
Introduction

The bulletin presents International Merchandise trade statistics (exports and imports flows) between Uganda and the rest of the world as compiled from Customs and Non-Customs data sources. **International merchandise trade** statistics record all goods which add to, or subtract from, the stock of material resources of a country by entering (as imports) or leaving (as exports) its economic territory. The data compiled from customs and commodity authorities is herein referred to as Formal exports and imports.

The compilation of International Merchandise Trade Statistics is based on the General Trade System and coded according to Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System 2017 (HS2017) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev4) commodity nomenclatures as prescribed in the International Merchandise Trade Statistics manual 2010 (IMTS2010).

In June 2021, total trade increased by 19.0 percent to US\$ 1,497.7 million from US\$ 1,258.9 million recorded in May 2021. Total exports decreased by 4.5 percent to US\$ 411.7 million in June 2021 from US\$ 431.1 million recorded in May 2021. Total imports flows increased by 31.2 percent to US\$ 1,086.0 million in June 2021 from US\$ 827.8 million registered in May 2021.

Annually, trade flows in June 2021 increased by 53.8 percent from US\$ 973.7 million recorded in June 2020. Imports increased by 70.5 percent to US\$ 1,086.0 million in June 2021 compared to US\$ 636.8 million recorded in June 2020. Similarly, Exports increased by 22.2 percent to US\$ 411.7 million in June 2021 in comparison to US\$ 336.9 million registered in June 2020. See figure 1 and table 1 below.



The trade deficit decreased to US\$ 674.4 million in June 2021 compared to a deficit of

US\$ 396.6 million recorded in May 2021. See Table 1 below.

Performance of Formal Commodity Exports

Gold and Gold compounds continued to be the leading exported commodity though its earnings decreased to US\$ 165.9 million in June 2021 from US\$ 191.6 million receipted in May 2021, contributing 40.3 percent to total exports in June 2021 compared to a contribution of 44.4 percent registered in May 2021.

Coffee was the second most exported commodity whose revenues increased to US\$ 58.6 million, accounting for 14.2 percent of total exports in June 2021 in comparison to US\$ 47.2 million generated in May 2021.

Sugar & Sugar Confectionary was the third most exported commodity accounting for 2.8 percent of total exports in June 2021.

Fish and Fish products, Cocoa Beans, Tea Animal/vegetable fats and oils, Petroleum products, Cement, Iron and Steel, Beans and other legumes, Maize and Tobacco were also among Uganda's leading exported commodities. See Table2 below.

Formal Exports by Region and Country of destination

Middle East continued to be the leading destination of Uganda's formal exports throughout the period under review followed by EAC, European Union, Other Africa and Asia.

However, in June 2021, formal exports to Middle East decreased by 12.8 percent to US\$ 171.2 million, accounting for 41.6 percent of total formal exports compared to US\$ 196.3 million registered in May 2021. The leading country of destination was United Arab Emirates with revenues worth US\$ 168.1 million representing 40.8 percent of total export earnings.

East African Community (EAC) was the second largest region of destination whose export earnings slightly increased by 25.0 percent to US\$ 102.8 million in June 2021 compared to US\$ 109.9 million receipted in May 2021.

Exports to other African countries increased to US\$ 47.2 million in June 2021 compared to US\$ 43.3 million recorded in May 2021. D.R Congo and Ethiopia were the major countries of destination in the region, with a combined market share of 8.2 percent in June 2021compared to 6.6 percent registered in May 2021.

Exports to Europe increased to US\$ 59.0 million in June 2021 from US\$ 55.8 million recorded in May 2021. Exports to Italy, Uganda's leading country of destination in Europe for the period under review increased to US\$ 19.2 million in June 2021 from US\$ 16.8 million registered in May 2021.


Germany, Netherlands, Belgium, Spain, Turkey and Switzerland were also among the leading countries of destination in the region for the period under review.

The market share for the Asian region increased to 5.3 percent, as a result of a slight rise in the export earnings from the region to US\$ 21.8 million in June 2021 compared to US\$ 16.5 million recorded in May 2021. India, Hong Kong, Indonesia and China were among the leading destinations of Uganda's exports.

Exports destined to North America/Caribbean were worth US\$ 9.1 million in June 2021. In particular, these were destined to the United States and Canada, see Annex Table 6.

Formal Exports to East African Community (EAC) Countries

Kenya was the leading destination of Uganda's exports among the East African Community (EAC) member states in June 2021 accounting for 11.3 percent of total exports. Revenues generated were worth US\$ 46.4 million. This was a 0.2 percent decrease in the export earnings from Kenya in comparison to the 22.5 percent increase generated in May 2021. South Sudan was the second country of destination contributing 9.4 percent to Uganda's exports in June 2021 in comparison to the contribution of 11.3 percent recorded in May 2021. Trade activities between Uganda and Rwanda are still low with only US\$ 0.1 million export earnings made in June 2021, see Figure 2 below and Annex Table 6.



