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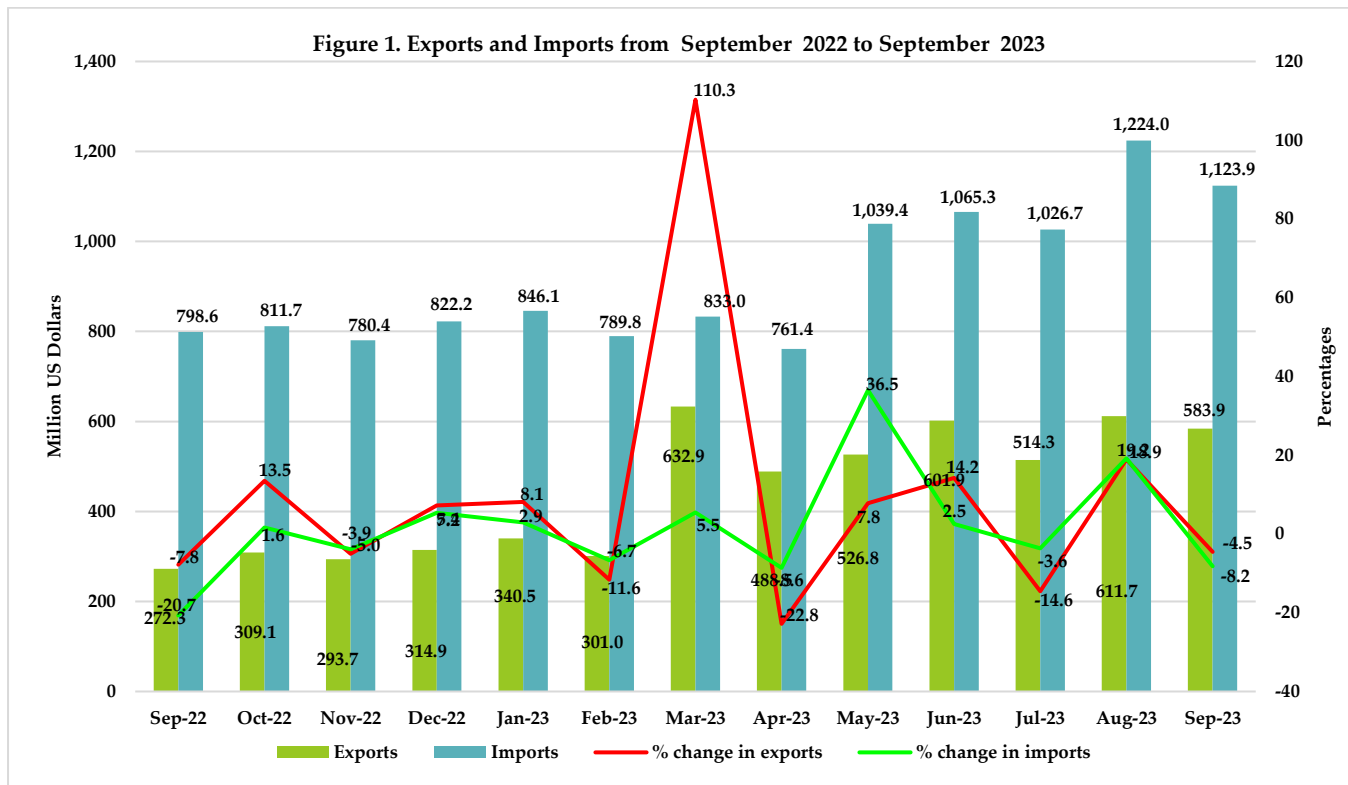
Introduction

This bulletin presents International Merchandise trade statistics (exports and imports flows) between Uganda and the rest of the world as compiled from custom and non-custom data sources. International merchandise trade statistics records all goods which add to, or subtract from, the stock of material resources of a country by entering (as imports) or leaving (as exports) its economic territory. The data compiled from customs and commodities authorities is herein referred to as formal exports and imports.

The compilation of international merchandise trade Statistics is based on the General Trade System and coded according to Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System 2022 (HS2022) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev4) commodity nomenclatures as prescribed in the International Merchandise Trade Statistics manual 2010 (IMTS2010).

