
## Introduction

The bulletin presents International Merchandise trade statistics (exports and imports flows) between Uganda and the rest of the world as compiled from Customs and Non-Customs data sources. **International merchandise trade** statistics record all goods which add to, or subtract from, the stock of material resources of a country by entering (as imports) or leaving (as exports) its economic territory. The data compiled from customs and commodity authorities is herein referred to as Formal exports and imports.

The compilation of International Merchandise Trade Statistics is based on the General Trade System and coded according to Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System 2017 (HS2017) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev4) commodity nomenclatures as prescribed in the International Merchandise Trade Statistics manual 2010 (IMTS2010).

In February 2022, total trade increased by 15.4 percent to US\$ 1,088.1 million from US\$ 943.2 million recorded in January 2022. Total exports increased by 15.3 percent to US\$ 289.8 million in February 2022 from US\$ 251.4 million recorded in January 2022. Total imports flows increased by 15.4 percent to US\$ 798.3 million in February 2022 from US\$ 691.8 million registered in January 2022.

Annually, trade flows in February 2022 decreased by 10.6 percent from US\$ 1,217.7 million recorded in February 2021. Imports decreased by 0.8 percent to US\$ 798.3 million in February 2022 compared to US\$ 804.6 million recorded in February 2021. Similarly, Exports decreased by 29.9 percent to US\$ 289.8 million in February 2022 in comparison to US\$ 413.1 million registered in February 2021. See figure 1 and table 1 below.



The trade deficit increased to US\$ 508.5 million in February 2022 compared to a deficit of

US\$ 440.4 million recorded in January 2022. See Table 1 below.

#### **Performance of Formal Commodity Exports**

Coffee was the most exported commodity whose revenues increased to US\$ 72.2 million, accounting for 24.9 percent of total exports in February 2022 in comparison to US\$ 62.0 million generated in January 2022.

Beans and other Legumes was the second most exported commodity accounting for 4.4 percent of total exports in February 2022.

Fish and Fish Products, Sugar and Sugar Confectionary, Cocoa Beans, Iron and Steel, Animal/Veg Fats and Oils, Cement, Tea and Petroleum Products were also among Uganda's leading exported commodities. See Table2 below.

# Formal Exports by Region and Country of Destination

East African Community (EAC) was the leading destination of Uganda's formal exports throughout the period under review followed by, Other Africa, European Union and Asia.

In February 2022, formal exports to the EAC increased by 9.2 percent to US\$ 113.8 million, accounting for 39.3 percent of total formal exports compared to US\$ 104.2 million registered in January 2022. The leading country of destination was South Sudan with revenues worth US\$ 52.1 million representing 18.0 percent of total export earnings.

Other Africa was the second highest export destination whose earnings increased to US\$ 60.2 million in February 2022 compared to US\$ 52.9 million recorded in January 2022. D.R Congo, Sudan and Algeria were the major countries of destination in the region, with a combined market share of 18.5 percent in February 2022 compared to 19.2 percent registered in January 2022.

Export earnings from European Union increased by 8.7 percent to US\$ 60.0 million in February 2022 compared to US\$ 55.2 million receipted in January 2022.

Exports to Asia increased to US\$ 30.3 million in February 2022 from US\$ 21.5 million recorded in January 2022. Exports to India, Uganda's leading country of destination in Asia for the period under review slightly increased to US\$ 10.3 million in

February 2022 from US\$ 7.3 million registered in January 2022. China, Indonesia and Pakistan were also among the leading countries of destination in the region for the period under review.


Exports destined to North America increased by 69.9 percent to US\$ 10.8 million in February 2022 from US\$ 6.4 million recorded in January 2022. In particular, these were destined to the United States.

The market share for Middle East increased by 3.0 percent to US\$ 8.8 million in February 2022 from US\$ 6.2 million recorded in January 2022.

# Formal Exports to East African Community (EAC) Countries

South Sudan was the leading destination of Uganda's exports among the East African Community (EAC) member states in February 2022 accounting for 18.0 percent of total exports. Revenues generated were worth US\$ 52.1 million. This was a 30.0 percent increase in the export earnings from South Sudan in comparison to 15.2 percent decrease generated in January 2022.

