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FOREWORD

This publication provides the monthly Consumer Price Indices for Uganda (Composite) and for the ten centres of Kampala High Income, Kampala Middle Income, Kampala Low Income, Jinja, Mbale, Masaka, Mbarara, Fortportal, Gulu and Arua. All the baskets are for the urban households.

The current Consumer Price Index has been rebased from 2009/2010 to 2016/2017, using weights derived from the Uganda National Household Survey (UNHS VI) that was conducted from July 2016 to June 2017. The rebased CPI is classified using international standards, referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP 2018). This is a shift from the COICOP 1999 that was used in the earlier series. COICOP 2018 is more detailed than the previous (1999) version, responding to the users' need for more detail, and addresses several other issues that required revision of the classification. The new COICOP of 2018 reflects the significant changes in goods and services in some areas, improved links of COICOP to other classifications, and addresses emerging statistical and policy needs of regional and international users.

At the elementary aggregate (EA) level, the indices are computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute higher level indices. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the ten centres mentioned above and rebased indices are available from July 2017 to date at EA level.



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ACRONYMS AND DEFINITIONS

COICOP: Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose, is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyse individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

CPI: Consumer Price Index - a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

CPI basket: A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

Elementary aggregate (EA): The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

Inflation: A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.

Jevons price index: An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

Laspeyres price index: The Laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

Outlet: The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue, a website etc. Also referred to as a "retail outlet", although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers

Outlier: A term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect

Price relative: A measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

Reference base: The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2016/17.

Weight: The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity or value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

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1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF UGANDA CPI FOR DECEMBER 2023

1.1 Annual Headline Inflation

The Annual Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Uganda for the 12 months to December 2023 is registered at 2.6 percent same rate registered in the year ended November 2023, see Table 1 below.

This is largely attributed to the Annual Core inflation that registered 2.3 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 2.0 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. The main driver to Annual Core Inflation was the Annual Services inflation that increased to 3.7 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 2.8 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. The increase in the Annual Services Inflation was due to Annual Passenger transport by road fares that increased by 4.3 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 4.4 percent registered in November 2023 and the Annual Passenger transport by air fares that registered minus 3.1 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 5.1 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. Annual Other Goods Inflation increased at a slower rate of 1.2 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 1.4 percent in the year ended November 2023. The main drivers were Annual Motorcycle prices which increased by 36.2 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 7.2 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. Prices of Rice increased by 1.3 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 1.7 percent in the year ended November 2023, and Smoked Tilapia prices increased by 11.0 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 4.2 percent in the year ended November 2023.

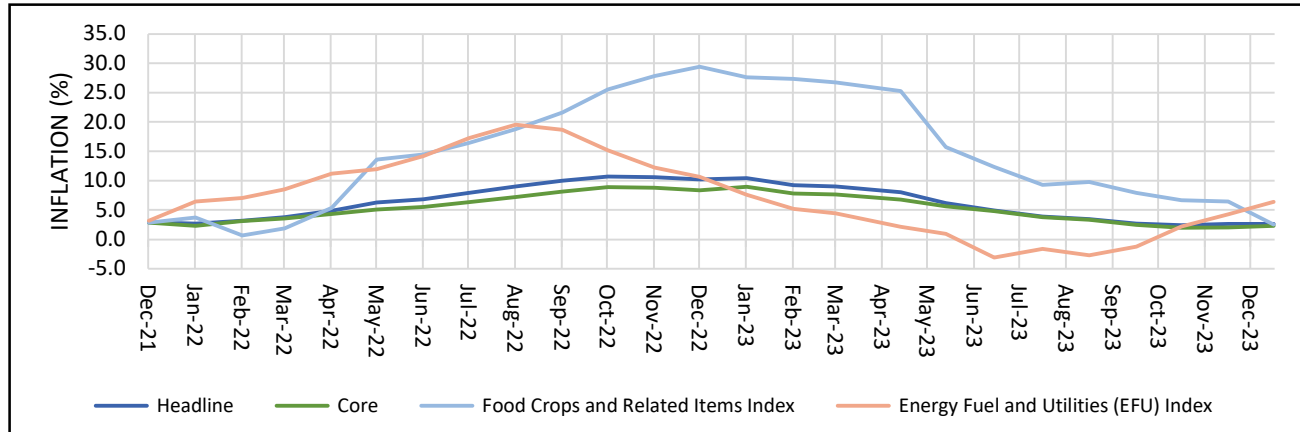
Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) inflation increased to 6.4 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 4.3 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. This was due to the increase in price of charcoal by 24.7 percent in December 2023 compared to 16.7 percent in November 2023, Petrol prices increased by 0.6 percent in December 2023 compared to minus 3.9 percent in November 2023.