In September 2023, total external trade decreased by 7.0 percent to US\$ 1,707.8 million from US\$ 1,835.7 million recorded in August 2023. Total exports decreased by 4.5 percent to US\$ 583.9 million in September 2023 from US\$ 611.7 million recorded in August 2023. The decrease in export earnings in September 2023 was due to exports of coffee, gold and gold compounds which decreased by 2.0 percent and 0.4 percent respectively yet they are the main leading export commodities. Total import flows decreased by 8.2 percent to US\$ 1,123.9 million in September 2023 from US\$ 1,224.0 million registered in August 2023.

Annually, trade flows in September 2023 increased by 59.5 percent to US\$ 1,707.8 million from US\$ 1,070.9 million recorded in September 2022. Imports increased by 40.7 percent to US\$ 1,123.9 million in September 2023 compared to US\$ 798.6 million recorded in September 2022. Similarly, Exports increased by 114.4 percent to US\$ 583.9 million in September 2023 in comparison to US\$ 272.3 million registered in September 2022. See figure 1 and table 1 below.



The trade deficit decreased to US\$ 540.0 million in September 2023 compared to a deficit of

US\$ 612.2 million recorded in August 2023. See Table 1 below.

Performance of Formal Commodity Exports

The most exported commodity was Gold and gold compounds with decrease of revenue earnings to US\$ 225.9 million in September 2023 from 239.4 million recorded in August 2023.

Coffee was the second most exported commodity whose revenue declined to US\$ 94.4 million, accounting for 16.2 percent of total

exports in September 2023 in comparison to US\$ 111.4 million earned in August 2023.

Iron and steel, maize, fish and fish products, Sugar and Sugar Confectionary were also among Uganda's leading exported commodities. See Table 2 below.

Formal Exports by Region and Country of Destination.

In September 2023, EAC was the major leading destination of Uganda's formal exports followed by Middle East, Asia, European Union, Other COMESA, Other Africa, North America and Other Europe.

Formal exports to the EAC increased to US\$ 201.4 million, accounting for 34.5 percent of total formal exports compared to US\$ 184.6 million registered in August 2023.

The leading countries of destination were Kenya, South Sudan and D.R. Congo with revenues worth US\$ 53.4 million, US\$ 48.6 million and US\$ 40.9 million representing 9.2 percent, 8.3 percent and 7.0 percent of total export earnings respectively.

Middle East was the second highest export destination region whose earnings decreased to US\$ 133.9 million in September 2023 from US\$ 149.5 million recorded in August 2023. United Arab Emirates was the leading country of destination in the region, with a market share of 22.3 percent in September 2023.

Export earnings from Asia decreased by 5.5 percent to US\$ 125.3 million in September 2023 from US\$ 132.6 million received in August 2023. The leading destination countries in the region were; India, Hong Kong, China and Vietnam whose earnings increased to US\$ 119.6 million accounting for 95.4 percent of the exports to Asia in September 2023.

