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## Foreword

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten baskets of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index was rebased from 2005/2006 to 2009/2010, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS IV) that was conducted from May 2009 to April 2010. During the rebasing exercise, Kampala was further decomposed into three baskets from the two that has been existing. In addition, Fortportal Centre was incorporated into the Index. The rebased CPI is now classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP). This is a shift from the Central Product Classification (CPC) that was used in the earlier series.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten baskets mentioned above and indices are available from the EA level.

# Highlights of CPI, November 2016

## 1. Annual Inflation

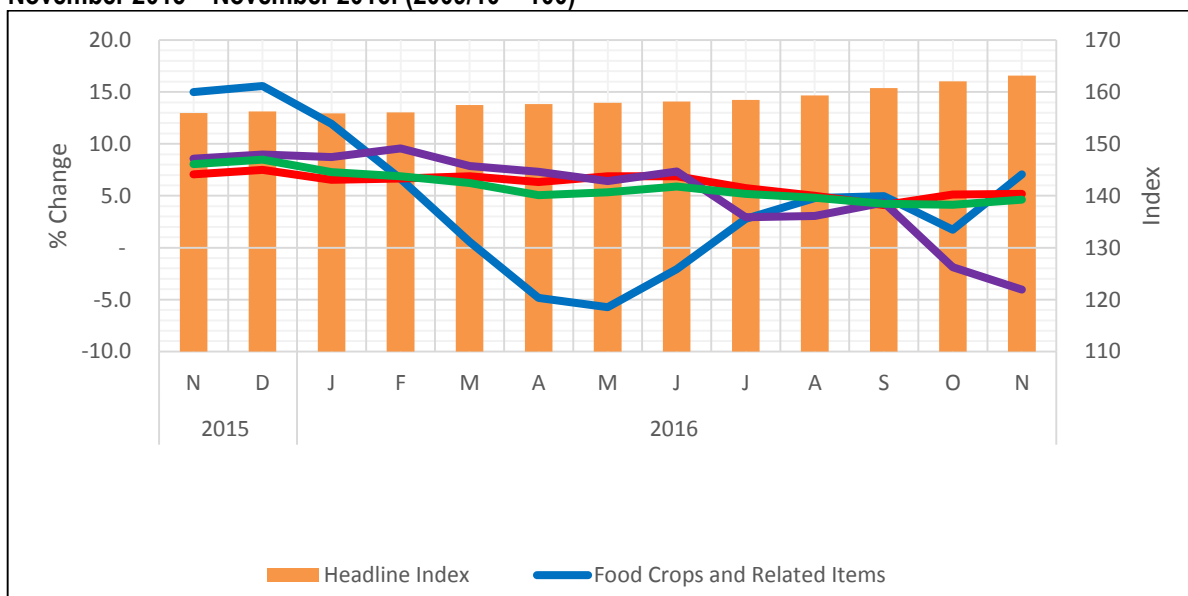
The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending November 2016 rose to 4.6 percent compared to the 4.1 percent recorded during the year ended October 2016.

The increase was due to Annual Food Crops Inflation that rose to 7.1 percent for the year ending November 2016 from the 1.7 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The rise in Annual Food Crops Inflation is attributed to Fruits Inflation that increased to 13.1 per cent for the year ending November 2016 compared to the minus 1.1 percent registered during the year ended October 2016.

Similarly, the Annual Core Inflation increased to 5.2 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 5.1 percent recorded for the ended October 2016. The rise in Annual Core Inflation is due to the Services Inflation that registered an increase of 6.6 per cent for the year ending November 2016 compared to the 6.5 percent registered during the year ended October 2016. Key services include; Education that registered an increase of 19.7 percent for the year ending November 2016, the same rate recorded for the year ended October 2016. In addition, Restaurants and Hotels recorded an increase of 6.5 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 6.0 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The Annual Inflation of Other Goods recorded 4.2 percent rise for the year ending November 2016 the same rate recorded for the year ended October 2016.

