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## FOREWORD

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten centres of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index has been rebased from 2009/2010 to 2016/2017, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS VI) that was conducted from July 2016 to June 2017. The rebased CPI is classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP 2018). This is a shift from the COICOP 1999 that was used in the earlier series. COICOP 2018 is more detailed than the previous (1999) version, responding to the users' need for more detail, and addresses several other issues that required revision of the classification. The new COICOP of 2018 reflects the significant changes in goods and services in some areas, improved links of COICOP to other classifications, and addresses emerging statistical and policy needs of regional and international users.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten centres mentioned above and rebased indices are available from July 2017 to date at EA level.

## ACRONYMS AND DEFINITIONS

**COICOP:** Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose, is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyse individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

**CPI:** Consumer Price Index - a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

**CPI basket:** A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

**Elementary aggregate (EA):** The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

**Inflation:** A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.

**Jevons price index:** An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

**Laspeyres price index:** The Laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

**Outlet:** The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue, a website etc. Also referred to as a "retail outlet", although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers

**Outlier:** A term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect

**Price relative:** A measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

**Reference base:** The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2016/17.

**Weight:** The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity or value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

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## 1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF UGANDA CPI FOR SEPTEMBER 2023

### 1.1 Annual Headline Inflation

The Annual Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Uganda for the 12 months to September 2023 is registered at 2.7 percent compared to 3.5 percent registered in the year ended August 2023.

The slowdown in the Annual Inflation is largely attributed to the Annual Core inflation, which slowed down to 2.4 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 3.3 percent registered in the year ended August 2023. The main driver for the Annual Core Inflation slowdown was the Annual Other Goods Inflation that registered 3.1 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 4.4 percent registered in the year ended August 2023. Specifically, Rice inflation registered 5.2 percent in September 2023 compared to 17.8 percent registered in August 2023, Mukene inflation registered negative 5.4 percent in September 2023 compared to 22.3 percent registered in August 2023, Sugar inflation registered 34.0 percent in September 2023 compared to 43.2 percent registered in August 2023, and Maize Flour inflation registered negative 3.8 percent in September 2023 compared to 1.0 percent registered in August 2023. In addition, Annual Services inflation slowed down to 1.6 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 2.0 percent registered in the year ended August 2023. This is attributed to Annual Restaurants and Accommodation Services inflation that decelerated to 4.2 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 5.0 percent registered in August 2023.

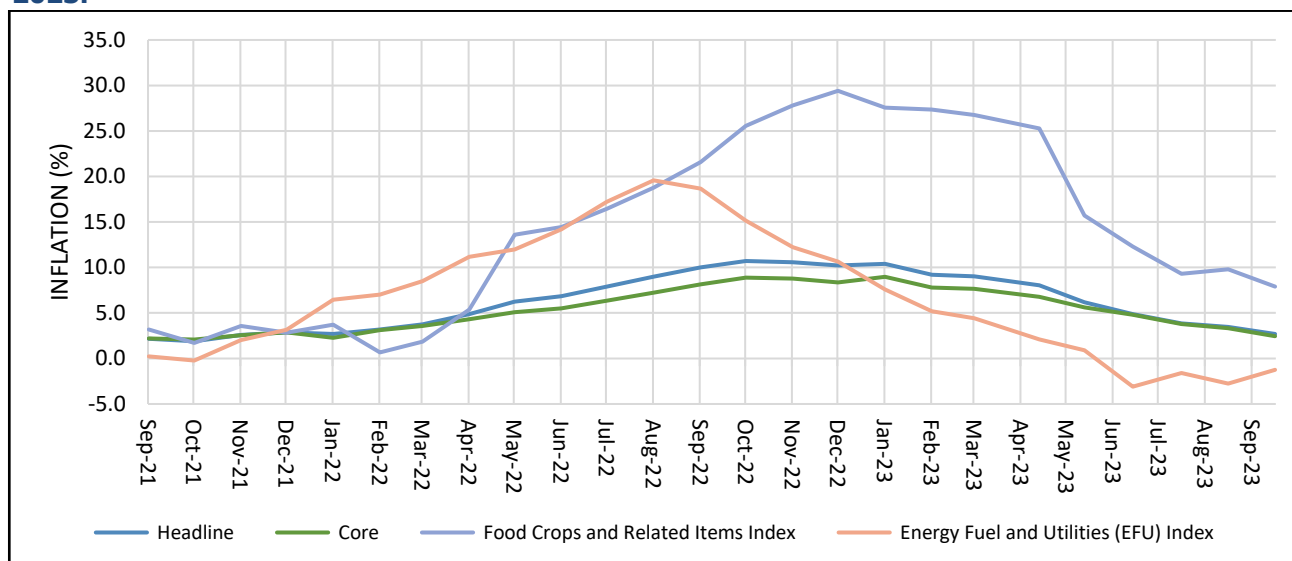
The other driver to the slowdown in the Annual Inflation was the Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation that registered 7.9 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 9.8 percent registered in the year ended August 2023. This is attributed to Dry Beans inflation that registered 8.0 percent in September 2023 compared to 20.1 percent registered in August 2023, Cassava Fresh inflation that registered 6.0 percent in September 2023 compared to 18.9 percent registered in August 2023, Bananas(Matoke) inflation that registered negative 3.3 percent in September 2023 compared to 2.4 percent registered in August 2023 and Mangoes Inflation that registered 3.5 percent in September 2023 compared to 26.1 percent registered in August 2023.

