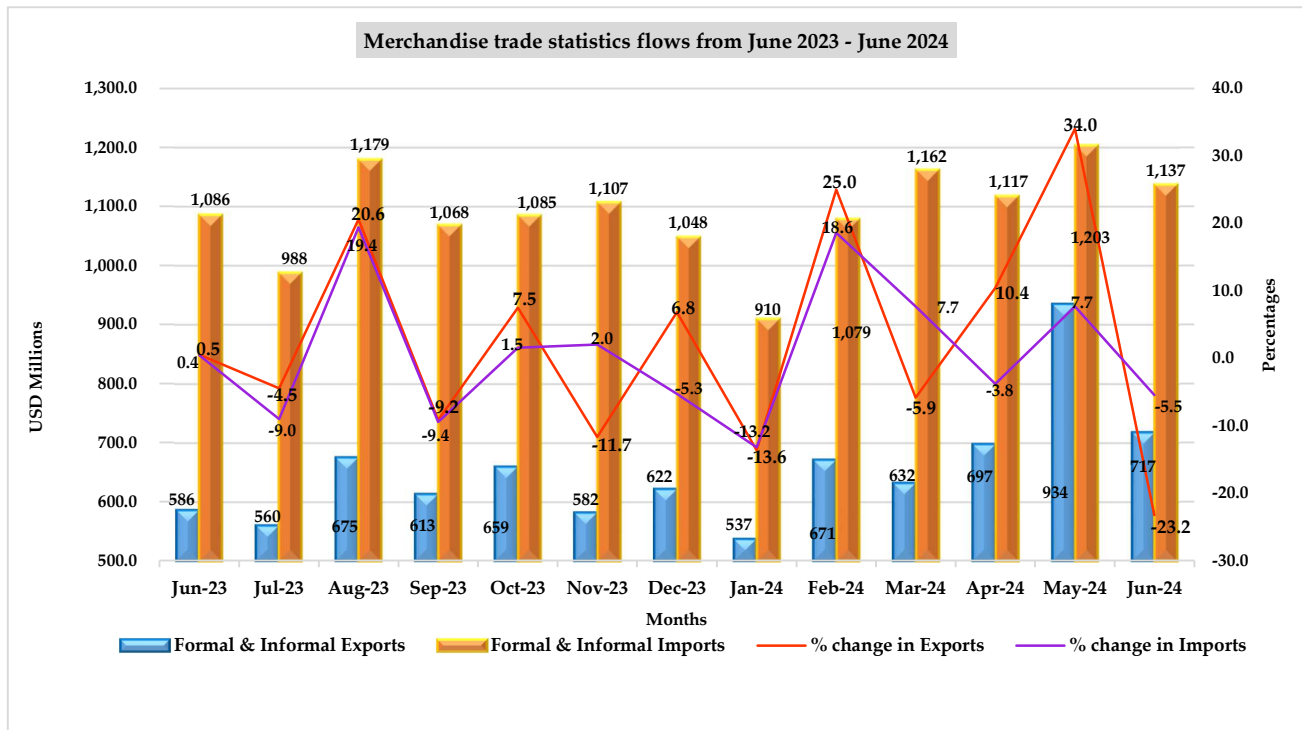
Introduction

This bulletin presents International Merchandise trade statistics (exports and imports flows) between Uganda and the rest of the world as compiled from customs, non-custom data sources and Informal Cross Border Trade (ICBT) Survey. International merchandise trade statistics records all goods which add to, or subtract from, the stock of material resources of a country by entering (as imports) or leaving (as exports) its economic territory. The data compiled from customs and commodities authorities is herein referred to as formal exports and imports while data from ICBT Survey is referred to as informal exports and imports.

The compilation of international merchandise trade Statistics is based on the General Trade System and coded according to Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System 2022 (HS2022) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev4) commodity nomenclatures as prescribed in the International Merchandise Trade Statistics manual 2010 (IMTS 2010).

