

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FOREWORD

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten baskets of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index was rebased from 2005/2006 to 2009/2010, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS IV) that was conducted from May 2009 to April 2010. During the rebasing exercise, Kampala was further decomposed into three baskets from the two that has been existing. In addition, Fortportal Centre was incorporated into the Index. The rebased CPI is now classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP). This is a shift from the Central Product Classification (CPC) that was used in the earlier series.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten baskets mentioned above and indices are available from the EA level.

ACRONYMS AND DEFINITIONS

COICOP: Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose, is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyse individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

CPI: Consumer Price Index - a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

CPI basket: A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

Elementary aggregate (EA): The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

Inflation: A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.

Jevons price index: An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the unweighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

Laspeyres price index: The Laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

Outlet: The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue, a website etc. Also referred to as a "retail outlet", although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers

Outlier: A term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect

Price relative: A measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

Reference base: The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2009/10.

Weight: The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity or value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

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1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF CPI FOR OCTOBER 2020

1.1 Annual Inflation

The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending October 2020 is recorded at 4.5 percent the same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020. The stability in Annual Headline inflation is mainly attributed to the Annual Core Inflation that increased to 6.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 from 6.2 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. However, the increase in Core inflation was offset by Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation that declined to 1.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 2.3 percent registered for the year ended September 2020

The increase in Annual Core Inflation is attributed to Annual Services Inflation that is registered at 11.8 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 11.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Specifically, Transport services Inflation rose to 64.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 62.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. However, Other Goods Inflation registered 2.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020, see Table 1, 3 and 7.

The decrease in EFU was mainly due to Liquid Energy Fuels Inflation that declined to minus 4.8 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the minus 4.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Specifically, the Annual Inflation for Liquefied gas (propane) declined to minus 7.5 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to a minus 4.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Annual Inflation for Petrol registered minus 4.2 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the minus 4.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.




Figure 1: Uganda Headline Index and Annual Inflation for 3 major components, October 2019 – October 2020: (2009/2010 = 100)

The Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation registered a minus 6.1 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to a minus 6.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. The increase was mainly due to Annual Inflation for Vegetables that recorded a minus 2.8 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to a minus 3.7 percent recorded in September 2020. However, Annual Fruits Inflation decreased to minus 9.9 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the minus 8.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In particular, the Annual Inflation for Bananas decreased to minus 21.2 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the minus 19.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Also, See table 1. The twelve months' series for the Headline Index and the Annual Inflation for the three major components are shown in Figure 1.

1.2 Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical areas

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups reveal that Arua registered the highest Annual Inflation of 5.7 percent for the year ending October 2020 from 4.5 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. This was driven by Annual Transport Inflation that was registered at 25.7 percent for the year ending October 2020 from 19.6 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco Inflation increased to 11.9 percent for the year ending October 2020 from 1.1 percent registered for the year ended September 2020, see Table 8.

The second highest Inflation was registered in the basket of Kampala High Income that registered an Inflation of 5.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 from the 5.5 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. The main driver was Annual Transport Inflation that registered 27.2 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 23.4 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco Inflation increased to 1.5 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 1.3 percent registered for the year ended September 2020.




Figure 2: Annual Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical Areas for the year ending September 2020 and October 2020

The least Annual Inflation was registered in Fort portal at 2.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 2.8 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. The low inflation in the Centre was due to Transport Inflation that declined to 20.8 Percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 25.0 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other fuels Inflation declined to 5.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 6.3 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. *Annual Inflation figures for all the ten consumption baskets are shown in Figure 2 and Table 8.*

1.3 Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation for October 2020 rose by 0.2 percent compared to the 0.7 percent rise recorded in September 2020.

The increase in the Monthly Headline Inflation is attributed to the Food Crops and Related items Inflation that rose by 1.2 percent in October 2020 same rate recorded in September 2020. The increase in Monthly Food Crops and related Items Inflation was due to Fruits Inflation that went up by 6.4 percent in October 2020 compared to the 6.2 percent rise recorded in September 2020. In addition, Vegetables Inflation increased to a minus 1.6 percent from the 2.2 percent drop recorded in September 2020

The Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities Inflation increased by 0.4 percent during the month of October 2020 compared to 0.3 percent drop recorded in September 2020. The decrease was due to Monthly Liquid Energy Fuels that decreased by 1.2 percent in October 2020 compared to 1.3 percent drop recorded for September 2020. Specifically, the Monthly Propane Gas Inflation registered a 3.4 percent drop during the month of October 2020 compared to a 4.4 percent drop recorded in September 2020, See Table 1 & 2.