The Annual Energy, Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation decelerated further to minus 4.1 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to minus 1.9 percent recorded during the year ended October 2016. The driver for the decrease in EFU was Annual Inflation for Liquid Fuels that recorded a minus 6.7 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to minus 7.0 per cent recorded for the year ended October 2016. Key items under liquid fuels include; Petrol (-12.6 percent from -12.0 percent), Diesel (-9.5 percent from -9.8 percent), and Kerosene (-6.7 percent from -7.0 percent). Details of the annual inflation by Division are described in Section 1 of the explanatory notes.

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## 2. Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical Areas

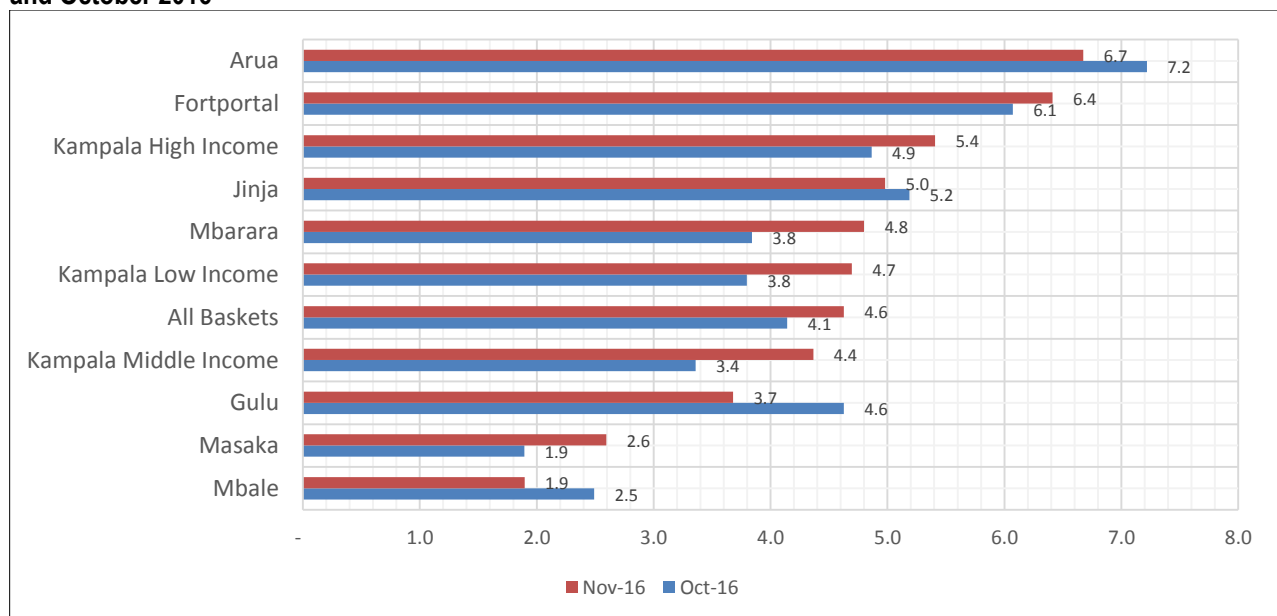
Arua registered the highest Annual Inflation of 6.7 percent for the year ending November 2016 though lower than the 7.2 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The driver is high Annual Inflation for Education that registered an increase of 19.0 per cent for the year ending November 2016, the same rate recorded for the year

ended October 2016. In addition, the Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels rose to 11.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 10.2 percent registered for the year ended October 2016.

The second highest inflation is registered in Fortportal at 6.4 percent for the year ending November 2016, compared to 6.1 percent recorded in October 2016. The main driver is high Annual Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages that is registered at 12.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 10.8 percent for the year ended October 2016. In addition, Restaurants and Hotels Inflation recorded an annual inflation of 8.0 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.8 percent for the year ended October 2016.