In June 2024, total external trade decreased by 13.2 percent to US\$ 1,854.1 million from US\$ 2,137.1 million recorded in May 2024. Total exports decreased by 23.2 percent to US\$ 717.2 million in June 2024 from US\$ 934.4 million recorded in May 2024. The decrease in export earnings was due to low exports of gold and gold compounds whose contribution decreased to 34.7 percent (US\$ 248.9 Million) in June 2024 from 52.9 percent (US\$ 494.1 Million) recorded in May 2024. Total import flows decreased by 5.5 percent to US\$ 1,136.9 million in June 2024 from US\$ 1,202.7 million registered in May 2024.

Annually, trade flows in June 2024 increased by 10.9 percent to US\$ 1,854.1 million compared to US\$ 1,671.6 million recorded in June 2023. Imports bill increased by 4.7 percent to US\$ 1,136.9 million in June 2024 compared to US\$ 1,085.7 million recorded in June 2023. Similarly, Exports earnings increased by 22.4 percent to US\$ 717.2 million in June 2024 in comparison to US\$ 585.9 million registered in June 2023. See Figure1 and Table1 below.



The trade deficit increased to US\$ 419.6 million in June 2024 compared to a deficit of

US\$ 268.3 million recorded in May 2024. See Table1 below.

Performance of Formal and Informal Commodity Exports

The most exported commodity was gold and gold compounds though the earnings decreased to US\$ 248.9 million in June 2024 from 494.1 million recorded in May 2024.

Coffee was the second most exported commodity whose revenues increased to US\$ 162.4 million, accounting for 22.6 percent of total

exports in June 2024 in comparison to US\$ 127.1 million earned in May 2024.

Cocoa beans, sugar and sugar confectionary, maize, fish and fish products, petroleum products, iron and steel, cement, Beans and Other Legumes, Plastic Products, flowers and electric current were also among Uganda's leading exported commodities. See table 2 below

Formal and Informal Exports by Region and Country of Destination.

In June 2024, EAC was the major leading destination of Uganda's formal and informal exports followed by Middle East, European Union and Asia, North America/Caribbea, Other COMESA, Other Africa and Other Europe

Export earnings from EAC that accounted for 32.7 percent of the total exports, decreased by 2.9 percent to US\$ 234.4 million compared to US\$ 241.3 million registered in May 2024. The leading country of destination was Kenya with revenues worth US\$ 74.5 million representing 10.4 percent of total export earnings.

Middle East was the second highest export destination region whose earnings decreased to US\$

174.0 million in June 2024 from US\$ 302.4 million recorded in May 2024. United Arab Emirates was the leading country of destination in the region, with a market share of 23.6 percent in June 2024. Low exports of gold led to decrease of export earnings from UAE in June 2024

Export earnings from European Union increased by 22.3 percent to US\$ 126.6 million in June 2024 from US\$ 103.5 million receipted in May 2024. The leading destination countries in the region were; Italy, Germany, Netherlands, Spain and Belgium whose earnings increased to US\$ 110.4 million accounting for 15.4 percent to total exports in June 2024.

