

#### FOREWORD

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten centres of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index has been rebased from 2009/2010 to 2016/2017, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS VI) that was conducted from July 2016 to June 2017. The rebased CPI is classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP 2018) This is a shift from the COICOP 1999 that was used in the earlier series. COICOP 2018 is more detailed than the previous (1999) version, responding to the users' need for more detail, and addresses several other issues that required revision of the classification. The new COICOP of 2018 reflects the significant changes in goods and services in some areas, improved links of COICOP to other classifications, and addresses emerging statistical and policy needs of regional and international users.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten centres mentioned above and rebased indices are available from July 2017 to date at EA level.

#### ACRONYMS AND DEFINITIONS

**COICOP:** Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose, is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyse individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

**CPI:** Consumer Price Index - a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

**CPI basket:** A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

**Elementary aggregate (EA):** The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

**Inflation:** A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.

**Jevons price index**: An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

**Laspeyres price index**: The Laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

**Outlet:** The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue, a website etc. Also referred to as a "retail outlet", although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers

**Outlier:** A term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect

**Price relative:** A measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

**Reference base:** The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2016/17.

**Weight:** The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity or value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

#### 1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF UGANDA CPI FOR OCTOBER 2024

#### 1.1 Annual Headline Inflation

The Annual Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Uganda for the 12 months to October 2024 is 2.9 percent compared to 3.0 percent registered in the year ended September 2024.

The Annual Inflation of October 2024 is largely attributed to Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation that was recorded at minus 5.3 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to minus 4.1 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. This was mainly attributed to a drop in the prices of Cooking Bananas (by minus 8.0 percent compared to 4.9 percent in September 2024), Tomatoes (by minus 14.2 percent compared to minus 4.1 percent in September 2024), Beans (by minus 4.4 percent compared to minus 2.5 percent in September 2024) and Irish Potatoes prices increasing by 11.8 percent compared to 26.0 percent in September 2024.


Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation recorded 3.3 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 4.5 percent that was registered in the year ended September 2024. This was mainly due to Liquid Energy Fuels Inflation that recorded minus 5.4 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to minus 2.0 percent registered in the year ended September 2024, driven mainly by Petrol and Diesel prices that decreased on an annual basis in October 2024 by minus 5.9 percent compared to minus 2.2 percent in September 2024 and minus 7.5 percent compared to minus 2.6 percent in September 2024 respectively. Liquefied Gas (Propane) prices decreased by minus 4.2 percent compared to minus 1.5 percent in September 2024. Additionally, Water supply charges increased by 3.7 percent in October 2024 compared to 4.4 percent recorded in September 2024. However, Solid fuels inflation increased to 15.5 percent in October 2024 compared to 14.3 percent registered in September 2024 mainly due to Charcoal prices that increased by 17.0 percent in October 2024 compared to 13.7 percent recorded in September 2024 and firewood prices increased by 13.3 percent compared to 16.6 percent in September 2024.

However, Annual Core Inflation is registered at 3.9 percent compared to 3.7 percent that was recorded in the year ended September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Services Inflation that recorded 6.2 percent in October 2024 compared to 5.8 percent for September 2024. The main driver of Services Inflation was Accommodation Services Inflation that registered 5.7 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 5.0 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. Additionally, Passenger Transport by Road Inflation registered 3.8 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 3.4 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. The other driver of Annual Core Inflation was Annual Other Goods Inflation that is recorded at 2.1 percent in the year ending October 2024 the same rate recorded in the year ended September 2024. This was mainly due to Laundry Bar Soap prices that registered minus 2.5 percent in October 2024 compared to minus 4.7 percent registered in September 2024 and Bread (Loaf) prices registered minus 0.8 percent in October 2024 compared to minus 2.7 percent registered in September 2024.

Table 1 shows Annual Headline Inflation and its categories for September 2024 and October 2024.