However, the Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) inflation was registered at negative 1.2 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to negative 2.7 percent registered in the year ended August 2023. This was mainly due to Liquid Energy Fuels inflation that registered negative 14.7 percent in September 2023 compared to negative 20.1 percent in August 2023. In particular, Petrol inflation registered negative 17.6 percent in September 2023 compared to negative 24.5 percent in August 2023. Diesel inflation slowed down to negative 19.2 percent in September 2023 compared to negative 22.7 percent in August 2023. In addition, Charcoal inflation slowed down to 15.9 percent in September 2023 compared to 22.0 percent registered in August 2023 as shown in Table 1 and Figure 1.

## 1.2 Annual Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), the main drivers to the registered inflation were commodities under; 'Food and Non- alcoholic beverages' whose inflation registered 5.1 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 7.7 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, 'Information and Communication' whose inflation was registered at 2.4 percent for the year ending September 2023 compared to 3.3 percent for the year ended August 2023, 'Health' whose inflation was registered at 1.8 percent for the year ending September 2023 compared to 2.2 percent for the year ended August 2023, 'Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods' whose inflation registered 6.6 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 7.9 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' whose inflation registered 3.0 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 3.4 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, 'Education Services' whose inflation registered 3.8 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 7.5 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' whose inflation registered 4.2 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 5.0 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, Transport whose inflation registered minus 4.8 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to minus 6.9 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, and 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' whose inflation registered minus 0.5 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to minus 0.9 percent registered in the year ended August 2023.

However, 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation registered 2.5 percent in the year ending September 2023 compared to 2.4 percent registered in the year ended August 2023, 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' inflation was registered at 4.0 percent for the year ending September 2023 compared to 3.7 percent for the year ended August 2023 and 'Clothing and Footwear' inflation registered 2.8 percent in the year ending September 2023 the same rate registered in the year ended August 2023, as shown in Table 3 below.

### 1.3 Monthly Inflation.

The Monthly Headline Inflation for September 2023 increased by 0.7 compared 0.6 percent rise recorded in the month of August 2023 as shown in Table 4 below.

The main driver was the monthly Food Crops and Related items inflation that increased by 3.8 percent in September 2023 from the 3.6 percent rise recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to monthly Vegetables, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses inflation that increased by 3.5 percent in September 2023 from the 2.9 percent rise recorded in August 2023. Specifically, Cooking Bananas (Matooke) inflation increased by 26.1 percent in September 2023 from the 7.1 percent rise recorded in August 2023, Mangoes inflation increased by 15.3 percent in September 2023 from the 33.3 percent rise recorded in August 2023, Irish potatoes inflation increased by 7.0 percent in September 2023 from the 8.0 percent drop recorded in August 2023 and Sweet Potatoes inflation increased by 5.5 percent in September 2023 compared to the 6.4 percent drop recorded in August 2023.

Monthly Core inflation rose by 0.3 percent in September 2023 from 0.2 percent rise recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to monthly Services inflation that recorded 0.5 percent rise in September 2023 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in August 2023. In addition, Other goods inflation recorded 0.2 percent in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) inflation increased by 1.7 percent in September 2023 compared to 1.1 percent rise registered in August 2023. The rise in EFU was mainly due to Liquid fuels inflation that increased by 5.3 percent in September 2023 from 0.1 percent drop recorded in August 2023. Specifically, Diesel inflation increased by 3.4 percent in September 2023 from 0.6 percent drop recorded in August 2023. In addition, Petrol inflation increased by 8.4 percent in September 2023 compared to the 0.0 percent recorded in August 2023. However, Monthly Solid energy fuels inflation decreased by 0.4 percent in September 2023 from the 3.9 percent rise registered in August 2023.