Total exports to Asia decreased to US\$ 125.5 million,

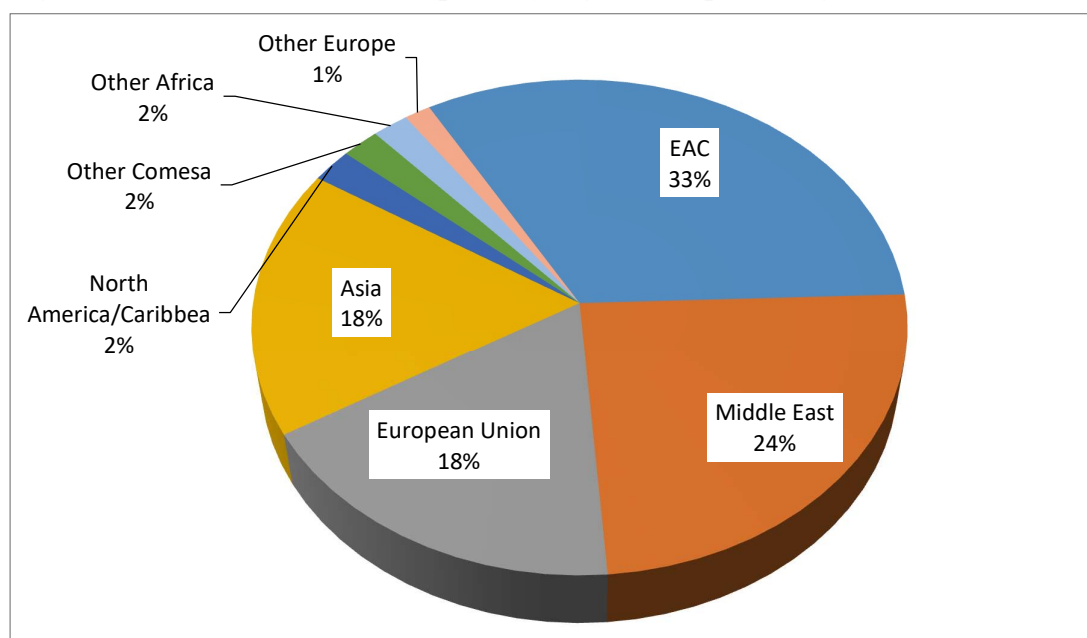
accounting for 18 percent of total exports compared to US\$ 238.5 million registered in May 2024. The leading country of destination was Hong Kong with revenues worth US\$ 80.0 million representing 11.1 percent of total export earnings.

Export earnings from North America decreased by 9.0 percent to US\$ 15.9 million generated in June 2024 from US\$ 17.5 million registered in May 2024. In particular, these exports were destined to United States and Canada.

The market shares for COMESA (excluding EAC) slightly increased to 2.0 percent with earnings of US\$ 14.7 million in June 2024 from US\$ 9.5 million generated in May 2024.

Exports destined to other Africa slightly increased to 2.0 percent to US\$ 14.1 million in June 2024 from US\$ 13.4 million recorded in May 2024. See figure 2 below and annex table 6.

Figure2: Formal and Informal Exports by region and percentage share in June 2024



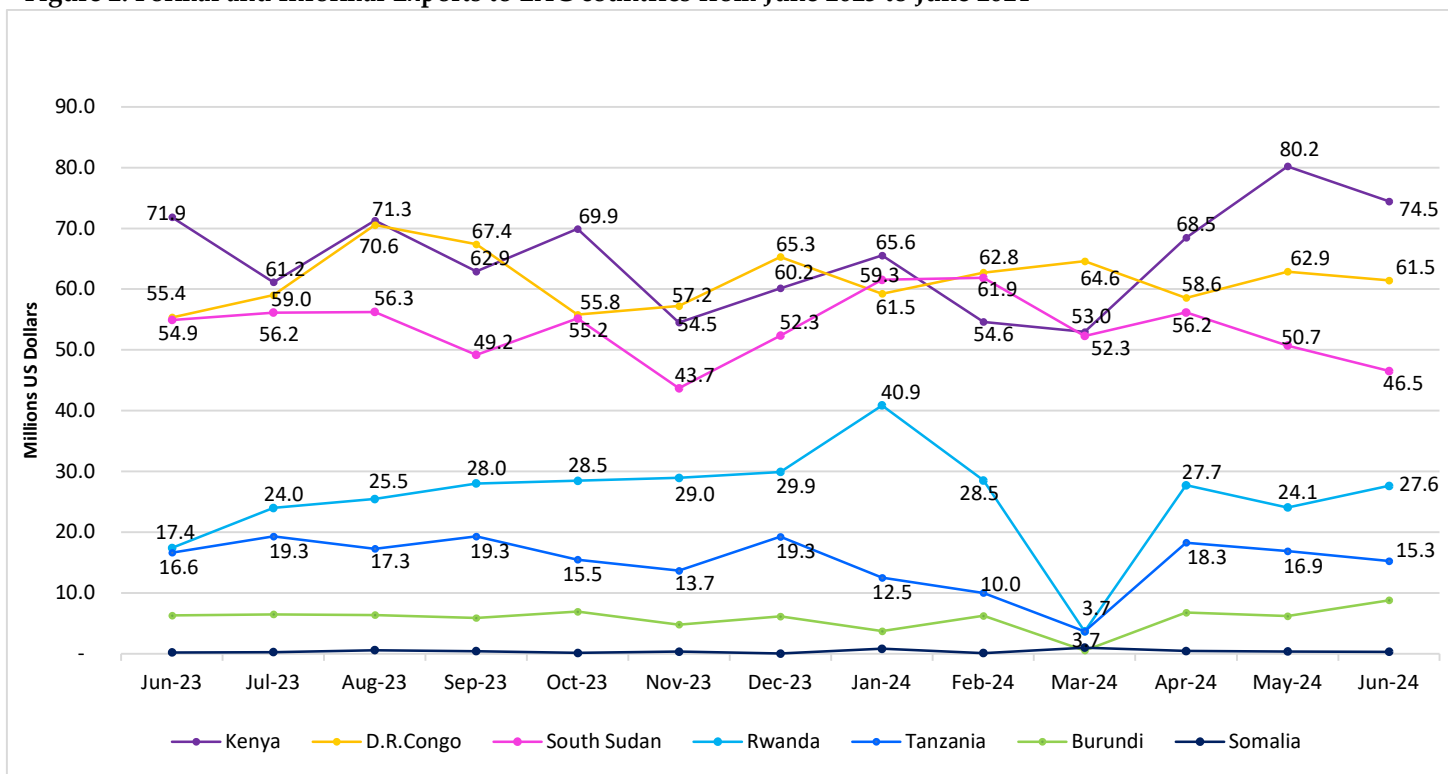
Formal and Informal Exports to EAC Countries