#### 1.2 Annual Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), the main drivers to the registered inflation were 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' inflation that decreased to minus 2.1 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to minus 1.5 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. 'Education Services' inflation slowed down to 10.3 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 12.1 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. 'Insurance and Financial Services' inflation registered 2.6 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 4.0 percent recorded in the year ended September 2024. 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' inflation slowed down to 2.2 percent for the year ending October 2024 compared to 2.9 percent registered for the year ended September 2024. 'Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods' inflation registered 4.5 percent for the year ending October 2024 compared to 4.9 percent registered for the year ended September 2024. 'Clothing and Footwear' inflation registered 5.3 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 5.4 percent recorded in the year ended September 2024. 'Health' inflation registered 7.8 percent for the year ending October 2024 compared to 7.9 percent registered for the year ended September 2024. 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' inflation slowed down to 6.9 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 7.0 percent registered in the year ended September 2024.

However, 'Transport' inflation increased to 4.9 percent in the year ending October 2024 from the 2.9 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation registered 3.6 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 2.7 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. 'Information and communication' inflation registered 1.9 percent in the year ending October 2024 from the 1.5 percent recorded in the year ended September 2024. 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' inflation registered 3.8 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 3.7 percent registered in the year ended September 2024. 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' inflation registered 4.2 percent in the year ending October 2024 compared to 4.1 percent registered in the year ended September 2024, see Table 3 below.

#### 1.3 Monthly Inflation.

The Monthly Headline Inflation for October 2024 increased by 0.5 percent from the 0.2 percent rise registered for the month of September 2024, Table 4 below.

This was mainly due to Monthly Core Inflation that increased by 0.5 percent in October 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise registered in September 2024. The main driver for the rise in Core Inflation was monthly Services Inflation that registered an increase of 0.8 percent in October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. In addition, monthly Other Goods Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in October 2024 the same rate recorded in September 2024.

In addition, monthly Food Crops and Related Items Inflation increased by 1.1 percent in October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to matooke prices that increased by 8.2 percent in October 2024 from the 35.2 percent rise recorded in September 2024. In addition, Onions prices increased by 8.0 percent in October 2024 from the 20.8 percent drop recorded in September 2024. Passion fruit prices increased by 4.5 percent in October 2024 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded in September 2024. Fresh cassava prices increased by 2.0 percent in October 2024 from the 2.7 percent rise recorded in September 2024.

Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation recorded 0.0 percent in October 2024 from the 1.4 percent rise registered in September 2024. This was mainly due to monthly Solid fuels Inflation that increased by 0.9 percent in October 2024 from the 4.0 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Specifically, Firewood prices increased by 2.9 percent in October 2024 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in September 2024. However, this increase was offset by the monthly Liquid Energy Fuels inflation that decreased by 1.9 percent from the 0.5 percent drop recorded in September 2024. Specifically, Petrol prices decreased by 2.0 percent in October 2024 from the 0.7 percent drop recorded in September 2024. Liquified gas prices decreased by 2.8 percent in October 2024 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in September 2024.

#### 1.4 Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), monthly Transport Inflation increased by 1.6 percent in October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024. Monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation increased by 0.5 percent in October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Restaurants and Accommodation Services Inflation increased by 0.7 percent in October 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation increased by 0.4 percent in October 2024 from the 1.0 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Education Services Inflation increased by 0.6 percent in October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024. Monthly Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Inflation increased by 0.5 percent in October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Information and Communication Inflation increased by 0.4 percent in October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods inflation increased by 0.2 percent in October 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Health Inflation increased by 0.1 percent in October 2024 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded in September 2024. Monthly Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in October 2024 the same rate recorded in September 2024. Monthly Insurance and Financial Services Inflation increased by 0.1 percent in October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024.



