CONSUMER PRICE INDICES AND INFLATION DECEMBER 2025

1.1 Annual Headline Inflation

The Annual Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Uganda for the 12 months to December 2025 is 3.1 percent, the same rate registered in the year ended November 2025, see Table 1 and Figure 1 below.

Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation increased to 4.4 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 4.0 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. This is attributed to Irish potatoes (whose rate of price change is 2.3 percent compared to minus 5.9 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025), Cabbage (whose rate of price change is 35.7 percent compared to minus 0.6 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025), Passion fruits (whose rate of price change is 11.1 percent compared to minus 1.1 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025), Fresh cassava (whose rate of price change is 8.9 percent compared to 3.0 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025), Onions (whose rate of price change is minus 3.7 percent compared to minus 8.2 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025) and Green pepper (whose rate of price change is 25.2 percent compared to 5.4 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025).

In addition, Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation increased to 1.4 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 0.6 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. This is mainly due to Annual Solid Fuels Inflation that increased to 5.1 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 3.6 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025. Particularly, Firewood prices increased by 4.9 percent in December 2025 compared to 1.2 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025, Charcoal prices increased by 5.3 percent in December 2025 compared to 4.8 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025 and Petrol prices increased by 1.4 percent in December 2025 compared to minus 0.4 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025 and Water charges increased by 0.7 percent in December 2025 compared to 0.4 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025.

On the other hand, Annual Core Inflation registered 3.1 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 3.2 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025. This was mainly due to the Annual Services Inflation recorded at 4.0 percent in December 2025 compared to 4.2 percent registered in November 2025. Annual Passenger Transport by Air Inflation increased to 1.2 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to minus 2.0 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025 and Food and beverage Holiday package charges increased to 15.2 percent compared to 1.3 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. However, Annual Core Goods Inflation increased to 2.5 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 2.4 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025. This is attributed to Annual Dried Fish Inflation recorded at 2.4 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to minus 5.6 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025, Live chicken (whose rate of price change is 0.2 percent compared to minus 1.7 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025) and New Women Clothes (whose rate of price change is 2.7 percent compared to 2.1 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025).



1.2 Annual Average Headline Inflation

The Annual Average Headline Inflation for the Calendar Year 2025 increased to 3.6 percent compared to 3.3 percent recorded during the Calendar Year 2024. This was mainly due to Annual Average Core Inflation that increased to 3.8 percent for the Calendar Year 2025 compared to 3.6 percent recorded during the Calendar Year 2024.

1.3 Annual Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), the main drivers to the 3.1 percent Inflation were 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' Inflation that registered 3.5 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 2.9 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' Inflation registered 2.5 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 2.2 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. 'Health' Inflation registered 4.3 percent for the year ending December 2025 compared to 3.8 percent registered for the year ended November 2025. 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' Inflation registered 2.1 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 1.7 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. 'Insurance and Financial Services' Inflation registered 10.1 percent in the year ending December 2025 same rate recorded in the year ended November 2025 same rate recorded in the year ended November 2025. 'Education Services' Inflation registered 7.6 percent in the year ending December 2025 same rate recorded in the year ended November 2025. 'Information and Communication' Inflation registered 2.2 percent in the year ended November 2025 same rate recorded in the year ended November 2025. 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' Inflation registered 1.6 percent for the year ending December 2025 same rate recorded for the year ended November 2025.

However, 'Transport' Inflation registered 0.1 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 1.4 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025. 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' Inflation recorded 4.7 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 5.2 percent registered in the year ended November 2025. 'Clothing and Footwear' Inflation registered 2.6 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 2.7 percent recorded in the year ended November 2025. 'Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods' Inflation registered 2.1 percent for the year ending December 2025 compared to 2.2 percent registered for the year ended November 2025. 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' Inflation registered 2.0 percent in the year ending December 2025 compared to 2.1 percent registered in the year ended November 2025, see Table 3 below.