Kenya remained the leading destination of Uganda’s exports among the East African Community (EAC) member states with revenues worth US\$ 74.5 million accounting for 10.4 percent of the total exports in June 2024. This was a 7.1 percent decrease in the export earnings from Kenya after a 17.1 percent increase recorded in May 2024. D.R. Congo was the second highest export destination country accounting for 8.6 percent of Uganda’s exports, though the earnings decreased by 2.3 percent in June 2024 compared to a decrease 7.4 percent registered in May 2024.

Export earnings from South Sudan slightly decreased to US\$ 46.5 million contributing 6.5 percent to total exports in June 2024 compared to US\$ 50.7 million registered in May 2024.

Exports to Rwanda increased to US\$ 27.6 million while those to Tanzania decreased to US\$ 15.3 million respectively in June 2024 from US\$ 24.1 million and US\$ 16.9 million recorded in May 2024. See figure 3 below and annex table 6.

Performance of Formal and Informal Commodity Imports

Gold, non-monetary (excl. gold ores and concentrates) was the most imported product accounting for 22.8 percent of total imports in June 2024. The import bill for Gold, non-monetary (excl. gold ores and concentrates) decreased by 18.2 percent to US\$ 259.0 million in June 2024 from US\$ 316.7 million recorded in May 2024.

Petroleum, petroleum products and related materials were the second most imported product whose import bill slightly increased to US\$ 197.6 million in June 2024 from US\$ 195.8 million registered in May 2024.

Road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles) increased by 6.2 percent to US\$ 63.5 million in June 2024 from US\$ 59.8 million recorded in May 2024 thus accounting for 5.6 percent of total imports.

Cereals and cereal preparations, Iron and steel, Plastics in primary forms, general industrial machinery and equipment, nes, machine parts, nes and Fixed vegetable fats and oils, crude, refined or fractionated were also among the leading imported products. See table 3 below.

Formal and Informal Exports by Region and Country of Destination

The Asian region remained the main source of Uganda's merchandise for the period under review. The region's import bill increased to US\$ 412.1 million in June 2024 from US\$ 384.2 million recorded in May 2024. China and India were the

leading countries of origin of Uganda's imports in the region. Value of imports from China increased by 5.9 percent to US\$ 191.6 million in June 2024 from US\$ 180.9 million recorded in May 2024. Expenses to India also increased by 7.5 percent to US\$ 104.5

million in June 2024 from US\$ 97.3 million recorded in May 2024.