Annual Food Crops and Related Items Inflation increased at a slower rate of 2.5 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 6.4 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. This was attributed to increase in the prices of Green Cabbage by 10.3 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 3.3 percent registered in November 2023. Dry Bean prices increased by 13.4 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 11.4 percent in the year ended November 2023. Watermelon prices increased by 19.4 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 0.1 percent recorded in the year ended November 2023, and Carrot prices increased by 28.8 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 18.0 percent registered in the year ended November 2023.

1.2 Annual Average Headline Inflation

The Annual Average Headline Inflation for the calendar year 2023 was recorded at 5.4 percent compared to 7.2 percent recorded during the calendar year ended 2022. This was mainly due to the Annual Average Core Inflation for the calendar year 2023 recorded at 4.7 percent compared to 6.0 percent during the calendar year ended 2022.

1.3 Annual Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), the main drivers to the registered inflation were 'Transport' inflation that increased to 2.4 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to minus 1.6 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' inflation increased to 4.6 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 3.6 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. 'Clothing and Footwear' inflation increased to 2.9 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 2.6 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. 'Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household' inflation increased to 1.9 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 1.7 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. 'Health' inflation increased to 4.5 percent for the year ending December 2023 compared to 4.4 percent for the year ended November 2023. 'Restaurants and Accommodation Services' inflation increased to 4.4 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 4.3 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. 'Information and Communication' inflation registered 2.1 percent for the year ending December 2023 the same rate recorded for the year ended November 2023. 'Education Services' inflation registered 6.1 percent in the year ending December 2023 the same rate recorded in the year ended November 2023 and 'Insurance and Financial services' inflation registered 5.5 percent in the year ending December 2023 the same rate recorded in the year ended November 2023.

However, 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' inflation slowed down to 3.6 percent for the year ending December 2023 compared to 4.1 percent for the year ended November 2023. 'Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods' inflation slowed down to 5.3 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 5.6 percent registered in the year ended November 2023. 'Recreation, Sport and Culture' inflation slowed down to 0.3 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 1.4 percent registered in the year ended November 2023 and 'Food and Non-alcoholic beverages' inflation slowed down to 0.1 percent in the year ending December 2023 compared to 2.1 percent registered in the year ended November 2023 as shown in Table 3 below.

1.4 Monthly Inflation.

The Monthly Headline Inflation for December 2023 increased by 0.1 percent compared to the 0.2 percent rise recorded in the month of November 2023 as shown in Table 4 below.

The main driver was the monthly Core inflation that increased by 0.5 percent in December 2023 compared to the 0.3 percent rise recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to monthly Services inflation that recorded 0.9 percent rise in December 2023 from the 0.6 percent rise recorded in November 2023. In addition, other goods inflation recorded 0.2 percent rise in December 2023 compared to 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Monthly Energy Fuel and Utilities (EFU) inflation increased by 0.7 percent in December 2023 compared to 0.4 percent rise registered in November 2023. The rise in EFU was mainly due to Charcoal inflation that increased by 7.0 percent in December 2023 compared to 3.2 percent rise recorded in November 2023. However Liquid energy fuels inflation decreased by 0.7 percent in December 2023 from the 1.0 percent rise recorded in November 2023. Specifically, Petrol prices decreased by 0.7 percent in December 2023 compared to the 1.9 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

However, Monthly Food Crops and Related items inflation decreased by 3.4 percent in December 2023 from the 0.3 percent drop recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to monthly Vegetables, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses inflation that decreased by 3.3 percent in December 2023 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in November 2023. Specifically, Onions prices decreased by 17.6 percent in December 2023 from the 11.6 percent drop recorded in November 2023, Beans inflation decreased by 4.1 percent in December 2023 from the 3.0 percent drop recorded in November 2023, Tomato prices decreased by 7.6 percent in December 2023 from the 23.9 percent rise recorded in November 2023 and Irish potato prices decreased by 6.6 percent in December 2023 compared to the 4.8 percent drop recorded in November 2023. In addition, monthly Fruits and Nuts inflation decreased by 3.4 percent in December 2023 from the 0.9 percent drop recorded in November 2023. Specifically, Mango prices decreased by 14.5 percent in December 2023 from 13.4 percent drop recorded in November 2023.

