

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Foreword

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten baskets of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index was rebased from 2005/2006 to 2009/2010, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS IV) that was conducted from May 2009 to April 2010. During the rebasing exercise, Kampala was further decomposed into three baskets from the two that has been existing. In addition, Fortportal Centre was incorporated into the Index. The rebased CPI is now classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP). This is a shift from the Central Product Classification (CPC) that was used in the earlier series.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten baskets mentioned above and indices are available from the EA level.

Highlights of CPI, October 2017


1. Annual Inflation

The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending October 2017 has been recorded at 4.8 percent compared to the 5.3 percent reported during the year ended September 2017. This represents a 0.5 percentage point drop from that recorded during the year ended September 2017.


The drop in Annual Headline Inflation was due to the decrease in Annual core Inflation which is recorded at 3.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 4.2 percent for the year ended September 2017. This decrease was due to Services Inflation that registered 2.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 4.1 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. However, Other Goods Inflation increased to 4.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 4.2 percent recorded during the year ended September 2017.

In addition, the Annual Food Crops Inflation declined to 7.8 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 9.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The driver for the lower Annual Food Crops Inflation was Vegetables Inflation that declined to 6.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 8.5 percent registered during the year ended September 2017. In addition, Fruits inflation decreased to 9.7 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 10.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017.

The Annual Energy, Fuels and Utilities (EFU) Inflation increased to 14.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 10.6 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. This was due to Annual Inflation for solid fuels (charcoal & firewood) that increased to 25.0 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 15.0 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. However, Liquid Energy Fuels inflation declined to 5.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 5.5 percent recorded in September 2017. The one year series for the Headline Index and the Annual Inflation rates for the three major components are shown in Graph 1.



Graph 1: Uganda Headline Index and Annual Inflation rates for 3 major components, October 2016 – October 2017: (2009/10 = 100)





2. Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical Areas

Fort Portal registered the highest Annual Inflation of 8.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 though lower than 8.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. This drop was driven by Annual Inflation for Food and non-alcoholic beverages that decreased to 14.0 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 16.0 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. However, the Annual Inflation for Clothing and Foot wear increased to 11.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 11.1 percent registered during the year ended September 2017.

The second highest inflation was registered in Gulu at 7.0 percent for the year ending October 2017 though lower than the 8.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The main driver for this drop was Annual Inflation for Food and non-alcoholic beverages that registered 15.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 20.3 percent for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Restaurants & Hotels recorded an annual inflation of 6.0 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 8.9 percent registered for the year ended September 2017.

Arua registered the third highest annual inflation of 6.7 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 9.0 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. This was driven by Food and non-alcoholic beverages Inflation that decreased to 10.4 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 17.5 percent that was recorded during the year ended September 2017. In addition, Education Services inflation decreased to 4.2 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 11.4 percent recorded during the year ended September 2017. Annual Inflation for all the ten consumption baskets are shown in Graph 2 and Table 7.

3. Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation for October 2017 increased by 0.3 percent from the 1.0 percent rise recorded in September 2017. This was due to Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Inflation that increased by 1.8 percent during the month of October 2017 from the earlier rise of 3.7 percent recorded in September 2017. In addition, Monthly Core Inflation registered an increase of 0.2 percent in October 2017 from the 0.1 percent recorded in September 2017. Also, the Monthly Food Crops & Related Items Inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of October 2017 from the 4.6 percent rise recorded in September 2017. The detailed Monthly Inflation figures per Division are presented in Section 2 of the explanatory notes.


EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR THE INFLATION OF OCTOBER 2017

SECTION 1: Annual Inflation by COICOP¹ Divisions

The evolution of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for Food and non-alcoholic beverages dropped to 9.0 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 9.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The drop was due to a decline in Annual Food Inflation to 9.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 10.5 percent recorded during the year ended September 2017. The Annual Inflation for Non-Alcoholic Beverages registered a 0.6 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 0.4 recorded for the year ended September 2017. Graph 3 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Inflation from January 2016 to October 2017



Graph 3: Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation Trends; January 2016 – October 2017


02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Annual Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics increased to 1.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 0.7 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The increase was due to Annual Inflation of Tobacco that increased to 17.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 5.1 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. However, Alcoholic Beverages Inflation decreased to 0.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 0.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to the 0.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased to 1.8 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 1.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The increase was mainly attributed to Clothing Inflation that registered 2.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 1.3 percent for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Foot wear Inflation increased to 0.7 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 0.3 percent recorded during the year ended September 2017. Graph 4 shows the trends of clothing and Footwear from December 2014 to October 2017.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance & repair of the dwelling, Water Supply, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels

The Annual Inflation for Housing, water, electricity, Gas & other fuels increased to 7.6 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 6.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The increase was attributed to Inflation of Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels that recorded 16.7 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 11.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Annual Inflation for Maintenance and repair of the dwelling increased to 2.2 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 1.1 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. Annual Inflation for Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services relating to the dwelling increased to 9.9 percent for the year ending October 2017 the same rate recorded for the year ended September 2017.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools & Equipment for House, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance

The Annual Inflation for Furnishings, household equipment & routine household maintenance decreased to 5.8 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 5.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. This decrease was attributed to Annual inflation for Household Appliances that decreased to 8.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 9.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Tools and Equipment for House and Garden inflation decreased to 9.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 9.8 percent recorded for year ended September 2017. Also, Furniture & furnishings, Carpets & Other Floor Coverings inflation decreased to 3.5 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 4.0 percent recorded for year ended September 2017.

06 Health

The health Division comprises of Medical Products, Appliances & Equipment, Outpatient Services, and Hospital Services.

The Annual Inflation for Health decreased to 1.2 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 1.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. This decrease was attributed to Annual inflation for Hospital Services that decreased to 0.9 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 1.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Outpatient Services inflation decreased to 3.7 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 3.8 percent recorded for year ended September 2017. However,

Medical products, appliances & equipment inflation increased to 0.1 percent in October 2017 compared to 0.0 percent recorded for year ended September 2017.

07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Transport and Personal Equipment and Transport Services.

Annual Inflation for Transport increased to 0.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 0.1 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The increase was due to Purchase of vehicles inflation that rose to minus 13.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to minus 15.2 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. However, Annual Inflation for Operation of Personal Transport Equipment decreased to 9.7 percent for the year ending October 2017 from the 10.4 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017.

08 Communication

Communication includes Postal services, Telephones and Telefax equipment and Telephone and Telefax services.

The Annual Inflation for Communication registered minus 8.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to minus 8.1 percent recorded for year ended September 2017. The main driver was Telephone and telefax services that registered a minus 9.9 percent for the year ending October 2017 the same rate recorded for the year ended September 2017. Telephone and telefax equipment decreased to minus 3.3 percent for the year ending October 2017compared to minus 2.3 percent recorded in September 2017.

09 Recreation and Culture

Recreation and Culture comprises of Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment, Recreational & Cultural services, Newspapers, books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

Annual inflation for Recreational and Culture registered 7.0 percent for the year ending October 2017, compared to 7.1 percent recorded the year ended September 2017. This was attributed due to Recreational and Cultural Services Inflation that declined to 22.4 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 22.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Package holiday's inflation decreased to 6.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 6.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. Audio-visual, photographic & Information processing equipment Inflation registered 0.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 the same rate recorded for the year ended September 2017.

10 Education

Education comprises of Pre-Primary and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education not definable by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education declined to 2.6 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 7.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. This was attributed due to Pre-Primary and Primary Education Inflation that declined to 3.9 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 9.3 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Secondary Education inflation decreased to 1.6 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 7.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017.

11. Restaurants and Hotels

Restaurants and Hotels comprises of catering services and accommodation services. Restaurants and Hotels. Annual inflation for Restaurants and Hotels decreased to 5.4 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 6.0 percent registered for the year ended September 2017. The decrease was due to inflation of Catering services that registered 6.3 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 7.0 percent for the year ended September 2017. In addition, Accommodation services registered 3.4 percent for the year ending October compared to 3.8 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017.

12. Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous goods and services comprises of Personal Care such as hairdressing salons and personal grooming establishments, Personal Effects such as Jewellery, clocks and watches, Insurance and Other services such as passport fees, photocopying and radio announcements.

The Miscellaneous goods and services Inflation for the year ending October 2017 decreased to 1.3 percent compared to 1.5 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. The decrease was due to Inflation of Personal Effects n.e. that recorded an inflation of minus 1.1 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to minus 0.7 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017. In addition, the Annual Inflation for Personal Care decreased to 1.6 percent for the year ending October 2017 compared to 1.9 percent recorded for the year ended September 2017.

