It is important to note that, Statistics for the month of April excludes the Informal cross border trade, data collection resumed late March 2021 and data is still being processed. It will be included in the next bulletin.


#### Introduction

The bulletin presents International Merchandise trade statistics (exports and imports flows) between Uganda and the rest of the world as compiled from Customs and Non-Customs data sources. **International merchandise trade** statistics record all goods which add to, or subtract from, the stock of material resources of a country by entering (as imports) or leaving (as exports) its economic territory. The data compiled from customs and commodity authorities is herein referred to as Formal exports and imports.

The compilation of International Merchandise Trade Statistics is based on the General Trade System and coded according to Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System 2017 (HS2017) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev4) commodity nomenclatures as prescribed in the International Merchandise Trade Statistics manual 2010 (IMTS2010).

In April 2021, total trade decreased by 1.3 percent to US\$ 1,200.0 million from US\$ 1,215.5 million recorded in March 2021. Total exports decreased by 4.4 percent to US\$ 397.6 million in April 2021 from US\$ 415.7 million recorded in March 2021. Total imports flows increased by 0.3 percent to US\$ 802.4 million in April 2021 from US\$ 799.8 million registered in March 2021.

Annually, trade flows in April 2021 increased by 96.0 percent from US\$ 612.2 million recorded in April 2020. Imports increased by 97.7 percent to US\$ 802.4 in April 2021 compared to US\$ 405.8 million recorded in April 2020. Similarly, Exports increased by 92.6 percent to US\$ 397.6 million in April 2021 in comparison to US\$ 206.4 million registered in April 2020. See figure 1 and table 1 below.



The trade deficit increased to US\$ 404.8 million in April 2021 compared to a deficit of

US\$ 384.1 million recorded in March 2021. See Figure 1 above and Table 1 below.

#### **Performance of Formal Commodity Exports**

Gold and Gold compounds continued to be the leading exported commodity whose earnings increased to US\$ 175.6 million in April 2021 from US\$ 155.7 million receipted in March 2021, contributing 44.2 percent to total exports in April 2021 compared to a contribution of 37.5 percent registered in March 2021.

Coffee was the second most exported commodity whose revenues slightly decreased to US\$ 50.0 million, accounting for 12.6 percent of total exports in April 2021 in comparison to US\$ 53.5 million generated in March 2021.

Sugar & Sugar Confectionary was the third most exported commodity accounting for 3.2 percent of total exports in April 2021.

Cocoa beans, Animal/vegetable fats and oils, Petroleum products, Fish and Fish products, Cement, Tea, Iron and Steel, Tobacco Flowers were also among Uganda's leading exported commodities.

Maize exports declined further to US\$ 3.1 million in April 2021 from US\$ 5.4 million exported in March 2021. The reduction was attributed to the restrictions imposed on maize importation by Kenya due to the low quality standards of maize produced by Uganda. See Table2 below.

## Formal Exports by Region and Country of destination

Middle East continued to be the leading destination of Uganda's formal exports throughout the period under review followed by EAC, European Union, Other Africa and Asia.

In April 2021, formal exports to Middle East increased by 12.0 percent to US\$ 180.9 million, accounting for 45.5 percent of total formal exports compared to US\$ 161.6 million registered in March 2021. The leading country of destination was United Arab Emirates with revenues worth US\$ 178.1 million representing 44.8 percent of total export earnings.

East African Community (EAC) was the second largest region of destination although its export earnings decreased by 17.5 percent to US\$ 90.1 million in April 2021 compared to US\$ 109.2 million receipted in March 2021.

Exports to other African countries also decreased to US\$ 37.1 million in April 2021 compared to US\$ 50.7 million recorded in March 2021. D.R Congo and Sudan were the major countries of destination in the region, with a combined market share of 6.6 percent in April 2021 compared to 8.2 percent registered in March 2021.

Exports to Europe increased to US\$ 58.8 million in April 2021 from US\$ 58.0 million recorded in March 2021. Exports to Italy, Uganda's leading country of destination in Europe for the period under review increased to US\$ 15.4 million in April 2021 from US\$ 12.7 million registered in March 2021.


Germany, Netherlands, Belgium Spain, Turkey and Switzerland were also among the leading countries of destination in the region for the period under review.

The market share for the Asian region decreased to 6.3 percent, as a result of a reduction in the export earnings from the region to US\$ 25.2 million in April 2021 compared to US\$ 29.6 million recorded in March 2021. India, China, Hong Kong and Indonesia were among the leading destinations of Uganda's exports.

Exports destined to North America/Caribbean were worth US\$ 4.9 million in April 2021. In particular, these were destined to the United States and Canada, see Annex Table 6.