#### **1.4 Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions**

The monthly headline inflation for September 2023 registered 0.7 percent from the 0.6 percent recorded in the month of August 2023. This was mainly attributed to the Monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that increased by 1.1 percent in September 2023 from the 1.5 percent rise recorded in August 2023. Monthly Transport inflation increased by 2.4 percent in the month of September 2023 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in August 2023. Monthly Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics Inflation increased by 1.3 percent in September 2023 from 0.2 percent drop recorded in August 2023. Monthly Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Inflation increased by 0.9 percent in September 2023 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in August 2023. Monthly Recreation, sport and culture inflation increased by 0.7 percent from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in August 2023. Monthly Clothing and Footwear Inflation increased by 0.4 percent in September 2023 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Monthly Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods inflation recorded 0.3 percent in September 2023 from 0.1 percent rise registered in August 2023. Monthly Health inflation recorded 0.0 percent in September 2023 from the 0.1 percent rise registered in August 2023. Education Services inflation registered 0.0 percent in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. Monthly Insurance and Financial Services inflation recorded 0.0 percent for September 2023 the same rate registered for August 2023.

However, Monthly Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels inflation decreased by 0.1 percent in September 2023 from the 0.9 percent rise recorded in August 2023. Monthly Restaurants and Accommodation Services inflation decreased by 0.1 percent in September 2023 from 0.6 percent rise recorded in August 2023. and Monthly Information and Communication inflation decreased by 0.1 percent for September 2023 from the 0.0 percent registered for August 2023 as indicated in Table 6 below.

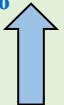

### 1.5 Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical areas

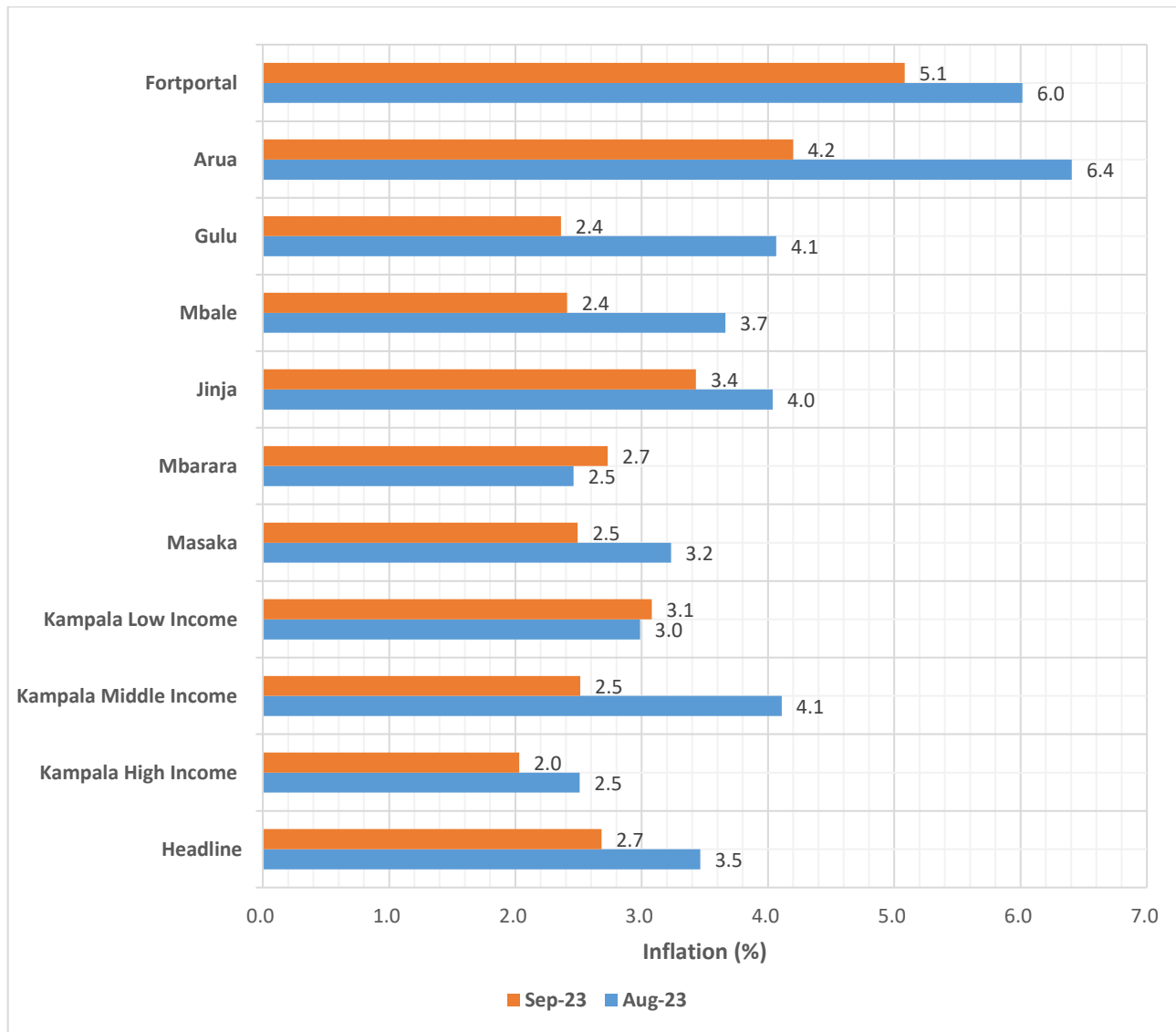
Analysis by geographical areas and income groups revealed that Fort portal registered the highest inflation of 5.1 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 6.0 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly driven by annual 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation that registered 3.1 percent in September 2023 compared to 0.9 percent registered in August 2023. In addition, Annual 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' inflation registered 0.6 percent in September 2023 compared to minus 2.6 percent registered in August 2023.