Performance of Formal Commodity Imports

Gold, non-monetary (excl. gold ores and main concentrates) continued being the commodities imported into the country and whose import bill extremely increased to US\$ 344.6 million in June 2021 from US\$ 158.1 million recorded in May 2021. The proportion of Gold to total imports stood at 31.7 percent in June 2021 compared to 19.1 percent registered in May 2021. The rise in gold imports was due to high importation worth US\$ 207.8 million (60.3) percent from Zimbabwe.

Petroleum products (petrol, diesel, paraffin, aviation fuel and related materials) were Uganda's second most imported products accounting for 10.5 percent of total imports in June 2021. The import bill for petroleum products was US\$ 114.0 million in June 2021 from US\$ 102.5

million recorded in May 2021. This was an 11.2 percent increase in the importation of petroleum products in June 2021 in comparison to May 2021.

Cereals and cereal preparations were also among the main imported commodities with an import bill worth US\$ 58.0 million in June 2021 from US\$ 58.3 million registered in May 2021. The continuous increase in the import bill was due to high importation of rice from Tanzania

Road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles), iron and steel, fixed vegetable fats and oils, crude, refined or fractionated, medical and pharmaceutical products, Plastics in primary forms, machinery specialized for particular industries, amongst others were among the leading imported products, see Table 3 below.

Formal Imports by Region and Country of Origin

The Asian region was the main source of Uganda's merchandise for the period under review. The region's import bill was US\$ 397.1 million in June 2021 from US\$ 310.1 million recorded in May 2021. China and India were the leading countries of origin of Uganda's imports in the Asian region. China recorded an increase in import expenses worth US\$ 153.7 million from US\$ 132.7 million

recorded in May 2021 while expenses to India increased to US\$ 122.0 million in June 2021 compared to US\$ 81.7 million recorded in May 2021.

The East African Community (EAC) ranked the second accounting for 18.3 percent of the imports bill in June 2021. Expenses to the region slightly decreased to US\$ 198.5 million in June 2021 from US\$ 203.8 million recorded in May 2021.

Zimbabwe, South Africa and Egypt were the leading sources of imports from other Africa region with import bills of US\$ 207.9 million, US\$ 31.1 million and US\$ 14.6 million respectively in June 2021 compared to US\$ 0.1 million, US\$ 17.0 million and US\$ 12.8 million recorded in May 2021.


Netherlands was the main country of origin for imports from European region with a slight decrease in expenses to US\$ 25.0 million in June 2021 from US\$ 27.6 million registered in May 2021.

Imports from Middle East decreased to US\$ 95.6 million contributing 8.8 percent to the total imports in June 2021. United Arab Emirates was the main contributing country within this region accounting for 5.8 percent of total imports in June 2021 from 8.6 percent registered in May 2021. Its imports decreased by 11.4 percent to US\$ 62.7

million in June 2021 from US\$ 70.8 million registered in May 2021

United States was the leading country of origin in the North America/Caribbean region. In June 2021, its import bill decreased to US\$ 8.3 million from US\$ 16.9 million recorded in May 2021; see Figure 3 and Annex Table 8.


Notably, 90.3 percent of Uganda's imports originated from the regions of Asia, Africa and Middle East as seen in Figure 3 below.



Formal Imports from East African Community (EAC) Countries

In June 2021, Tanzania and Kenya were the major source of Uganda's Imports among the EAC member states whose import bills were US\$ 120.3 million and US\$ 77.5 million from US\$ 137.2 million and US\$65.6 million registered in May

2021. The increase in importation of rice led to high import bills to Tanzania. Burundi and Rwanda were the least countries of origin of Uganda's Imports. See figure 4 below and Annex table 8.



Exports by border station

Entebbe Cargo/Airport, Malaba, Elegu, Busia, Mutukula and Mpondwe continued to be the major border stations through which exports worth US\$ 380.9 million exited the country to different destinations in June 2021 accounting for 92.5 percent of total exports in comparison to US\$ 399.8 million (92.7 percent) registered in May 2021, see Annex Table 7.

Imports by border station

Malaba, Entebbe Cargo/Airport, Busia and Mutukula were the main entry border stations accounting for 99.9 percent (US\$ 1084.6 million) and (US\$ 825.2 million) of Uganda's imports in June and May 2021 respectively, see Annex Table9.