#### 1.5 Annual Headline Inflation by CPI Geographical Center

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups revealed that Kampala High Income Group registered the highest inflation at 4.4 percent for the year ending October 2024 compared to 4.0 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly driven by Annual 'Transport' inflation that increased to 7.2 percent in October 2024 compared to 3.7 percent registered in September 2024. In addition, Annual 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation increased to 7.0 percent in October 2024 compared to 5.8 percent registered in September 2024

The second highest Annual Inflation was registered in Mbarara Centre at 4.2 percent for the year ending October 2024 compared to 3.9 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly driven by Annual 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' inflation that increased to 1.2 percent in October 2024 compared to minus 1.4 percent registered in September 2024. In addition, Annual 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation increased to 5.5 percent in October 2024 compared to 4.2 percent registered in September 2024.

The least Annual Inflation was registered in Gulu at 1.1 percent for the year ending October 2024 compared to 2.1 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to the annual 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' inflation that registered minus 6.8 percent in October 2024 compared to minus 4.1 percent registered in September 2024. In addition, Annual 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' inflation registered 4.2 percent in October 2024 compared to 7.4 percent registered in September 2024.



#### ANNEX 1: ANNUAL INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 6.


#### **01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages**

The Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased to minus 2.1 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to minus 1.5 percent registered in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Food Inflation that decreased to minus 2.4 percent in October 2024 compared to minus 1.7 percent recorded in September 2024.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation for the 12 months to October 2024 registered 2.6 percent compared to 2.3 percent recorded in September 2024 .

Figure 4 shows the trends of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation from October 2022 to October 2024.

#### 02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics registered 2.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 2.9 percent recorded in September 2024. This was attributed to the Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that slowed down to 1.3 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 2.0 percent recorded in September 2024.

In addition, Annual Tobacco Inflation slowed down to 10.7 percent in October 2024 compared to the 11.3 percent registered in September 2024.


#### 03 Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Clothing and Footwear Inflation registered 5.3 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 5.4 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly attributed to Clothing Inflation that registered 5.3 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 5.4 percent recorded in September 2024.

In addition, Footwear Inflation registered 5.3 percent in October 2024 compared to 5.5 percent recorded in September 2024.

#### 04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling, Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels Inflation registered 4.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 4.1 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly attributed to Annual Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation that registered 7.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 7.8 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Annual Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling inflation registered 3.8 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 4.2 recorded in September 2024. Annual Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 1.5 percent in October 2024 compared to 1.8 percent recorded in September 2024.

Annual Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling Inflation registered 0.4 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to minus 1.4 percent recorded in September 2024.

## 05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance increased to 3.6 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 2.7 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation that registered 2.7 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to the 1.2 percent registered in September 2024. In addition, Annual Household textiles inflation registered 7.5 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to the 8.1 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation registered 5.8 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 5.3 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets Inflation registered 3.5 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 3.6 percent recorded in September 2024.

Annual Household Appliances Inflation registered 3.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 3.4 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation registered 0.6 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to minus 0.2 percent recorded in September 2024.

#### 06 Health

The Health Division comprises of Medicines and Health Products, Outpatient Care Services, Inpatient Care Services and Other Health Services.

The Inflation for Health slowed down to 7.8 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 7.9 percent registered in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Inpatient Care Services Inflation that slowed down to 17.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 18.2 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Annual Medicine and Health Products Inflation registered 3.4 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 3.6 percent recorded in September 2024.

Annual Outpatient Care Services Inflation increased to 7.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 from the 7.7 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Other Health Services Inflation increased to 8.1 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 7.8 percent recorded in September 2024.

#### 07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment and Passenger Transport Services.

The Inflation for Transport increased to 4.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 2.9 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly attributed to Annual Operation of Personal Transport Equipment inflation that increased to 6.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 1.9 percent registered in September 2024. In addition, Annual Passenger Transport Services Inflation registered 3.8 percent in October 2024 compared to 4.1 percent recorded in September 2024.

Annual Purchase of vehicles Inflation registered 2.2 percent in October 2024 the same rate recorded in September 2024.