# Formal Exports to East African Community (EAC) Countries

Kenya was the leading destination of Uganda's exports among the East African Community (EAC) member states in April 2021 accounting for 9.5 percent of total exports. However, revenues generated decreased to US\$ 37.9 million. This was a 24.8 percent decrease in the export earnings from Kenya in comparison to US\$ 50.4 million earned in March 2021. South Sudan was the second country of destination for the period under review, contributing 9.5 percent to Uganda's exports in April 2021 in comparison to the contribution of 11.0 percent recorded in March 2021. Trade activities between Uganda and Rwanda are still low with only US\$ 0.2 million export earnings made in April 2021, see Figure 2 below and Annex Table 6.



#### **Performance of Formal Commodity Imports**

Gold, non-monetary (excl. gold ores and concentrates) continued being the main imported Commodity into the country whose import bill increased to US\$ 172.8 million in April 2021 from US\$ 112.5 million recorded in March 2021. The proportion of Gold to total imports stood at 21.5 percent in April 2021 compared to 14.1 percent registered in March 2021.

Petroleum products (petrol, diesel, paraffin, aviation fuel and related materials) were Uganda's second most imported products accounting for 13.9 percent of total imports in April 2021. The import bill for petroleum products was US\$ 111.7 million in April 2021 from US\$ 101.4 million recorded in March 2021. This was a

10.2 percent increase in the importation of petroleum products in April 2021 in comparison to March 2021.

Road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles) was the third most imported commodity with import bill worth US\$ 52.8 million in April 2021 from US\$ 57.2 million registered in March 2021.

Iron and steel, medical and pharmaceutical products, Cereals and cereal preparations, Plastics in primary forms, fixed vegetable fats and oils, crude, refined or fractionated, amongst others were among the leading imported products, see Table 3 below.

#### Formal Imports by Region and Country of Origin

The Asian region was the main source of Uganda's merchandise for the period under review. The region's import bill however decreased to US\$ 309.6 million in April 2021 from US\$ 333.3 million recorded in March 2021. China and India were the leading countries of origin of Uganda's imports in the region. China recorded a decrease in import expenses to US\$ 99.7 million from US\$ 132.7 million recorded in March 2021 while expenses to India decreased to US\$ 96.8 million in April 2021 million from US\$ 98.7 million recorded in March 2021.

The East African Community (EAC) ranked the second accounting for 21.1 percent of the imports bill in April 2021. Expenses to the region increased to US\$ 169.7 million in April 2021 from US\$ 158.1 million recorded in March 2021.


The Gambia and South Africa were the leading sources of imports from Other Africa region with import bills of US\$ 36.4 million and US\$ 17.0 million respectively in April 2021 compared to US\$ 20.4 million and US\$ 20.3 million recorded in March 2021.

Netherlands was the main country of origin for imports from European region with a slight decrease in expenses to US\$ 24.5 million in April 2021 from US\$ 37.7 million registered in March 2021.

Imports from Middle East decreased to US\$ 103.7 million contributing 12.9 percent to the total imports in April 2021. United Arab Emirates was the main contributing country within this region accounting for 8.3 percent of total imports in April 2021 from 7.7 percent registered in March 2021. Its imports increased by 8.2 percent to US\$ 66.2 million in April 2021 from US\$ 61.2 million registered in March 2021

United States was the leading country of origin in the North American region. In April 2021, its import bill decreased to US\$ 5.4 million from US\$ 8.2 million recorded in March 2021; see Figure 3 and Annex Table 8.


Notably, 86.4 percent of Uganda's imports originated from the regions of Asia, Africa and Middle East as seen in Figure 3 below.



#### Formal Imports from East African Community (EAC) Countries

In April 2021, Tanzania and Kenya were the major source of Uganda's Imports among the EAC member states whose import bills increased to US\$ 101.9 million and US\$ 66.7 million respectively from US\$ 95.6 million and US\$ 61.4

million registered in March 2021. Burundi and Rwanda were the least countries of origin of Uganda's Imports. See figure 4 below and Annex table 8.



#### Exports by border station

Entebbe Cargo/Airport, Malaba, Elegu, Busia, Mutukula and Mpondwe were the major border stations through which exports worth US\$ 374.6 million exited the country to different destinations in April 2021 accounting for 94.2 percent of total exports in comparison to US\$ 386.7 million (93.0 percent) registered in March 2021, see Annex Table 7.

#### Imports by border station

Malaba, Entebbe Cargo/Airport, Busia and Mutukula were the main entry border stations accounting for 99.6 percent (US\$ 799.3 million) and (US\$ 796.8 million) of Uganda's imports in April and March 2021 respectively, see Annex Table 9.