1.5 Monthly Inflation by COICOP Divisions

According to the Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP), the main drivers to the registered monthly inflation were; Transport inflation which increased by 3.0 percent in the month of December 2023 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded in November 2023. Monthly Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels inflation increased by 0.6 percent in December 2023 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in November 2023. Monthly Clothing and Footwear Inflation increased by 0.7 percent in December 2023 from the 1.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023. Monthly Personal care, social protection and miscellaneous goods inflation increased by 0.7 percent in December 2023 from 0.3 percent rise registered in November 2023. Monthly Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics Inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2023 from 0.3 percent rise recorded in November 2023. Monthly Health inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2023 from the 2.1 percent rise registered in November 2023. Monthly Recreation, sport and culture inflation increased by 0.2 percent in December 2023 from the 1.2 percent rise recorded in November 2023. While monthly Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Inflation increased by 0.1 percent in December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

However, Monthly Restaurants and Accommodation Services inflation decreased by 0.2 percent in December 2023 from 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023. Monthly Food and Non- Alcoholic Beverages Inflation decreased by 1.3 percent in December 2023 compared to 0.3 percent drop recorded in November 2023, see Table 6 below.

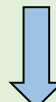

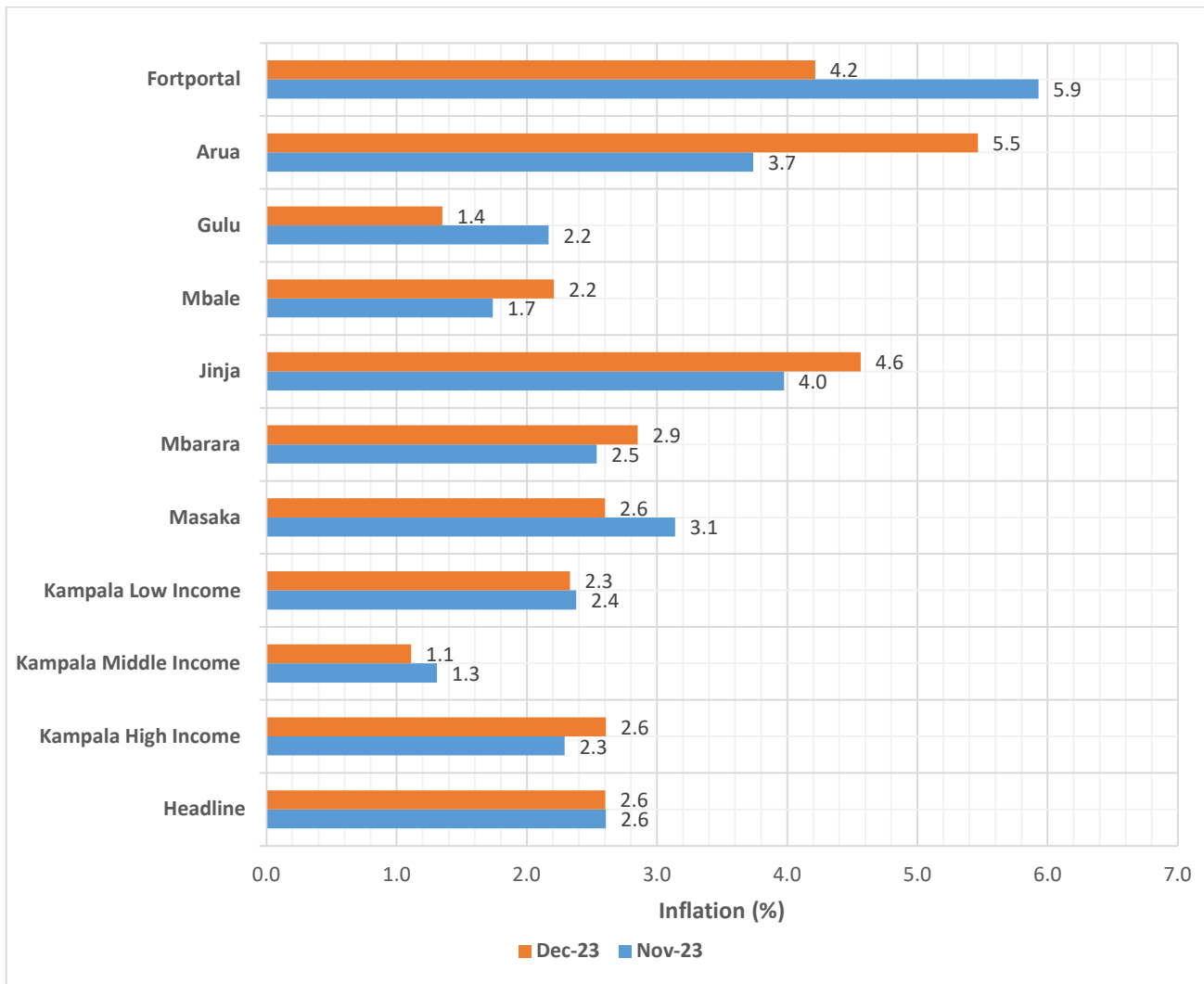
1.6 Annual Headline Inflation by Income Groups and Geographical areas