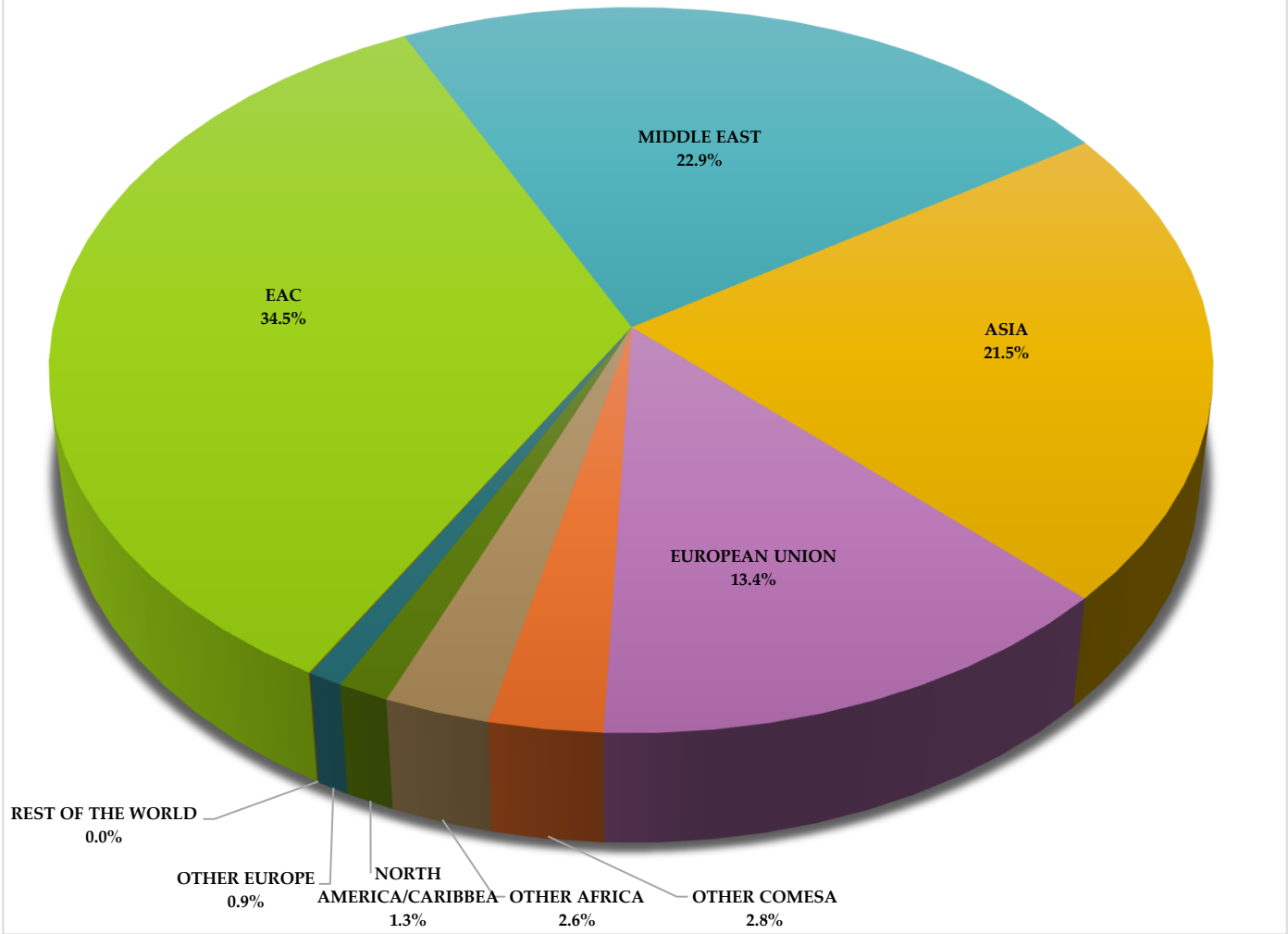
Export earnings from European Union slightly increased by 0.7 percent to US\$ 78.5 million, accounting for 13.4 percent of total formal exports compared to US\$ 78.0 million registered in August 2023. The leading countries of destination were Germany, Italy, Netherlands and Belgium with total revenues worth US\$ 63.9 million representing 10.9 percent of total export earnings.

The market shares for Other COMESA (excluding EAC) decreased to 2.8 percent from 4.8 percent with earnings of US\$ 16.6 million in September 2023 from US\$ 29.2 million recorded in August 2023.

Exports destined to Other Africa decreased by 25.9 percent to US\$ 15.4 million in September 2023 from US\$ 20.7 million recorded in August 2023.

Export earnings from North America decreased by 9.7 percent to US\$ 7.5 million generated in September 2023 from US\$ 8.3 million registered in August 2023. In particular, these exports were destined to United States and Canada. See Figure 2 below and annex Table 6.

