


UGANDA DEMOGRAPHIC AND HEALTH SURVEY 2022



Total Fertility Rate


Average number of Children per woman by UDHS survey years

Average number of years a new born can expect to live




Contraceptive Use

Percentage of currently married women age 15-49 who were using any method and those using mordern method of family planning.




Nutritional Status in Children

Percent of children aged 6-59 months




Basic Vaccination Coverage

Percent of children age 12-23 months vaccinated




Pregnancy Related Mortality Ratio (PRMR)

Maternal Mortaliy Ratio




Teenage Child Bearing

Percentage of women aged 15-19 who have had a live birth or who are pregnant with their first child




Antenatal Care Coverage