Import bill to Middle East decreased to US\$ 204.6 million in June 2024 from US\$ 217.3 million recorded in May 2024. United Arab Emirates was the leading source of imports from the region with import bill of US\$ 152.1 million in June 2024 compared to US\$ 157.1 million recorded in May 2024.

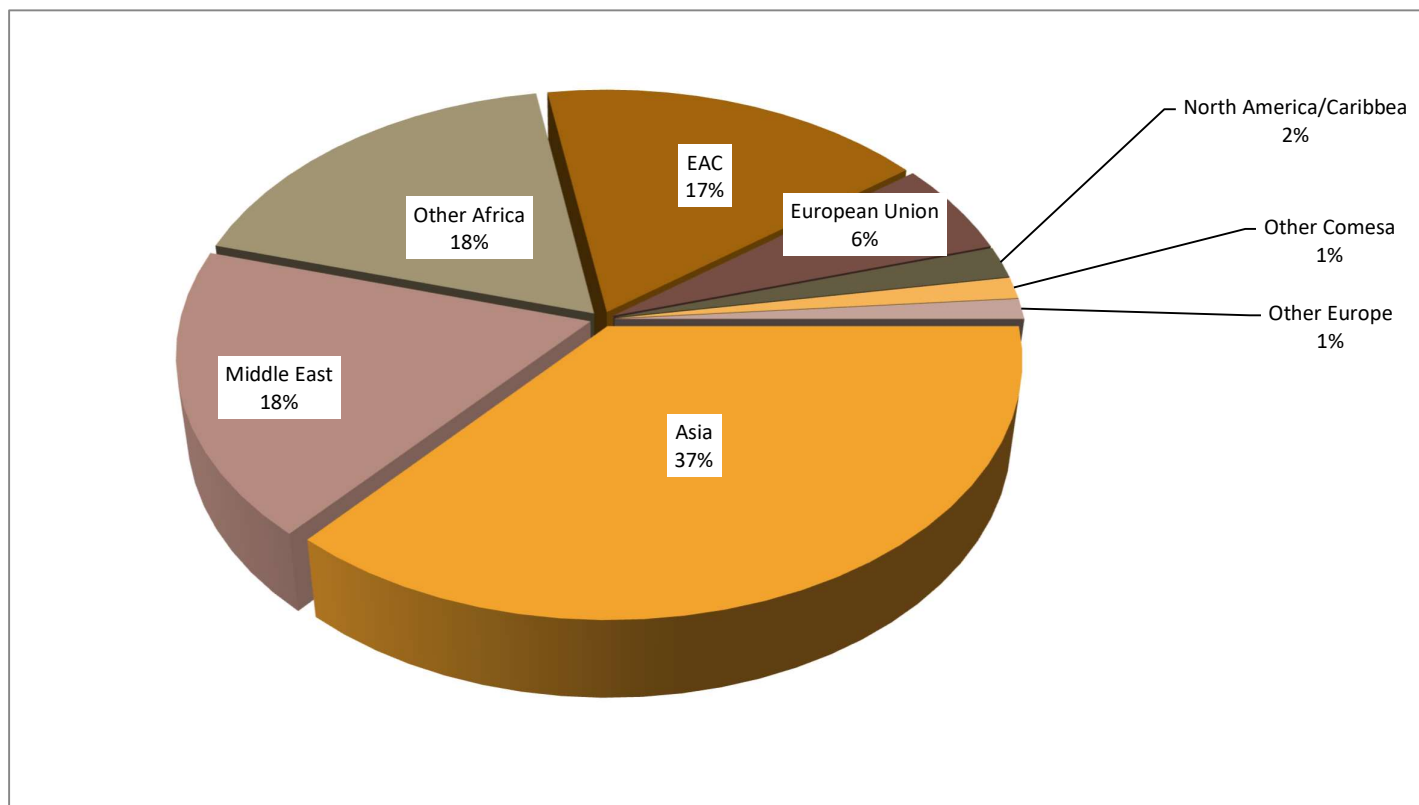
Import bill to other Africa increased by 12 percent to US\$ 202.5 million in June 2024 from US\$ 180.8 million registered in May 2024 accounting for 18 percent of the total imports recorded in June 2024.