Formal Exports to EAC Countries

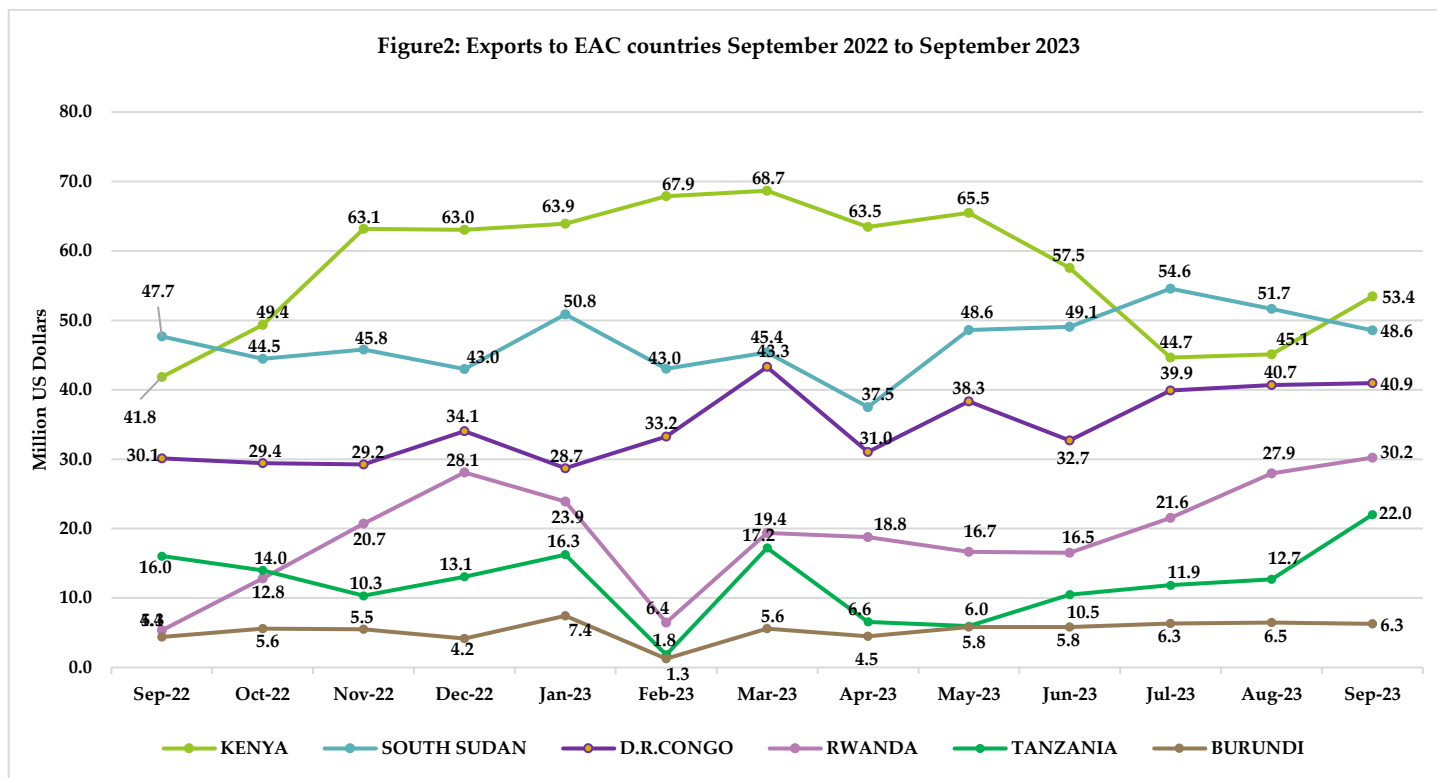
Kenya remained the leading destination of Uganda’s exports among the East African Community (EAC) member states in September 2023 accounting for 9.2 percent of the total exports. Revenues generated were worth US\$ 53.4 million. This was a 18.5 percent increase in the export earnings from Kenya from a 1.0 percent increase recorded in August 2023.

South Sudan was the second highest export destination country accounting for 8.3 percent of Uganda’s exports in September 2023, which was a slight decrease in the share from 8.4 percent registered in August 2023.

Export earnings from D.R. Congo increased to US\$ 40.9 million contributing 7.0 percent to total exports in September 2023 compared to US\$ 40.7 million registered in August 2023.

Exports to Rwanda and Tanzania increased to US\$ 30.2 million and US\$ 22.0 million in September 2023 from US\$ 27.9 million and US\$ 12.7 registered in August 2023 while those to Burundi slightly decreased to US\$ 6.3 million from US\$ 6.5 million recorded in August 2023. Performance of Formal Commodity Imports

Gold, non-monetary (excl. gold ores and concentrates) was the most imported product accounting for 19.1 percent of total imports in September 2023. The import bill for Gold decreased by 18.9 percent to US\$ 215.2 million in September 2023 from US\$ 265.3 million recorded in August 2023.

Petroleum, petroleum products and related materials were the second most imported product with increase in import bill to US\$ 197.2 million in September 2023 from US\$ 192.5 million registered in August 2023.

Road vehicles (including air-cushion vehicles) increased by 23.0 percent to US\$ 89.4 million in September 2023 from US\$ 72.7 million recorded in August 2023 thus accounting for 8.0 percent of total imports.

Iron and steel, Medical and pharmaceutical products, Cereals and cereal preparations, Machinery specialized for particular industries and plastics in primary forms were also among the leading imported products. See Table 3 below.

Formal Imports by Region and Country of Origin

The Asian region remained the main source of Uganda's merchandise for the period under review. The region's import bill decreased to US\$ 452.2 million in September 2023 from US\$ 474.0

million recorded in August 2023. China and India were the leading countries of origin of Uganda's imports in the region. Value of imports from China decreased by 6.0 percent to US\$ 227.8 million in

September 2023 from US\$ 242.4 million recorded in August 2023 while those from India decreased by 6.4 percent to US\$ 105.0 million in September 2023 from US\$ 112.1 million recorded in August 2023.