The second highest inflation was registered in Arua at 4.2 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 6.4 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly driven by annual 'Clothing and Footwear' inflation that registered 4.4 percent in September 2023 compared to 2.9 percent registered in August 2023. In addition, Annual 'Health' inflation registered 0.7 percent in September 2023 compared to minus 0.7 percent in August 2023.

The least annual inflation was registered in Kampala High at 2.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 2.5 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to the annual inflation for 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' that registered 6.5 percent in September 2023 compared to 8.8 percent registered in August 2023. In addition, annual 'Restaurant and Accommodation Services' inflation registered 3.2 percent in September 2023 compared to 7.2 percent in August 2023.

The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 6.

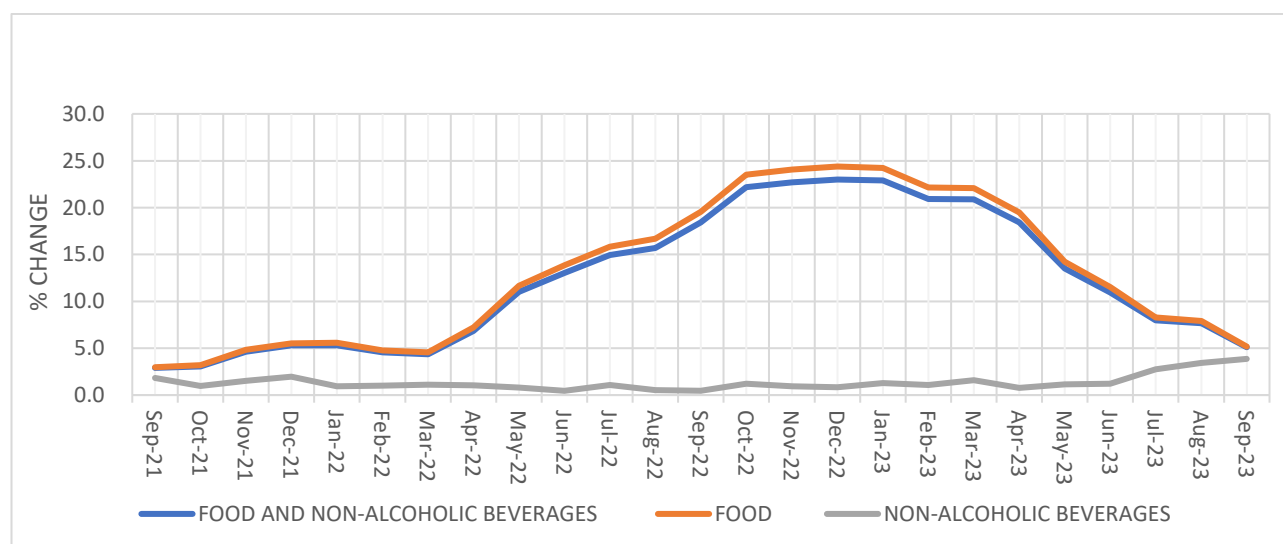
### 01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages registered 5.1 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 7.7 percent registered in August 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Food Inflation that registered 5.2 percent in September 2023 compared to 7.9 percent recorded in August 2023.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation registered 3.9 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 3.4 percent recorded in August 2023.