Kampala High Income registered the third highest inflation of 5.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.9 percent registered for the year ended October 2016. This was driven by Education which stood at 34.5 percent for the year ending November 2016 from the 34.6 percent that was recorded for the year ended October 2016. The other driver was Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages that registered an increase of 3.9 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 1.8 percent recorded during the year ended October 2016. Annual Inflation for all the ten consumption baskets are shown in Graph 2 and Table 7 below.

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### 3. Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation increased by 0.7 percent for the month of November 2016 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in October 2016. The Monthly Core Inflation rose by 0.3 percent for the month of November 2016 from the 0.9 percent rise recorded during the month of October 2016. Monthly Food Crops and related Items Inflation increased to 3.8 percent in November 2016 from the 1.7 percent rise recorded for the month of October 2016. Monthly Energy, Fuel and Utilities inflation registered a minus of 0.5 percent in November 2016 from the minus of 1.3 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. The detailed Monthly Inflation figures per Division are presented in Section 2 of the explanatory notes.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR THE INFLATION OF NOVEMBER 2016

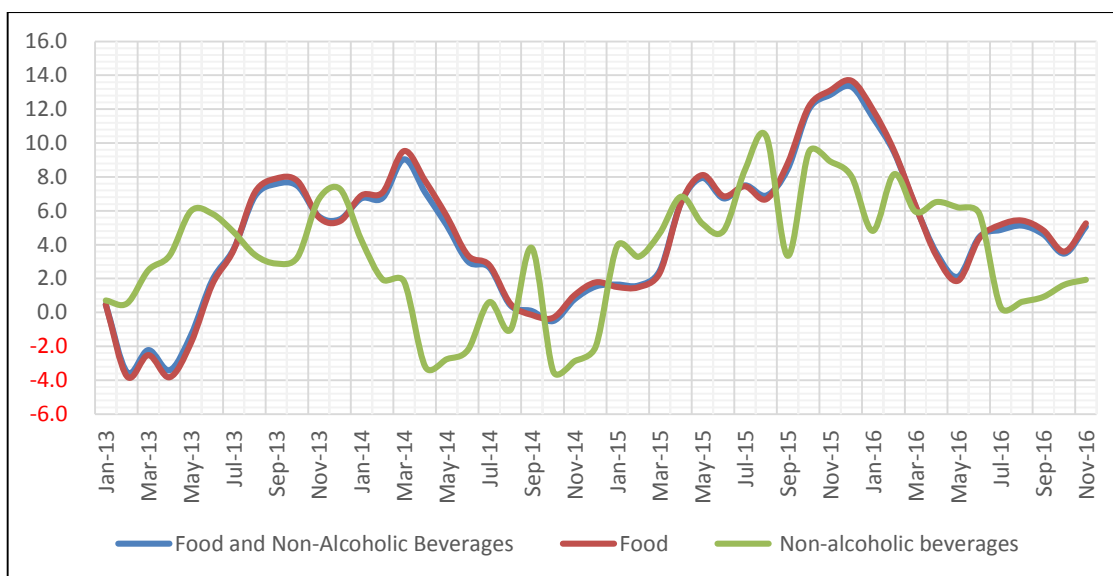
### SECTION 1: Annual Inflation by COICOP<sup>1</sup> Divisions

The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs

#### 01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for Food and non-alcoholic beverages increased to 5.1 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 3.5 for the year ended October 2016. The increase was due to a rise in Annual Food Inflation to 5.3 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 3.6 percent recorded during the year ended October 2016. The Annual Inflation for Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased to 1.9 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 1.6 percent that was recorded for the year ended October 2016. Graph 3 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Inflation from January 2013 to November 2016