SECTION 2: Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic beverages rose by 0.1 percent for the month of October 2017 from the 1.7 percent increase recorded for September 2017. The increase was due to Food inflation that recorded 0.1 percent in October 2017 from the 1.8 percent rise recorded in September 2017. In addition, Non-alcoholic Beverages rose by 0.5 percent for the month of October 2017 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in September 2017.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco registered a 0.7 percent increase during the month of October 2017 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in September 2017. The increase was due to Monthly Inflation of Alcoholic Beverages that registered 0.1 percent in October 2017 from the 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2017. In addition, Tobacco inflation registered an increase of 7.2 percent in October 2017 from 5.6 percent rise recorded in September 2017.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear registered a 1.2 percent increase for the month of October 2017 from the 2.3 percent drop recorded in September 2017. This rise was mainly attributed to Clothing inflation that registered 1.3 percent during the month of October 2017 from the minus 2.6 percent recorded in September 2017. In addition, Footwear Monthly Inflation rose by 0.5 percent for the month of October 2017 from the minus 0.5 percent recorded in September 2017.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, water, electricity, Gas & other fuels, registered an increase of 1.2 percent in October 2017 from the 2.3 percent decrease recorded in September 2017. It was attributed to Electricity, Gas & other Fuels inflation registered a 2.8 percent increase in October 2017 from the 5.8 percent rise recorded in September 2017. In addition, Maintenance & repair of the dwelling monthly inflation registered a 1.1 percent increase for the month of October 2017 from the 0.0 percent inflation recorded for the month of September 2017.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, household equipment & routine household maintenance increased by 0.4 percent during the month of October 2017 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2017. The rise was due to Goods & services for routine household maintenance inflation of 0.4 percent from 1.8 percent increase recorded in September 2017. In addition, Household textiles Inflation registered an increase of 1.0 percent in October 2017, the same rate recorded for the month of September 2017.

06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health increased by 0.3 percent during the month of October 2017, the same rate recorded for the month of September 2017. The increase was mainly due to Monthly Inflation for Medical products, appliances & equipment that recorded 0.5 percent rise in October 2017 from 0.0 percent inflation recorded for the month of September 2017. In addition, Hospital services registered 0.4 percent rise for the month of October 2017 from the 0.0 percent inflation recorded for the month of September 2017.

07 Transport

Transport division registered a decrease in the monthly inflation 0.6 percent for the month of October 2017 from the 1.6 percent rise recorded during the month of September 2017. The driver for the decrease was the Monthly Inflation for Purchase of vehicles that registered 2.9 percent during the month of October 2017 from the minus 1.7 percent recorded for the month of September 2017. In addition, Operation of personal transport equipment monthly inflation dropped by 0.1 percent in October 2017 from the 5.4 percent increase recorded during the month of September 2017.

08 Communication

The Monthly Inflation for Communication increased to 0.2 percent during the month of October 2017 from the 0.5 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2017. The main driver for the increase was Telephone and telefax equipment inflation that recorded 0.6 percent during the month of October 2017 from the minus 1.9 percent registered in September 2017. However, Telephone & telefax services inflation and Postal services inflation registered a 0.0 percent inflation during the month of October 2017 respectively, the same rate recorded during the month of September 2017.

09 Recreation and Culture

Monthly inflation for Recreational and Culture increased by 0.3 percent during the month of October 2017 from the minus 0.3 percent recorded for the month of September 2017. The increase was mainly attributed to monthly inflation of Audio-visual, photographic & information processing equipment that rose by 0.5 percent for in October 2017 from the minus 0.4 percent in September 2017. In addition, Newspapers, books & stationery inflation rose by 0.5 percent during the month of October 2017 from the minus 0.1 percent recorded in September 2017.

10 Education

Monthly inflation for Education recorded a 0.3 percent increase during the month of October 2017 from the 0.0 percent inflation recorded for the month ended September 2017. This was mainly due to Secondary education that registered a 0.6 percent rise for the month of October 2017 from the 0.0 percent inflation recorded for the month ended September 2017.

11 Restaurants and Hotels

The Monthly Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels registered a 0.5 percent increase during the month of October 2017 from the 0.2 percent rise registered for the month September 2017. This was due to Catering Services that registered 0.5 percent rise during the month of October 2017 from the 0.2 percent increase recorded for the month of September 2017. In addition, Accommodation Services inflation registered an increase of 0.5 percent during the month of October 2017 from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of October 2017.

12 Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Miscellaneous goods and services Inflation for the month of October 2017 registered 0.1 percent increase from the 0.2 percent rise recorded for the month of September 2017. The rise was mainly attributed to Monthly Inflation for Other services n.e.c inflation that recorded 0.3 percent increase during the month of October 2017 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded for the month of September 2017. In addition, Personal effects n.e.c inflation registered a 0.6 percent rise during the month of October 2017 from the 1.3 percent rise recorded in September 2017.