### 02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

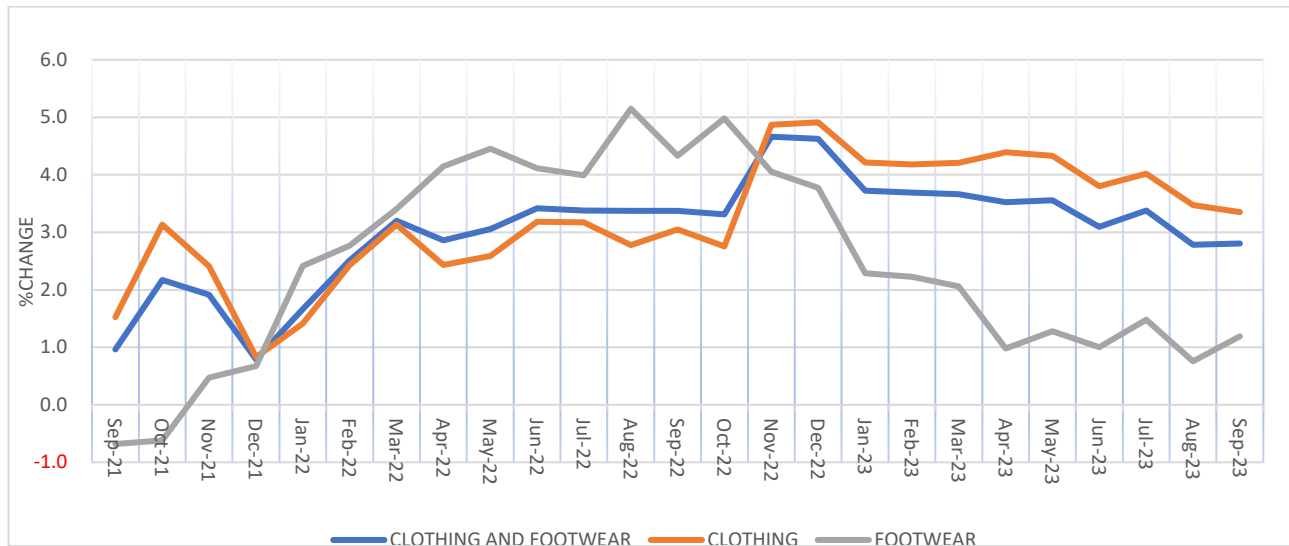
The Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics was registered at 4.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 3.7 percent recorded in August 2023. This was attributed to the Annual Tobacco Inflation registered 7.5 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 7.2 percent recorded in August 2023.

However, Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that registered 3.7 percent in September 2023 compared to 3.4 percent registered in August 2023

### 03 Clothing and Footwear

The Inflation for Annual Clothing and Footwear registered 2.8 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. This was mainly attributed to Clothing Inflation that registered 3.4 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 3.5 percent recorded in August 2023. Footwear Inflation registered 1.2 percent in September 2023 compared to 0.8 percent recorded in August 2023. *Figure 5 shows the trends of Clothing and Footwear Inflation from September 2021 to september 2023.*

#### 04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling, Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

The Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels was registered at 3.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 the from the 3.4 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly attributed to Annual Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling Inflation registered 8.7 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

Annual Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that registered 4.6 percent for the 12 months to September compared to 5.5 percent recorded in August 2023.

Annual Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 1.1 percent in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

However, Annual Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling inflation registered minus 5.1 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 4.8 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance**

This Division Comprises of Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance registered 2.5 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 2.4 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Household textiles that registered 5.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 4.5 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets Inflation registered 4.9 percent for the 12 months to August 2023 compared to 5.0 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Household Appliances Inflation registered 3.8 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 4.4 percent recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Annual Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation registered 1.7 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 1.4 percent in August 2023. Annual Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation registered 1.1 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 2.0 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation registered minus 1.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 0.5 percent in August 2023.