#### 02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

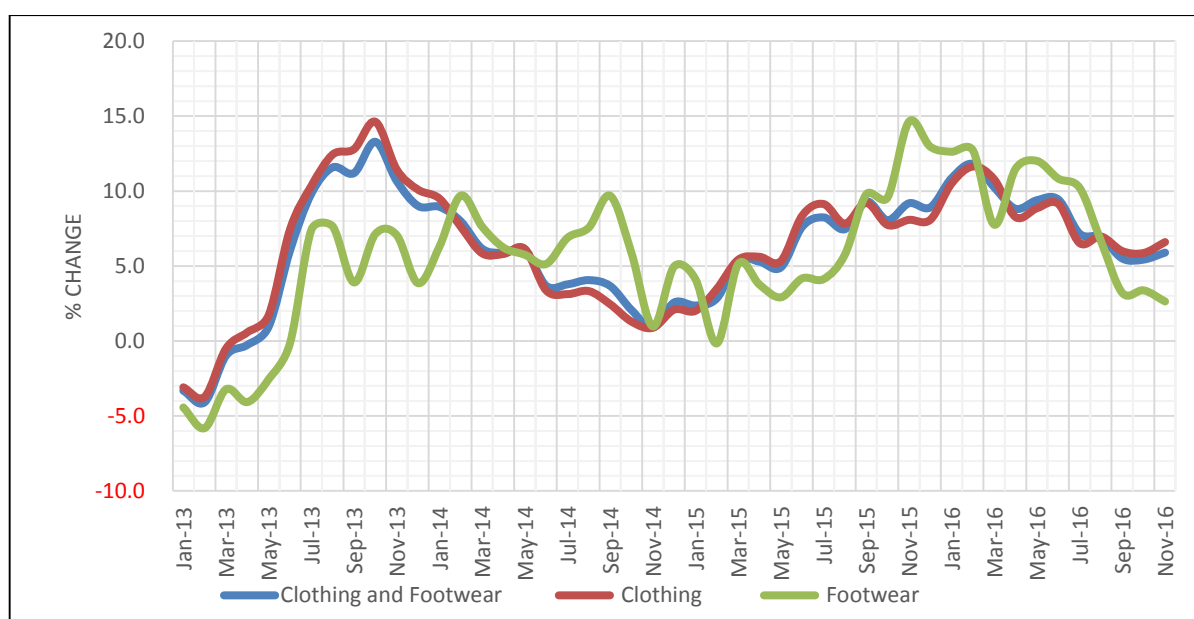
The Annual Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics dropped to 4.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to the 4.8 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The decrease was due to a decline in Annual Inflation of Alcoholic Beverages that is registered at 4.1 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.9 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. On the other hand, Tobacco increased to 7.8 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 3.6 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016.

#### 03 Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased to 5.9 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 5.4 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The increase was mainly attributed to Clothing Inflation that is registered at 6.6 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 5.9 percent for the year ended October 2016. Footwear Inflation declined to 2.6 percent for the year ending November 2016 from the 3.4 percent recorded during the year ended October 2016. Graph 4 shows the trends of clothing and Footwear from January 2013 to November 2016

#### 04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance & repair of the dwelling, Water Supply, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels

The Annual Inflation for Housing, water, electricity, Gas & other fuels, decreased to 0.5 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 1.8 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The decrease was attributed to Inflation of Electricity, Gas and other fuels that recorded minus 3.6 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to minus 1.7 recorded for the year ended October 2016.

Annual Inflation for Water supply & miscellaneous services is registered at 1.2 percent for the year ending November, 2016 compared to 6.0 percent for the year ended October, 2016. Maintenance & repair of the dwelling dropped to 0.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 0.7 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016.

#### 05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools & Equipment for House, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance

The Annual Inflation for Furnishings, household equipment & routine household maintenance is registered at 3.8 percent for the year ending November 2016 the same rate recorded for the year ended October 2016. Annual inflation for Furniture and furnishings, Carpets and Other Floor Coverings inflation is registered at 5.2 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.4 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. Tools and Equipment for House and Garden inflation increased to 14.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 12.8 percent recorded for year ended October 2016. Glassware, tableware and household utensils inflation increased to 8.8 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 7.0 percent recorded for year ended October, 2016.

#### 06 Health

The health Division comprises of Medical Products, Appliances & Equipment, Outpatient Services, and Hospital Services.