The Monthly Core Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 compared to the 0.7 percent rise registered in September 2020. The increase is due to Monthly Services Inflation that registered 0.3 percent rise for the month of October 2020 from the 1.9 percent increase registered in September 2020, See Table 1. *The detailed Monthly Inflation figures by COICOP Division are presented in Section 2 of the explanatory notes in the annex.*

2.0 ANNUAL INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS


The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 3.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased to a minus 0.1 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. The decrease was due to Annual Food Inflation that dropped to a minus 0.1 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

In addition, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation decreased to minus 0.8 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to minus 0.7 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. *Figure 3 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation from September 2018 to September 2020.*

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Annual Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics increased to 3.9 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that increased to 3.9 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Annual Tobacco Inflation increased to 4.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 3.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

03 Clothing and Footwear




Figure 4: Clothing and Footwear Annual Inflation Trends; October 2018 - October 2020.

The Annual Inflation for Clothing and Footwear decreased to 1.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Clothing Inflation that decreased to 0.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.0 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Footwear Inflation increased to 4.4 percent for the year ending October 2020 same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020. Figure 4 shows the trends of Clothing and Footwear Inflation from October 2018 to October 2020.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance & repair of the dwelling, Water Supply, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

The Annual Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels decreased to 1.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. The decrease was attributed to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that registered 2.8 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 4.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Water Supply and Services relating to the dwelling Inflation dropped to minus 0.1 percent for the year ending October 2020 same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020. However, Maintenance & Repair of the Dwelling Inflation increased to 2.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation recorded 0.7 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Annual Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance registered 1.4 percent rise for the year ending October 2020 same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020. The rise was mainly due to Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation that registered 10.9 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 9.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Glassware, Tableware, Household Utensils Inflation increased to 3.8 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 3.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Household Appliances Inflation increased to 0.4 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.2 percent drop recorded for the year ended September 2020. Household Textiles Inflation increased to 2.7 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

06 Health

The health Division comprises of Medical Products, Appliances & Equipment, Outpatient Services, and Hospital Services.

The Annual Inflation for Health decreased to 1.9 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.0 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Annual Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment Inflation that decreased to 1.2 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Annual Outpatient Services Inflation recorded 2.5 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

Annual Hospital Services Inflation registered 4.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 4.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Transport and Personal Equipment and Transport Services.

Annual Inflation for Transport increased to 29.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to the 27.7 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was mainly attributed to Transport Services Inflation that recorded 64.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 62.5 percent registered for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Purchase of Vehicles Inflation increased to 7.7 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 3.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Operation of Personal Transport Equipment Inflation registered a minus 0.2 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to minus 0.1 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

08 Communication

Communication includes Postal services, Telephones and Telefax equipment and Telephone and Telefax services.

The Annual Inflation for Communication increased to 1.5 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Annual Telephone and Telefax Equipment Inflation that increased to 5.1 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 4.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Telephone & Telefax Services Inflation recorded a minus 1.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.2 percent drop recorded for the year ended September 2020. However, Annual Postal Services Inflation recorded 21.9 percent same as that recorded for the year ended September 2020.

09 Recreation and Culture

Recreation and Culture comprises of Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment, Recreational & Cultural services, Newspapers, books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

Annual Inflation for Recreation and Culture decreased to 0.7 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Recreational & Cultural Services Inflation decreased to 0.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared 0.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation decreased to 2.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. However, Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation that increased to minus 1.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to a minus 1.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Package Holidays Inflation recorded 0.5 percent rise for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.5 percent drop recorded for the year ended September 2020.

10 Education

Education comprises of Pre-Primary and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education not definable by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education registered 0.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Pre-Primary and Primary Education Inflation registered 0.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

Secondary Education Inflation registered 0.5 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Tertiary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 the same rate recorded for the year ended September2020. Also, Education not definable by level recorded 0.0 percent for the year ending October 2020 same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

Restaurants and Hotels comprises of catering services and accommodation services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels increased to 1.6 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Catering Services Inflation that increased to 2.1 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Accommodation services Inflation increased to 0.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 0.1 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous goods and services comprises of Personal Care such as hairdressing salons and personal grooming establishments, Personal Effects such as Jewellery, clocks and watches, Insurance and Other services such as passport fees, photocopying and radio announcements.

The Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation for the year ending October 2020 declined to 1.6 percent compared to 2.0 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. This was due to Personal Care Inflation that decreased to 1.2 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 1.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. In addition, Personal Effects Inflation decreased to 1.5 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to 2.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. However, Insurance Inflation decreased to minus 0.3 percent for the year ending October 2020 compared to minus 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2020. Other Services n.e.c Inflation registered 4.4 percent for the year ending October 2020 same rate recorded for the year ended September 2020.

3.0 MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages registered a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded for September 2020. This was due to Food Inflation that recorded a drop of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.3 percent decrease recorded in September 2020. However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation registered 0.1 percent rise for the month of October 2020 from the 0.4 percent recorded in September 2020.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics registered an increase of 2.6 percent during the month of October 2020 from the 0.5 percent recorded for the month of September 2020. This was mainly due to Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that registered an increase of 2.6 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.6 percent recorded for September 2020. In addition, Tobacco Inflation registered a rise of 2.4 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.2 percent decrease recorded for the month of September 2020.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear registered decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 1.0 percent rise recorded in September 2020. This was due to Clothing Inflation that registered a drop of 1.2 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.9 percent increase recorded in September 2020. However, Footwear Inflation registered an increase of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 1.6 percent rise recorded in September 2020.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels registered an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of October 2020 from 0.2 percent drop recorded in September 2020. This was attributed to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that recorded an increase of 0.7 percent for the month of October 2020 from 0.4 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020. In addition, Actual Rentals Inflation registered an increase of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from 0.0 percent recorded for the month of September 2020. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services relating to the dwelling Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020. However, Maintenance and repair of the dwelling Inflation registered a drop of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.6 percent increase recorded for the month of September 2020.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.5 percent decrease recorded for the month of September 2020. This was due to Goods and Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation that registered a 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 1.5 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020. In addition, Furniture and Furnishings, Carpets and Other Floor Coverings Inflation registered a decrease of 0.5 percent for the month of October 2020 same rate recorded for the month of September 2020. Household Appliances Inflation also registered a decrease of 0.3 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020. Household Textiles Inflation registered a decrease of 0.4 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020. Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 1.5 percent decrease recorded for the month of September 2020. However Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation registered an increase of 1.6 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.8 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020.

06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020. This was mainly due to Outpatient Services Inflation that registered a drop of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.1 percent increase recorded for the month of September 2020. In addition, Hospital Services Inflation

registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 same rate recorded for the month of September 2020.

However, Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment Inflation registered a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 same rate recorded for the month of September 2020.

07 Transport

Transport Inflation registered an increase of 0.9 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 4.5 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020. This was due to Transport Services Inflation that recorded a rise of 0.9 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 7.2 percent increase recorded during the month of September 2020. In addition, Purchase of Vehicles Inflation registered a rise of 2.4 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 2.9 percent increase recorded during the month of September 2020.

Operation of Personal Transport Equipment Inflation registered a drop of 0.5 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.1 percent increase recorded during the month of September 2020.

08 Communication

The Monthly Inflation for Communication registered 0.1 percent rise for the month of October 2020 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of September 2020. Telephone and Telefax Equipment Inflation recorded a rise of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.1 percent increase recorded during the month of September 2020. In addition, Telephone and Telefax Services Inflation that registered a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded during the month of September 2020. Postal services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 same as that recorded for the month of September 2020.

09 Recreation and Culture

Monthly Recreation and Culture Inflation registered an increase of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.2 percent decrease recorded during the month of September 2020. This was mainly due to Recreational and Cultural Services Inflation registered an increase of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2020 same rate recorded for the month of September 2020. In addition, Package Holidays Inflation registered 0.5 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of September 2020. Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation that registered a 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 1.6 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020. However, Newspapers, Books and Stationery Inflation registered a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020.

10 Education

Monthly Inflation for Education registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 same as that recorded for the month of September 2020. This was due to Pre-primary & Primary Education,

Secondary Education, Tertiary Education and Education not defined by Level Inflation all registering 0.0 percent for the month of September 2020.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

The Monthly Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels registered 0.4 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of September 2020. Catering Services Inflation recorded an increase of 0.3 percent for the month of October 2020 from 0.2 percent rise recorded during the month of September 2020. In addition, Accommodation Services Inflation registered an increase of 0.4 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 0.5 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous Goods and Services Inflation for the month of October 2020 registered 0.0 percent from the 0.6 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020. This was due to Other Services n.e.c Inflation that recorded a 0.0 percent for the month of October 2020 from the 5.0 percent increase recorded for the month of September 2020. In addition, Insurance Inflation registered 0.0 percent during the month of October 2020 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2020. However, Personal Effects Inflation registered an increase of 0.4 percent during the month of October 2020 from the 1.3 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2020.