Analysis by geographical areas and income groups revealed that Arua registered the highest inflation of 5.5 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 3.7 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly driven by Annual 'Food and non-alcoholic beverages' inflation that increased to 4.3 percent in December 2023 compared to 1.4 percent registered in November 2023. In addition, Annual 'Transport' inflation increased to 5.3 percent in December 2023 compared to minus 0.8 percent registered in November 2023, see Figure 2 below.

The second highest Annual Inflation was registered in Jinja Centre at 4.6 percent for the year ending December 2023 compared to 4.0 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly driven by Annual 'Transport' inflation that increased to 7.9 percent in December 2023 compared to 1.1 percent in November 2023. In addition, annual 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other fuels' inflation increased to 7.4 percent in December 2023 compared to 5.5 percent registered in November 2023.

The least annual inflation was registered in Kampala Middle Income at 1.1 percent for the year ending December 2023 compared to 1.3 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to the annual inflation for 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' that decreased to minus 2.0 percent in December 2023 compared to 0.5 percent registered in November 2023. In addition, annual 'Alcoholic beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' inflation decreased to 1.5 percent in December 2023 compared to 2.8 percent in November 2023.

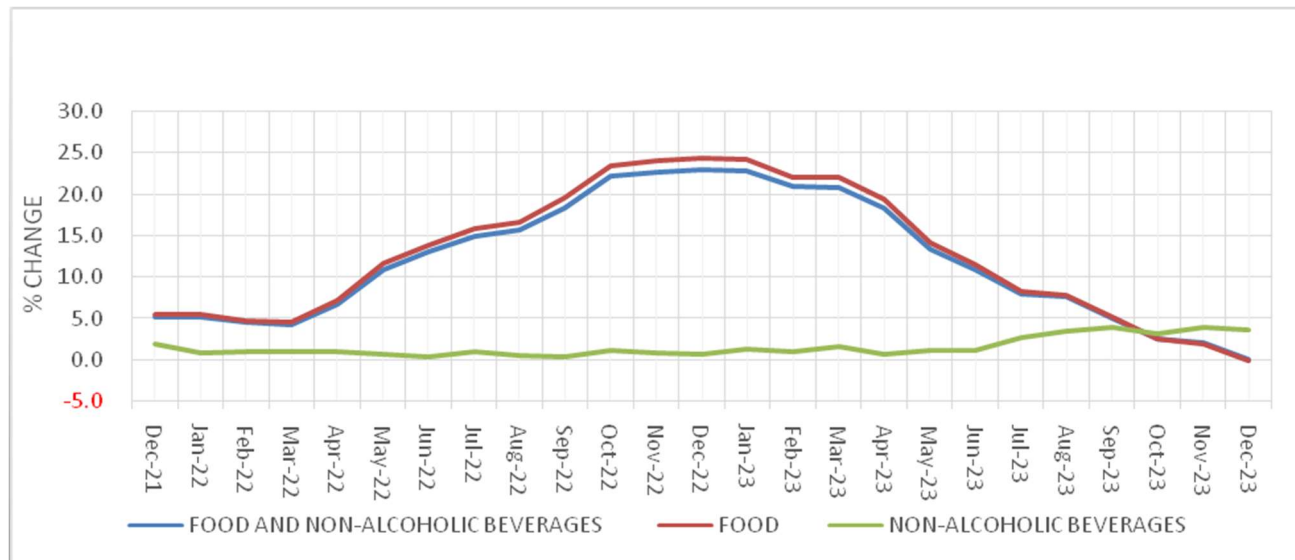
01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages registered 0.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 2.1 percent registered in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Food Inflation that registered 0.0 percent in December 2023 compared to 2.0 percent recorded in November 2023.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation registered 3.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 3.9 percent recorded in November 2023.

