CONSTRUCTION SECTOR INDICES AND INFLATION RATES

NOVEMBER 2021

HIGHLIGHTS

Annual Changes

The Inflation rate as measured by the Construction Sector Index for the 12 months to November 2021 for inputs of the Construction Sector (*covering material prices, wage rates & equipment hire rates*) increased to 1.9 percent up from 1.8 percent increase registered in October 2021, Figure 1.

The main contributors to the annual increase in input prices are;

- An increase of 1.3 percent in prices of inputs for Non-Residential Buildings for the year ending November 2021.
- An increase of 1.9 percent in prices of inputs for Residential Buildings for the year ending November 2021.
- An increase of 3.5 percent in prices of inputs for Civil Works subsector for the year ending November 2021.

Monthly Changes

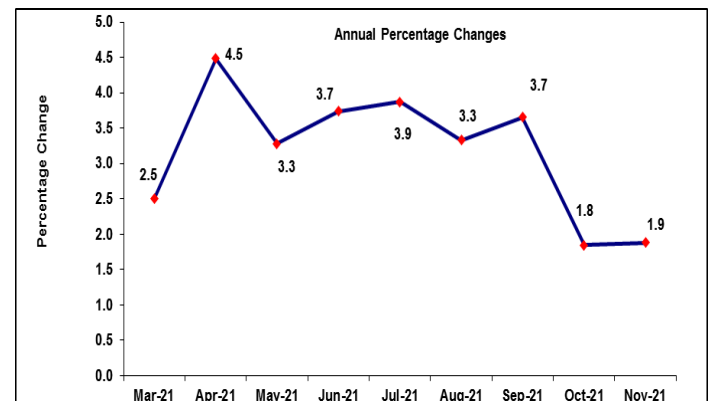
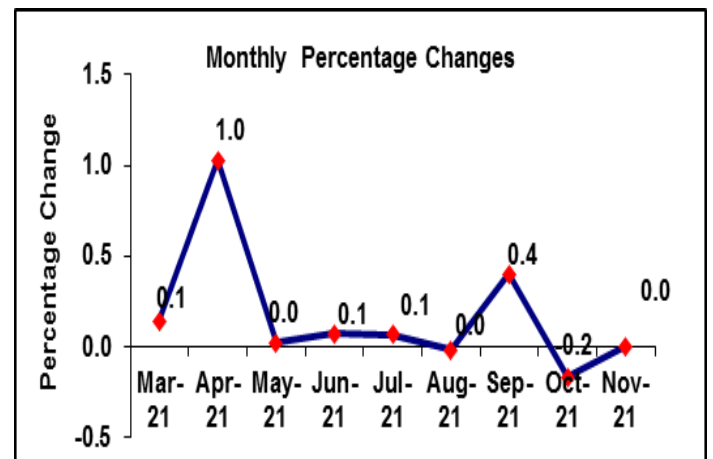


Fig 2: Monthly Price Changes at the Whole Construction Sector Index, March 2021 to November 2021

On a month to month basis, the Price Index of inputs into the Construction Sector was recorded at 0.0 percent in the month of November 2021 compared to 0.2 percent decrease registered for the month of October 2021, Figure 2.

This was mainly due to;

- A 0.4 percent increase in prices of inputs for Civil Works.
- A decrease in prices of 0.1 percent and 0.2 percent for Non-Residential and Residential Buildings respectively.

Monthly prices of Material inputs and Equipment hire that showed an increasing trend in November 2021 were; Diesel which increased by 2.4 percent, Lime increased by 1.69 percent and Roofing sheets increased by 0.1 percent.

Fig 1: Annual Price Changes at the Whole Construction Sector Index, March 2021 to November 2021

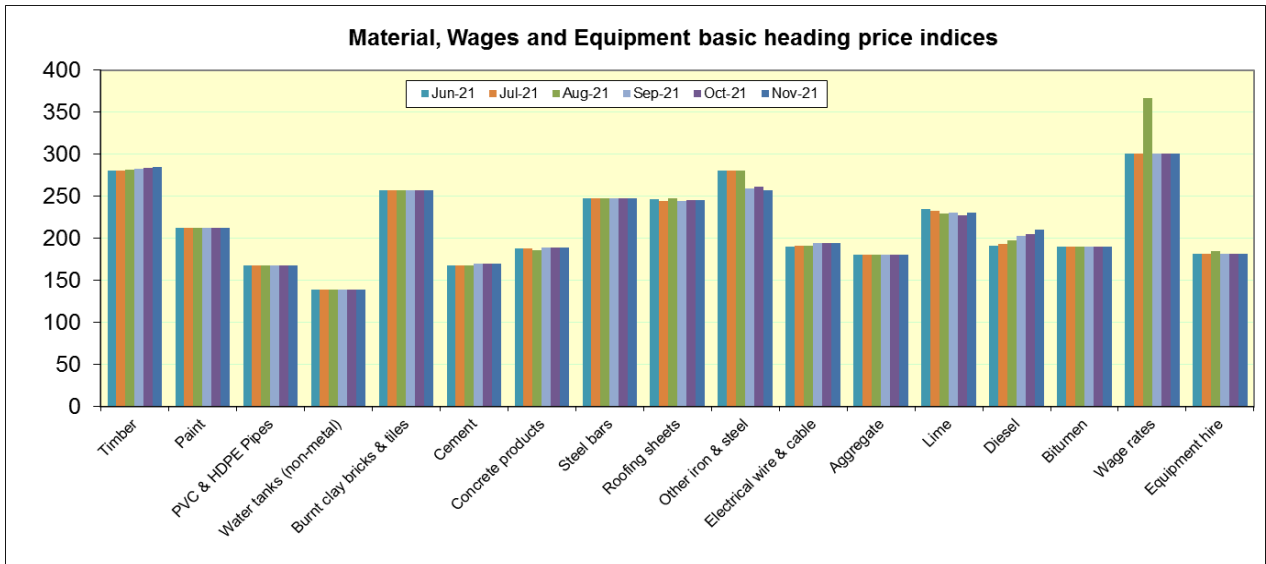

Explanatory Notes on the Statistical Release

The data presented in this Statistical Release are indices designed to show price changes in each period. On page 1 there is a short commentary highlighting the main changes observed.

The graphs on page 1 are derived from Table A “Construction Sector Price Indices” on page 2 of the statistical release. The first graph shows the percentage price changes for the whole sector for each month for a period of 9 months. The second graph shows the monthly average percentage price changes in each month for the whole sector.

The charts on page 6 above show the indices for the latest Six months for each basic heading. If the bars in the charts are at almost the same level, then they indicate very little (if any) change in prices. An increase in the height of the bars indicates an increase in the prices while a reduction in the height implies a decline in prices.