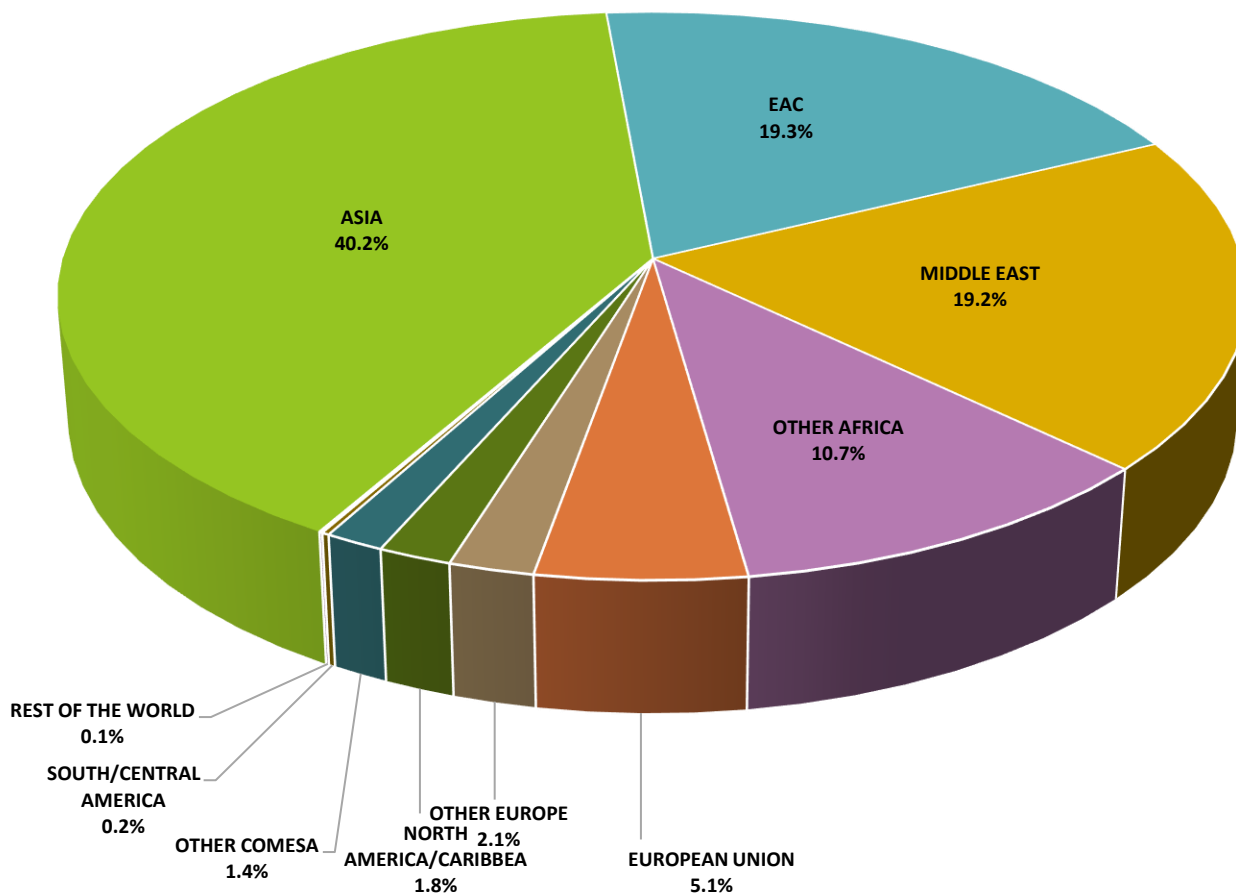
EAC (East African Community) ranked the second highest source of imports though its import bill decreased to US\$ 216.9 million in September 2023 from US\$ 281.3 million recorded in August 2023 contributing 19.3 percent to the total imports in September 2023. The import bill from Tanzania decreased to US\$ 139.9 million accounting for 12.5 percent of total imports in September 2023 from US\$ 190.5 million registered in August 2023. High imports of Gold led to increase of import expenses to Tanzania in

August 2023.

Import bill to Middle East slightly decreased to US\$ 215.3 million in September 2023 from US\$ 218.1 million. United Arab Emirates was the leading source of imports from the region with import bill of US\$ 168.5 million in September 2023 compared to US\$ 167.6 million recorded in August 2023.