Figure 4 shows the trends of Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages Annual Inflation from December 2021 to December 2023.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics was registered at 3.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 4.1 percent recorded in November 2023. This was attributed to the Annual Alcoholic Beverages Inflation that registered 2.7 percent in December 2023 compared to the 3.5 percent registered in November 2023.

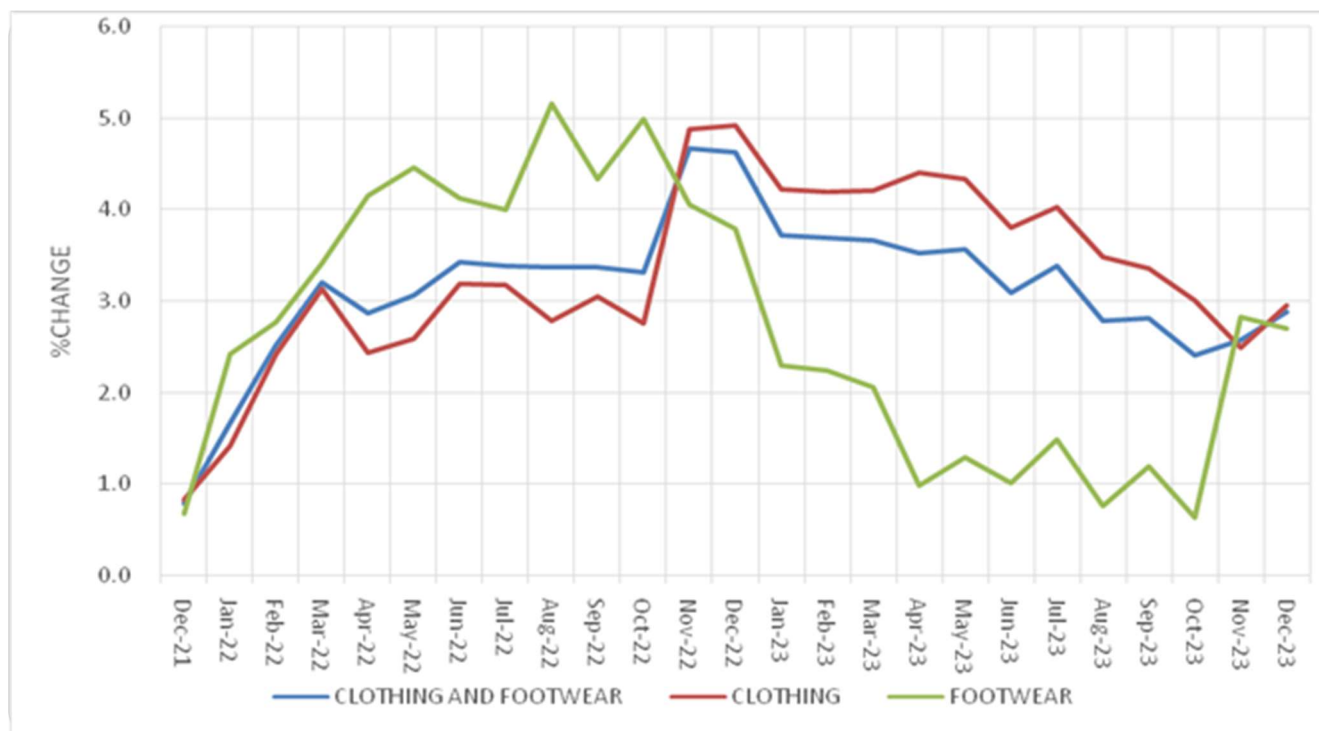
However, Annual Tobacco Inflation registered 12.3 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 9.7 percent recorded in November 2023.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Inflation for Annual Clothing and Footwear registered 2.9 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 2.6 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly attributed to Footwear Inflation that registered 2.7 percent in December 2023 compared to 2.8 percent recorded in November 2023. However, Clothing Inflation registered 2.9 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 2.5 percent recorded in November 2023.