#### **08 Information and Communication**

Information and Communication includes Information and Communication Equipment, and Information and Communication Services.

The Annual Inflation for Information and Communication increased to 1.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 1.5 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Information and Communication Services Inflation that increased to 1.8 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 1.6 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Annual Information and Communication Equipment Inflation registratered 2.0 percent in October 2024 from the 1.3 percent recorded in September 2024.

#### 09 Recreation, Sport and Culture

Recreation, Sport and Culture comprises of Other Recreational Goods, Gardens and Pets, Recreational Services, Cultural Services, Newspapers, Books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

The Annual Inflation for Recreation, Sport and Culture slowed down to 6.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 7.0 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Cultural Services Inflation that increased to 8.5 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 8.3 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Annual Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation slowed down to 4.6 percent in October 2024 compared to 4.8 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Recreational Services Inflation registered 6.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 7.5 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Gardens and Pets inflation registered 15.8 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 the same rate recorded in September 2024.

Annual Package Holidays inflation registered 1.9 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 2.6 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Other Recreational Goods Inflation registered 1.4 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 1.7 percent recorded in September 2024.

#### **10 Education Services**

Education Services comprises of Early Childhood and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education Not Defined by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education Services slowed down to 10.3 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 12.1 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Early Childhood and Primary Education inflation that slowed down to 14.7 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 18.3 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Annual Secondary Education Inflation slowed down to 9.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 from the 9.8 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Post-Secondary Non-Tertiary Education inflation registered 8.3 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 from the 8.4 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Education Not Defined by level registered 0.1 percent for the 12 months to October same as that recorded in September 2024.

### 11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services

Restaurants and Accommodation Services comprises of Food and Beverage Serving Services and Accommodation Services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Accommodation Services increased to 3.8 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 3.7 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Food and Beverage Serving Services Inflation that registered 3.0 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 3.1 percent recorded in September 2024.

However, Annual Accommodation Services Inflation increased to 5.7 percent in October 2024 compared to 5.0 percent recorded in September 2024.

#### 12 Insurance and Financial Services

Insurance and Financial Services comprises of Insurance and Financial Services.

The Annual Insurance and Financial Services Inflation for the 12 months to October 2024 registered 2.6 percent compared to 4.0 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Financial Services Inflation that registered 2.7 percent in October 2024 compared to 4.3 percent recorded in September 2024.

In addition, Annual Insurance Services Inflation increased to 1.4 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 0.5 percent recorded in September 2024.

## 13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods comprises of Personal Care, Personal Effects n.e.c, Social Protection and Other services n.e.c.

The Annual Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation for the 12 months to October 2024 registered 4.5 percent compared to 4.9 percent recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Personal Care Inflation that increased to 3.4 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 3.2 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Annual Other Services n.e.c Inflation slowed down to 7.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 8.5 percent recorded in September 2024. Annual Personal Effects NEC Inflation slowed down to 6.7 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 7.6 percent recorded for September 2024. Annual Social Protection Inflation slowed down to 5.2 percent for the 12 months to October 2024 compared to 12.2 percent recorded in September 2024.

## ANNEX 2: MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

#### 01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages increased by 0.5 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to the monthly Food Inflation that increased by 0.5 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024 .

In addition, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded in September 2024.

## 02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics increased by 0.2 percent for the month of October 2024 the same rate registered for the month of September 2024. This was mainly due to Alcoholic beverages Inflation that increased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in September 2024.

However, Tobacco Inflation registered a 0.6 percent rise for the month of October 2024 from the 2.4 percent drop recorded in September 2024.

### 03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Clothing Inflation that registered a drop of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in June 2024. In addition, Footwear Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 the same rate recorded in September 2024.

## 04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels registered a 0.4 percent rise for the month of October 2024 from the 1.0 percent increase recorded in September 2024. This was mainly attributed to Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Inflation that recorded a rise of 1.5 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 1.4 percent registered in September 2024. In addition, Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation recorded a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024. Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 2.3 percent rise recorded in September 2024.

