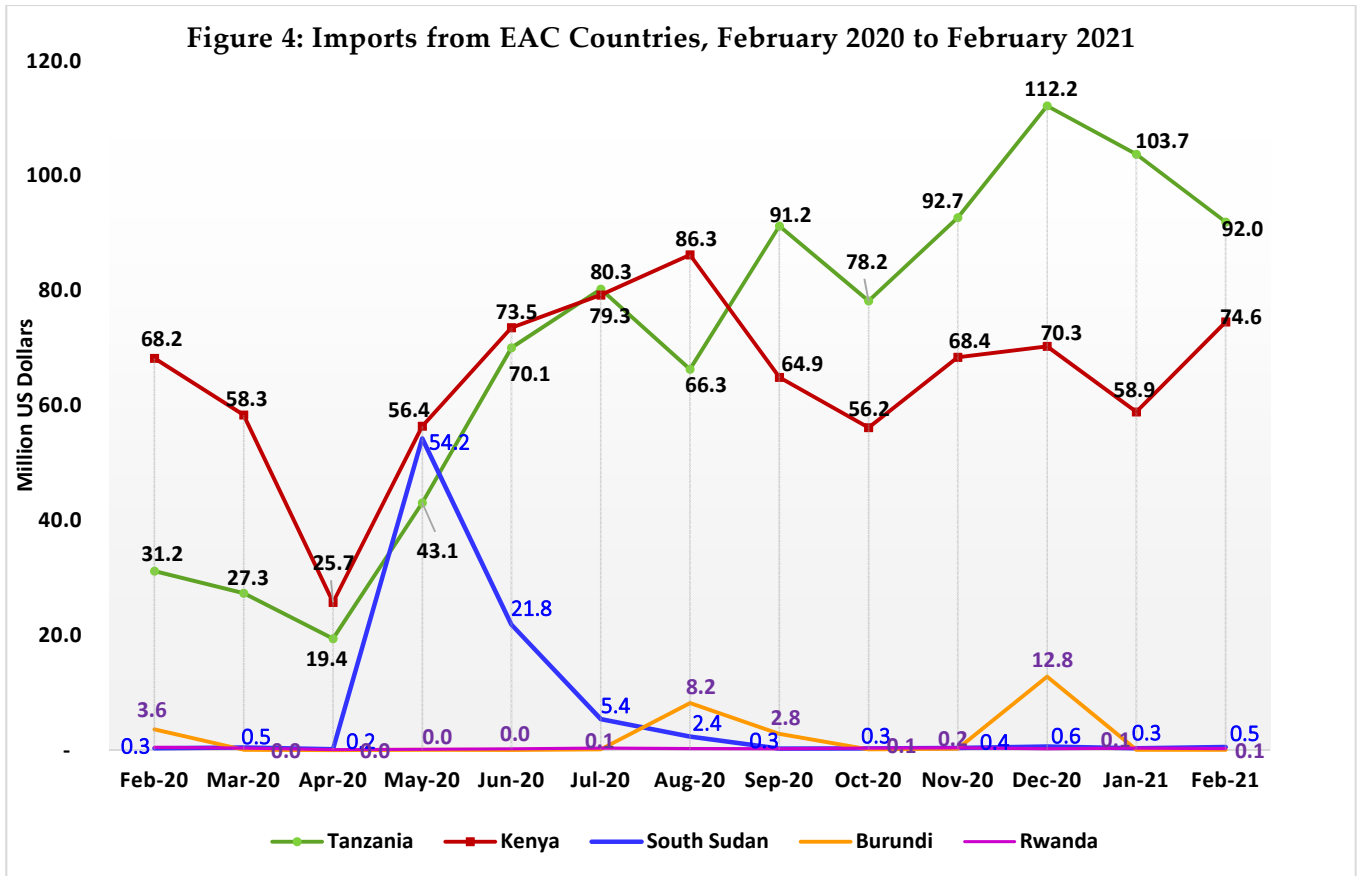
**Figure 3: Imports by Region and Percentage share, February 2021**

United States was the leading country of origin in the North American region whose contribution increased to US\$ 13.3 million in February 2021 from US\$ 5.3 million recorded in January 2021, see Figure 3 and Annex Table 8.

Notably, 93.8 percent of Uganda's imports originated from the regions of Asia, East African Community (EAC), Other Africa, Middle East and European Union in February 2021 as seen in Figure 3 below.

### **Formal Imports from East African Community (EAC) Countries**

In February 2021, Tanzania and Kenya were the major sources of Uganda's Imports among the EAC member Countries although their import bills decreased to US\$ 92.0 million and US\$ 74.6

million from US\$ 103.7 million and US\$ 58.9 million recorded in January 2021 respectively. See figure 4 below and Annex table 8.



### Exports by border station

Entebbe Airport, Malaba, Elegu, Busia, Mutukula and Mpondwe were the major border stations through which exports worth US\$ 389.6 million exited the country to different destinations in February 2021 accounting for 94.2 percent share of total exports while US\$ 348.6 million exited through the same borders in January 2021 representing 94.0 percent of total exports, see Annex Table 7.

### Imports by border station

Malaba, Entebbe Airport, Busia and Mutukula were the main entry border stations in February 2021 accounting for 99.8 US\$ percent (798.2 million) of Uganda's imports that got into the country compared to US\$ 657.9 million registered in January 2021, see Annex Table 9.