The Annual Inflation for Health increased to 2.9 percent for the year ending November 2015 compared to 2.8 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The increase was due to Annual Inflation for Medical



Products, Appliances & Equipment that is recorded at 3.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 3.2 registered for the year ended October 2016. In addition, Hospital Services inflation increased to 5.8 percent in November 2016 compared to 5.3 percent recorded for year ended October 2016. Outpatient inflation dropped to 0.7 percent for the year ending November 2016 from 0.9 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016.

## **07 Transport**

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Transport and Personal Equipment and Transport Services.

Annual Inflation for Transport increased to 2.9 per cent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 1.5 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The increase was due to Purchase of Vehicles inflation that is recorded at 11.7 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.6 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. Transport Services inflation increased to 4.1 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 3.9 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. Annual Inflation for Operation of Personal Transport Equipment decelerated to minus 4.3 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to minus 3.7 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016.

## **08 Communication**

Communication includes Postal services, Telephones and Telefax equipment and Telephone and Telefax services.

The Annual Inflation for Communication registered a minus 1.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 from the minus 1.3 percent recorded for year ended October 2016. The main driver was Telephone and telefax equipment that registered minus 6.4 percent for the year ending November 2016, from the minus 6.1 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. Telephone and telefax services remained stable at 0.0 percent for the year ending November 2016. Postal Services, on the other hand, registered a 10.8 percent rise for the year ending November 2016, the same rate recorded for the year ended October 2016.

## **09 Recreation and Culture**

Recreation and Culture comprises of Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment, Recreational & Cultural services, Newspapers, books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

Annual inflation for Recreational and Culture decreased to 1.6 percent for the year ending November 2016, compared to 2.2 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The main driver was the Recreational and Cultural Services Inflation that decelerated to minus 2.3 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to minus 1.5 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016.

## **10 Education**

Education comprises of Pre-Primary and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education not definable by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education increased to 19.7 percent for the year ending November 2016 the same rate recorded for the year ended October 2016. This was due to an increase in Secondary Education inflation that is registered at 25.4 percent for the year ending November 2016, the same rate registered for the year ended October 2016. Pre-primary & Primary Education, Tertiary Education and Education not defined by level recorded at 18.7 percent, 0.2 percent and 1.7 percent respectively for the year ending November 2016.

## **11 Restaurants and Hotels**

Restaurants and Hotels comprises of catering services and accommodation services. Restaurants and Hotels Annual inflation increased to 6.5 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 6.0 percent registered for the year ended October 2016. This was due to an increase in inflation of catering services from 6.8 percent for the year ended October 2016 to 7.2 percent for the year ending November 2016. Accommodation services



increased to 4.9 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.2 percent registered for the year ended October 2016.

## **12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services**

Miscellaneous goods and services comprises of Personal Care such as hairdressing salons and personal grooming establishments, Personal Effects such as Jewellery, clocks and watches, Insurance and Other services such as passport fees, photocopying and radio announcements.

The Miscellaneous goods and services Inflation for the year ending November 2016 dropped to 6.0 percent compared to 6.1 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016. The reduction was due to Inflation of Personal Effects such as travel bags and umbrellas that recorded an inflation of 1.4 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 4.0 percent for the year ended October 2016. However, the Annual Inflation for Personal care registered an increase of 5.3 percent for the year ending November 2016 compared to 5.2 percent recorded for the year ended October 2016.

## **SECTION 2: Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions**

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs

### **01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages**

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic beverages registered 1.5 percent rise for the month of November 2016 from the 1.1 percent recorded for October 2016. The increase was due to Food inflation that recorded 1.6 percent in November from the 1.1 percent recorded in October 2016. However, Non-alcoholic Beverages dropped to 0.1 percent for the month of November 2016 from the 0.2 percent recorded in October 2016.