Maintenance, Repair And Security Of The Dwelling Inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 1.2 percent drop recorded in September 2024.

## 05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance recorded a rise of 0.5 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise registered for the month of September 2024.

This was mainly due to Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation that registered a rise of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise registered in September 2024. In addition, Goods and Services for routine household maintenance inflation that recorded 0.2 percent rise from the 0.2 percent drop recorded for the mont of September 2024. In addition, Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation increased by 0.5 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise registered in September 2024. Household Appliances Inflation recorded a rise of 0.3 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.6 percent drop recorded during September 2024.

However, Household Textiles inflation recorded a drop of 0.1 percent for the Month of October 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for September 2024. Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets inflation recorded a drop of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.3 percent increase recorded in September 2024.

#### 06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health recorded an increase of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Medicines And Health Products Inflation that recorded a rise of 0.2 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.5 percent increase registered in September 2024. In addition, Outpatient Care Services Inflation recorded an increase of 0.5 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise registered in September 2024. Inpatient care services inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 1.8 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2024.

However, Other Health Services Inflation registered a drop of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise registered in September 2024 .

#### **07 Transport**

Transport Inflation registered a rise of 1.6 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of September 2024. This was mainly due to Operation of personal transport equipment inflation that registered 5.7 percent rise for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent decrease registered in September 2024. In addition, Purchase of vehicles Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in September 2024.

However, Passenger Transport Services inflation decreased by 1.8 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024.

#### **08 Information and Communication**

The monthly inflation for Information and Communication registered a rise of 0.4 percent for the month of September 2024 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in September 2024. This was mainly due to Information and communication services inflation that recorded a rise of 0.4 percent during the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024.

Information and Communication Equipment inflation that recorded a rise of 0.5 percent during the month of October 2024from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024 .

#### 09 Recreation, Sport and Culture

Monthly Recreation, Sport and Culture inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 same as that recorded in September 2024.

Newspapers, books & stationery inflation registered a drop of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent increase recorded in September 2024.

Cultural Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 same as that recorded in September 2024. Gardens and Pets Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 same rate recorded during the month of September 2024. Recreational services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 same rate recorded during the month of September 2024. Package Holidays Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 same rate recorded in September 2024. Other recreational goods inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 same rate recorded in September 2024.

#### **10 Education Services**

Monthly Inflation for Education Services registered an increase of 0.6 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024. This was due mainly due to Early Childhood and Primary Education Inflation that registered a rise of 1.0 percent for the month of October 2024 compared to 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024. In addition, Secondary Education Inflation registered a rise of 0.3 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded in September 2024. Post-secondary and non-tertiary education Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 the same rate recorded for the month of September 2024.

Tertiary education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 the same rate recorded for the month of September 2024 and Education not Defined by level inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 the same rate recorded in September 2024.

#### 11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services

The Monthly Inflation for restaurants and accommodation services increased by 0.7 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2024. This was due to Food and beverage serving services inflation that registered 0.3 percent rise for the month of October 2024 from the 0.2 percent rise registered in September 2024.

In addition, Accommodation services inflation registered an increase of 1.4 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.1 percent recorded for the month of September 2024.

#### 12 Insurance and Financial Services

Insurance and Financial Services Inflation registered a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of September 2024. This was mainly due to Insurance Inflation that registered a rise of 1.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.0 percent recorded during the month of September 2024.

Financial Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of October 2024 the same rate recorded for the month of September 2024.

## 13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2024. This was due to Other services n.e.c inflation that recorded a rise of 0.6 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 1.5 percent increase registered for September 2024.

In addition, Personal care Inflation recorded a rise of 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2024. Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2024 from the 1.6 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2024.

Social protection inflation recorded 0.0 percent in October 2024 same as that recorded for the month of September 2024.