EAC (East African Community) ranked the fourth

highest source of imports though its import bill slightly decreased to US\$ 194.3 million in June 2024 from US\$ 296.7 million recorded in May 2024 contributing 17 percent to the total imports in June 2024. The import bill from Tanzania decreased to US\$ 104.0 million accounting for 9.1 percent of total imports in June 2024 from US\$ 214.5 million registered in May 2024. Low imports of gold led to the decrease of import expenses to Tanzania in June 2024.

The Share of Import bill for European Union decreased by 12.4 percent in June 2024 from a 28.2 percent decrease registered in May 2024. Expenses to the region decreased to US\$ 66.0 million in June 2024 from US\$ 75.3 million recorded in May 2024. See figure 4 below and annex table 8.

Figure 4: Formal and Informal Imports by Region for the month of June 2024



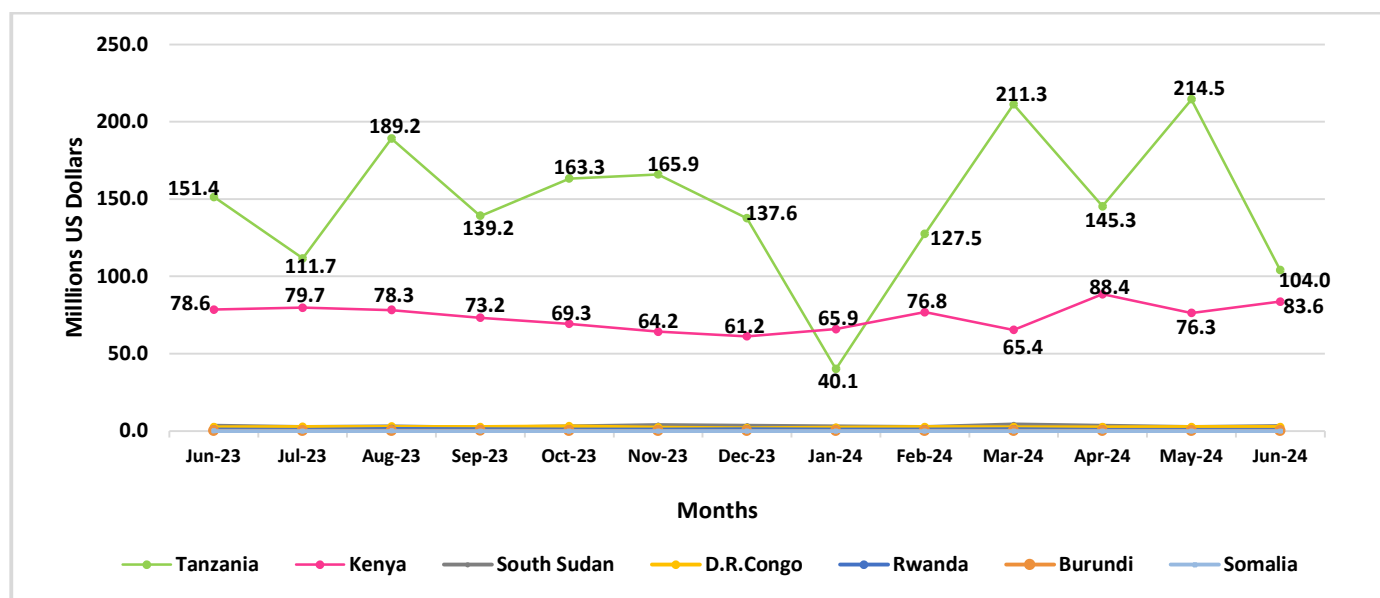
Formal and Informal Imports from East African Community (EAC) Countries

In June 2024, Tanzania and Kenya were the major sources of Uganda's total Imports among the EAC member states. The import bill for Tanzania decreased to US\$ 104.0 million while the import bill for Kenya increased to US\$ 83.6 million respectively

from US\$ 214.5 million and US\$ 76.3 million registered in May 2024.

Uganda's Imports from other member states were very low in the period under review. See figure 5 below and Annex table 8.