## **06 Health**

The Health Division comprises of Medicines and Health Products, Outpatient Care Services, Inpatient Care Services and Other Health Services.

The Inflation for Health registered 1.8 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 2.2 percent registered in August 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Medicines and Health Products Inflation registered 3.4 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. Annual Outpatient Care Services Inflation registered 2.5 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 3.3 percent recorded in August 2023.

Annual Inpatient Care Services Inflation registered 2.3 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 3.0 percent recorded in August 2023.

However, Annual Other Health Services Inflation registered minus 4.7 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 4.0 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **07 Transport**

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment and Passenger Transport Services.

The Inflation for Transport registered minus 4.8 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 6.9 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly attributed to Annual Passenger Transport Services Inflation that registered minus 6.6 percent in September 2023 compared to minus 8.8 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Operation of Personal Transport Equipment inflation that registered minus 3.9 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 6.7 percent registered in August 2023.

In addition, Annual Purchase of vehicles Inflation that registered minus 1.8 percent in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

## **08 Information and Communication**

Information and Communication includes Information and Communication Equipment, and Information and Communication Services.

The Annual Inflation for Information and Communication registered 2.4 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 3.3 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to the Information and Communication Services Inflation registered at 2.9 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 4.1 percent in August 2023. In addition, Annual Information and Communication Equipment Inflation that registered 1.2 percent in September 2023 compared to 1.6 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **09 Recreation, Sport and Culture**

Recreation, Sport and Culture comprises of Other Recreational Goods, Gardens and Pets, Recreational Services, Cultural Services, Newspapers, Books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

The Annual Inflation for Recreation, Sport and Culture registered minus 0.5 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 0.9 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to , Annual cultural services Inflation registered minus 2.6 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 3.5 percent recorded in August 2023.

However, Annual Gardens and Pets that registered 7.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 7.7 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Recreational Services Inflation registered 1.5 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 0.9 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Other Recreational Goods Inflation registered 1.5 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to the 2.1 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation that registered 1.0 percent in September 2023 compared to 1.4 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Package Holidays registered 0.7 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 2.5 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **10 Education Services**

Education Services comprises of Early Childhood and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education Not Defined by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education Services registered 3.8 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to the 7.5 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Annual 'Early Childhood and Primary Education' inflation that registered 6.0 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 7.6 recorded in August 2023. Annual 'Secondary Education' Inflation that registered 2.7 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 8.9 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Post-Secondary Non-Tertiary Education registered 2.7 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 16.6 percent recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Annual Education Not Defined by level registered minus 0.1 percent for the 12 months September 2023 compared to 0.0 percent recorded in August 2023. Annual Tertiary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the 12 months to in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

## **11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services**

Restaurants and Accommodation Services comprises of Food and Beverage Serving Services and Accommodation Services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Accommodation Services registered 4.2 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 5.0 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Accommodation Services Inflation that registered 7.1 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 8.8 percent recorded in August 2023.

Annual Food and Beverage Serving Services Inflation registered 3.0 percent in September 2023 compared to 3.4 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **12 Insurance and Financial Services**

Insurance and Financial Services comprises of Insurance and Financial Services.

The Annual Insurance and Financial Services Inflation for the 12 months to September 2023 registered 4.1 percent in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. This was due to Annual Financial Services Inflation that registered 4.5 percent in September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Annual Insurance Services Inflation registered minus 0.2 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to minus 0.1 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods**

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods comprises of Personal Care, Personal Effects n.e.c, Social Protection and Other services n.e.c.

The Annual Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation for the 12 months to July 2023 registered 6.6 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 7.9 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Personal Effects NEC Inflation that registered 9.8 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 9.3 percent recorded in August 2023.

Annual Personal Care Inflation registered at 6.9 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 8.7 percent recorded in August 2023. In addition, Annual Social Protection Inflation registered 5.2 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. Annual Other Services n.e.c Inflation recorded 1.3 percent for the 12 months to September 2023 compared to 2.8 percent recorded in August 2023.



## ANNEX 2: MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

### 01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages increased by 1.1 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 1.5 percent rise registered in August 2023. This was mainly due to the monthly Food Inflation that increased by 1.1 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 1.5 percent rise recorded in August 2023.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation increased by 0.6 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.3 percent rise recorded in August 2023.