Kenya was the second highest country of destination contributing 16.0 percent to Uganda's exports in February 2022 in comparison to the contribution of 17.9 percent recorded in January 2022. Trade activities between Uganda and Rwanda continued to decline during the period under review. See Figure 2 below and Annex Table 6.



#### **Performance of Formal Commodity Imports**

Petroleum products (petrol, diesel, paraffin, aviation fuel and related materials) were most imported products accounting for 15.9 percent of total imports in February 2022. The import bill for petroleum products was US\$ 127.3 million in February 2022 from US\$ 133.7 million recorded in January 2022. This was a 4.8 percent decline in the importation of petroleum products in February 2022 in comparison to January 2022.

Medical and pharmaceutical products were the second most imported commodity with import bill worth US\$ 95.7 million in February 2022 from US\$ 33.8 million registered in January 2022.

Road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles) also contributed to the import bill accounting for 6.5 percent of total imports. This was an increase of 13.7 percent to US\$ 51.9 million in February 2022 from US\$ 45.7 million recorded in January 2022

Plastics in primary forms, cereals and cereal preparations, iron and steel, fixed vegetable fats and oils, crude, refined or fractionated and machinery specialized for particular industries were among the leading imported products. See Table 3 below.

# Formal Imports by Region and Country of Origin

The Asian region continued to be the main source of Uganda's merchandise for the period under review. The region's import bill increased to US\$ 362.4 million in February 2022 from US\$ 291.6 million recorded in January 2022. China and India were the leading countries of origin of Uganda's imports in the region. China recorded an increase in import expenses worth US\$ 185.0 million from US\$ 114.7 million recorded in January 2022 while expenses to India increased to US\$ 89.4 million in February 2022 from US\$ 82.2 million recorded in January 2022.


Middle East ranked the second highest source of imports whose import bill increased to US\$ 133.3 in February 2022 from US\$ 116.3 million recorded in January 2022 contributing 16.7 percent to the total imports in February 2022. United Arab Emirates was the main contributing country within this region accounting for 9.7 percent of total imports in February 2022 from 7.8 percent registered in January 2022. Its imports bill increased by 43.7 percent to US\$ 77.7 million in February 2022 from US\$ 54.0 million registered in January 2022.

The East African Community (EAC) accounted for 10.9 percent of the imports bill in February 2022. Expenses to the region decreased to US\$ 87.0 million in February 2022 from US\$ 94.9 million recorded in January 2022.

Netherlands, Belgium, Germany, Turkey and United Kingdom were the leading sources of imports from European Union and Other Europe with import bills of US\$ 41.5 million, US\$ 24.5 million, US\$ 9.7 million, US\$ 9.4 million and US\$ 6.2 million respectively in February 2022 compared to US\$ 5.4 million, US\$ 14.1 million, US\$ 9.9 million, US\$ 28.4 million and US\$ 6.0 million recorded in January 2022.

Imports from Other African countries slightly increased to US\$ 28.0 million contributing 3.5 percent to the total imports in February 2022. South Africa was the main contributing country within this region accounting for 1.8 percent of total imports in February 2022 from 1.9 percent registered in January 2022. Its imports increased to US\$ 14.3 million in February 2022 from US\$ 13.2 million registered in January 2022.


Notably, in February 2022, 90.0 percent of Uganda's imports originated from the regions of Asia, Middle East, European Union and Africa. Seen Figure 3 below and annex table 8.



## Formal Imports from East African Community (EAC) Countries

In February 2022, Kenya and Tanzania were the major sources of Uganda's Imports among the EAC member states whose import bills were US\$ 61.5 million and US\$ 23.7 million respectively from US\$ 56.9 million and US\$ 36.2 million

registered in January 2022. Uganda's Imports from other member states were very low in the period under review. See figure 4 below and Annex table 8.



## Exports by border station

Malaba, Elegu, Busia, Entebbe Cargo/Airport, Mutukula and Padea were the major border stations through which exports worth US\$ 253.2 million exited the country to different destinations in February 2022 accounting for 87.4 percent of total exports in comparison to US\$ 220.5 million (87.8 percent) registered in January 2022, see Annex Table 7.

## Imports by border station

Malaba, Busia, Entebbe Cargo and Mutukula were the main entry border stations accounting for 99.6 percent (US\$ 795.3 million) and 99.5 percent (US\$ 688.3 million) of Uganda's imports recorded in February and January 2022 respectively. See Annex Table 9.