1.4 Monthly Inflation.

The Monthly Headline Inflation for December 2025 increased by 0.5 percent from 0.1 percent drop registered in November 2025, Table 4 below.

This was mainly due to monthly Core Inflation that increased by 0.5 percent in December 2025 from the 0.0 percent registered in November 2025. This was mainly due to monthly Services Inflation that increased by 0.7 percent in December 2025 from the 0.0 percent recorded in November 2025. In addition, monthly Core Goods Inflation increased by 0.3 percent in December 2025 from the 0.0 percent recorded in November 2025.

Monthly Food Crops and Related Items Inflation increased by 0.3 percent in December 2025 from the 0.9 percent drop recorded in November 2025. This was attributed to the increase in prices of cabbage by 32.0 percent in December 2025 from the 7.3 percent drop recorded in November 2025, passion fruits by 8.9 percent in December 2025 from the 9.2 percent rise recorded in November 2025, avocado by 9.5 percent in December 2025 from the 9.4 percent rise recorded in November 2025, green pepper by 15.2 percent in December 2025 from the 6.3 percent drop recorded in November 2025 and fresh leafy vegetables by 5.6 percent in December 2025 from the 4.8 percent drop recorded in November 2025.

Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation increased by 0.4 percent in December 2025 from the 0.2 percent drop registered in November 2025. This was mainly due to monthly firewood prices that increased by 7.0 percent in December 2025 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in November 2025. In addition, water charges increased by 0.3 percent in December 2025 from the 0.0 percent recorded in November 2025.

1.5 Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), monthly Transport Inflation increased by 1.7 percent in December 2025 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in November 2025. Monthly Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages Inflation increased by 0.5 percent in December 2025 from the 0.5 percent drop recorded in November 2025. Monthly Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation increased by 0.3 percent in December 2025 from the 0.1 percent drop recorded in November 2025. Monthly Health Inflation increased by 0.5 percent in December 2025 from 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2025. Monthly Restaurants and Accommodation Services Inflation increased by 0.3 percent in December 2025 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2025. Monthly Clothing and Footwear Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2025 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2025. Monthly Recreation, Sport and Culture Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2025 from 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2025. Monthly Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2025 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in November 2025. Monthly Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2025 from 0.5 percent rise recorded in November 2025. Monthly Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation increased by 0.1 percent in December 2025 from 0.5 percent rise recorded in November 2025.

However, monthly Education Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent in December 2025 same rate recorded in November 2025. Monthly Insurance and Financial Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent in December 2025 same rate recorded in November 2025. Monthly Information and Communication Inflation recorded 0.0 percent in December 2025 same rate recorded in November 2025.

1.6 Annual Headline Inflation by CPI Geographical Center

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups revealed that Kampala High Income group registered the highest Inflation at 4.2 percent for the year ending December 2025 compared to 4.4 percent recorded in November 2025. This was mainly driven by annual 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' inflation that registered 2.8 percent in December 2025 compared to 2.0 percent registered in November 2025. In addition, Annual 'Health' Inflation registered 4.2 percent in December 2025 compared to 3.6 percent registered in November 2025.

The second highest Annual Inflation was registered in Masaka at 3.7 percent for the year ending December 2025 compared to 4.2 percent recorded in November 2025. This was mainly driven by annual 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' Inflation that increased to 7.1 percent in December 2025 compared to 6.0 percent registered in November 2025. In addition, annual 'Health' Inflation increased to 7.2 percent in December 2025 compared to 6.9 percent registered in November 2025.

The least Annual Inflation was registered in Mbale Centre at 1.0 percent for the year ending December 2025 compared to 0.7 percent recorded in November 2025. This was mainly due to the annual 'Clothing and Footwear' Inflation that registered minus 0.1 percent in December 2025 compared to 2.0 percent registered in November 2025. In addition, Annual 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' Inflation registered minus 7.6 percent in December 2025 compared to minus 6.0 percent registered in November 2025.