### 02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics recorded 1.3 percent increase during the month of September 2023 from the 0.2 percent drop registered for the month of August 2023. This was due to Tobacco Inflation increased by 2.2 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 1.3 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023. In addition, Alcoholic beverages Inflation increased by 1.2 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded in August 2023.

### 03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased by 0.4 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.4 percent drop recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Clothing Inflation that increased by 0.5 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.5 percent drop recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Footwear Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

### 04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 from 0.9 percent rise recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that decreased by 0.2 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 2.2 percent rise recorded in August 2023. In addition, Maintenance, Repair And Security Of The Dwelling Inflation decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 1.3 percent rise recorded in August 2023.

However, Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

## **05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance**

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance increased by 0.9 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023.

This was mainly due to Goods and Services for Routine for Routine Household Maintenance Monthly Inflation that increased by 1.3 percent in September 2023 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in August 2023. In addition, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation increased by 0.3 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to the 0.5 percent rise registered in August 2023. Household Appliances Inflation increased by 0.7 percent during the month of September 2023 from 0.1 percent drop recorded for the month of August 2023. Household Textiles increased by 0.7 percent for the Month of September 2023 compared to 0.0 percent recorded for August 2023. In addition, Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of July 2023 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded for the month of June 2023. Furnishings, and Loose Carpets inflation recorded 0.2 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in June 2023.

However, Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation recorded 0.2 percent drop for the month of September 2023 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in August 2023.

## **06 Health**

The Monthly Inflation for Health registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023. This was mainly due to. Other Health Services Inflation increased by 0.3 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.3 percent drop recorded in August 2023. Outpatient Care Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023. Inpatient care services inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023.

However, Medicines And Health Products Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.3 percent rise registered for the month of August 2023.

## **07 Transport**

Transport Inflation increased by 2.4 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to the 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023. This was mainly due to Passenger Transport Services inflation that increased by 2.8 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Operation of personal transport equipment increased by 2.5 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.3 percent rise registered during the month of August 2023.

Purchase of vehicles Inflation increased by 0.9 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.6 percent drop recorded in August 2023.

## **08 Information and Communication**

The monthly inflation for Information and Communication recorded 0.1 percent drop for the month of September 2023 compared to 0.0 percent recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Information and Communication Equipment inflation that registered 0.2 percent drop during the month of September 2023 compared to 0.0 recorded in August 2023. Information and communication services inflation that registered 0.0 percent during the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

## **09 Recreation, Sport and Culture**

Monthly Recreation, Sport and Culture inflation increased by 0.7 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in August 2023. This was mainly attributed to Package Holidays Inflation that increased by 3.3 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 5.5 percent rise recorded in August 2023.

In addition, Cultural Services Inflation registered 0.9 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.6 percent drop recorded in August 2023.

Newspapers, books & stationery' inflation increased by 0.3 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of August 2023.

Recreational services Inflation increased by 0.6 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.0 percent recorded in August 2023.

Other recreational goods inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

However, Gardens and Pets Inflation that decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.9 percent drop registered during the month of August 2023.

## **10 Education Services**

Monthly Inflation for Education Services recorded 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023. This was mainly due to Secondary Education Inflation that registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

Early Childhood and Primary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

Post-secondary and non-tertiary education Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of August 2023.

Tertiary education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of August 2023.

However, Education not Defined by level inflation decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.0 percent recorded in August 2023.

## **11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services**

The Monthly Inflation for restaurants and accommodation services decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 compared to the 0.6 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023.

This was mainly due to Food and beverage serving services inflation decreased by 0.2 percent for the month of September 2023 from the 0.9 percent rise registered in August 2023.

However, accommodation services inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of August 2023.

## **12 Insurance and Financial Services**

Insurance and Financial Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded during the month of August 2023. This was due to Insurance Inflation that decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of August 2023.

Financial Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

## **13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods**

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation increased by 0.3 percent during the month of September 2023 compared to the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023. This was mainly due to Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation that increased by 1.1 percent during the month of September 2023 compared to the 0.3 percent drop recorded for the month of August 2023.

In addition, Personal care Inflation increased by 0.1 percent during the month of September 2023 compared to 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of August 2023.

Social Protection Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of September 2023 the same rate recorded in August 2023.

Other services n.e.c Inflation registered 0.0 percent in September 2023 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded for the month of August 2023.