The Share of Import bill for Other Africa increased to 10.7 percent in September 2023 from 9.6 percent registered in August 2023. Expenses to the region increased to US\$ 120.5 million in September 2023 from US\$ 117.4 million recorded in August 2023. See figure 4 below and annex Table 8.

Figure 4: Exports by Region for the month of September 2023

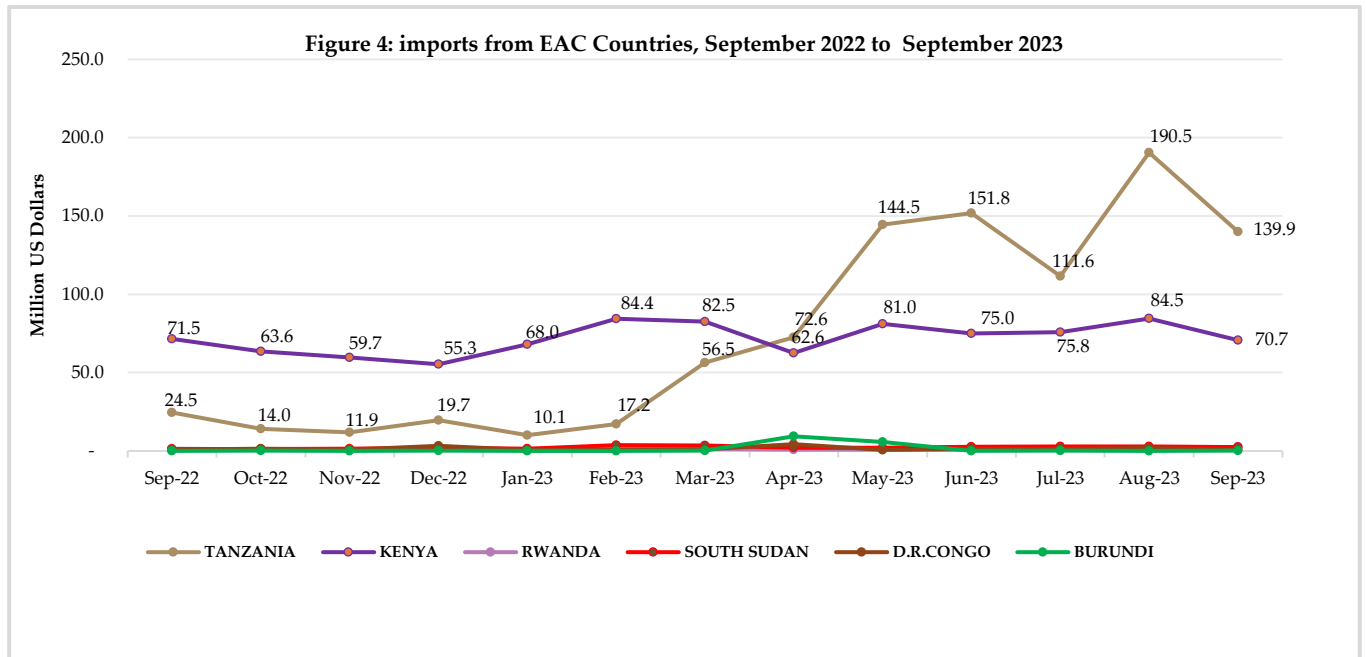


Formal Imports from East African Community (EAC) Countries

In September 2023, Tanzania and Kenya were the major sources of Uganda's Imports among the EAC member states. The import bills for Tanzania and Kenya which are the leading origins decreased to US\$ 139.9 million and US\$ 70.7 million respectively from US\$ 190.5 million and US\$ 84.5 million

registered in August 2023.

Uganda's Imports from other member states were very low in the period under review. See figure 5 below and Annex table 8.



Exports by border station

Entebbe Cargo, Malaba, Elegu, Katuna, Busia, Mutukula and Mpondwe were the major border stations through which exports worth US\$ 552.8 million exited the country to different destinations in September 2023 accounting for 94.7 percent of total exports in comparison to US\$ 581.3 million (95.0 percent) registered in August 2023, see Annex Table 7.

Imports by border station

Malaba, Entebbe Cargo, Busia and Mutukula were the main entry border stations accounting for 99.2 percent (US\$ 1,114.6 million) of Uganda's imports recorded in September 2023 from 99.1 percent (US\$ 1,213.3 million) recorded in August 2023. See Annex Table 9.