### **02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics**

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco dropped to minus 0.2 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 0.0 percent recorded in October 2016. The drop was due to Monthly Inflation of Alcoholic Beverages that registered minus 0.6 percent in November 2016 from the 0.3 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. On the other hand, Tobacco inflation increased to 4.2 percent in November 2016 from the minus 3.9 percent recorded in October 2016.

### **03 Clothing and Footwear**

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased to 0.8 percent for the month of November 2016 from the 0.5 percent recorded in October 2016. This was mainly attributed to an increase in Clothing inflation that registered an increase of 1.0 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 0.6 percent recorded in October 2016. However, Monthly Inflation for Footwear recorded a minus 0.2 percent for the month of November 2016 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in October 2016.

### **04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels**

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, water, electricity, Gas & other fuels, recorded minus 0.3 percent in November 2016 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in October 2016. The decrease was attributed to a drop in Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels that decreased further to minus 0.8 percent in November 2016 from the minus 2.0 percent in October 2016.

Monthly Inflation for Water supply & miscellaneous services registered a 0.0 percent in November, 2016 the same rate recorded in October, 2016. Actual Rentals for Housing registered 0.0 percent in November 2016 from the 2.8 percent recorded in October 2016.

### **05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance**

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, household equipment & routine household maintenance decreased to 0.1 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 0.5 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. The

drop was due to Household Textiles that registered minus 0.4 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 0.5 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. However, Glassware, tableware and household utensils registered 0.9 percent in November 2016 from the minus 0.2 percent recorded in October, 2016.

## **06 Health**

The Monthly Inflation for Health dropped to 0.1 percent during the month of November 2015 from the 0.5 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. The drop was due to Monthly Inflation for Outpatient Services that recorded minus 0.2 percent in November 2016 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. In addition, Medical Products, Appliances and Equipment dropped to 0.2 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 0.6 percent rise for the month of October 2016.

## **07 Transport**

Transport division registered a monthly inflation of 1.4 percent rise for the month of November 2016 from the minus 0.7 percent recorded during the month of October 2016. The driver was the Monthly Inflation for the Purchase of used vehicles that registered an increase of 6.7 percent during the month of November 2016 from the minus 5.2 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. On the other hand, Monthly inflation for Operation of Personal Transport Equipment registered a minus 0.4 percent in November 2016 from the 0.6 percent recorded for October 2016. Transport Services also decreased to 0.1 percent in November 2016 from the 0.5 percent recorded during the month of October 2016.

## **08 Communication**

The Monthly Inflation for Communication registered minus 0.1 percent in November 2016 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of October 2016. The main driver for the decrease in communication inflation was Telephone and Telefax Equipment that registered a minus 0.3 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 1.6 percent rise recorded for the month of October 2016.

## **09 Recreation and Culture**

Monthly inflation for Recreational and Culture registered 0.2 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 0.5 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. The decrease is attributed to a drop in monthly inflation of Audio-visual, photographic and information processing equipment that recorded minus 0.5 percent in November 2016 from the 0.5 percent recorded in October 2016. In addition, Recreational and Cultural Services dropped to minus 0.8 percent in November 2016 from the 0.2 percent increase recorded in October 2016.

## **10 Education**

The Monthly Inflation for Education for November 2016 recorded a 0.0 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 5.4 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. This drop is attributed to primary and pre-primary education Inflation that declined to 0.0 percent in November 2016 from the 5.2 percent recorded in October 2016. Tertiary Education registered inflation of 0.0 percent the same rate recorded in October 2016.

## **11 Restaurants and Hotels**

The Monthly Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels declined to 0.7 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 1.2 percent registered for the month October 2016. This was due to a drop in Accommodation Services that registered 0.4 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 1.0 percent recorded for the month of October 2016. In addition, Catering Services declined to 0.9 percent during the month of November 2016 from the 1.3 percent recorded for the month of October 2016.

## **12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services**

Miscellaneous goods and services Inflation for the month of November 2016 registered a minus 0.3 percent compared to 0.2 percent recorded for the month of October 2016.