Figure 5 shows the trends of Clothing and Footwear Inflation from December 2021 to December 2023.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels comprises of Actual Rentals for Housing, Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling, Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels.

The Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels was registered at 4.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 from the 3.6 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly attributed to Annual Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling inflation that registered minus 5.4 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to minus 4.6 percent recorded in November 2023.

Annual Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling Inflation registered 9.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 10.1 percent recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Annual Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation registered 1.4 percent in December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

Annual Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation registered 8.5 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 6.2 percent recorded in November 2023.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

This Division Comprises of Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets, Household Textiles, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils, Tools and Equipment for House & Garden, and Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance.

The Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance registered 1.9 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.7 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Household textiles that registered 7.0 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 5.4 percent recorded in November 2023. Annual Furniture, Furnishings, and Loose Carpets Inflation registered 4.3 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 4.2 percent recorded in November 2023. Annual Goods & Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation registered 1.2 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 0.8 percent in November 2023. Annual Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation registered 0.8 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.0 percent recorded in November 2023. Annual Tools and Equipment for House & Garden Inflation registered 0.9 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.3 percent registered in November 2023.

However, Annual Household Appliances Inflation registered minus 1.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 0.5 percent recorded in November 2023.

06 Health

The Health Division comprises of Medicines and Health Products, Outpatient Care Services, Inpatient Care Services and Other Health Services.

The Inflation for Health registered 4.5 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 4.4 percent registered in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Inpatient Care Services Inflation that registered 13.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 13.7 percent recorded in November 2023. The Annual Medicine and Health Products Inflation registered 4.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 3.7 percent recorded in November 2023.

However, Annual Other Health Services Inflation registered minus 5.0 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to minus 4.8 percent recorded in November 2023. Annual Outpatient Care Services Inflation registered 2.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

07 Transport

Transport division comprises of Purchase of vehicles, Operation of Personal Transport Equipment and Passenger Transport Services.

The Inflation for Transport registered 2.4 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to minus 1.6 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly attributed to Annual Passenger Transport Services Inflation that registered 2.2 percent in December 2023 compared to minus 4.6 percent recorded in November 2023.

Annual Purchase of vehicles Inflation registered 2.1 percent in December 2023 compared to minus 0.7 percent recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Annual Operation of Personal Transport Equipment inflation increased to 2.7 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.3 percent rise registered in November 2023.

08 Information and Communication

Information and Communication includes Information and Communication Equipment, and Information and Communication Services.

The Annual Inflation for Information and Communication registered 2.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to the Information and Communication Services Inflation that registered 3.0 percent for the 12 months to November 2023 compared to 2.5 percent in October 2023.

However, Annual Information and Communication Equipment Inflation that registered 0.3 percent in December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

09 Recreation, Sport and Culture

Recreation, Sport and Culture comprises of Other Recreational Goods, Gardens and Pets, Recreational Services, Cultural Services, Newspapers, Books & Stationery and Package Holidays.

The Annual Inflation for Recreation, Sport and Culture registered 0.3 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.4 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Gardens and Pets that registered 9.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. Annual Package Holidays registered 2.0 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 2.3 percent recorded in November 2023. Annual Newspapers, Books & Stationery Inflation registered 0.8 percent in December 2023 compared to 1.0 percent recorded in November 2023.

However, Annual Other Recreational Goods Inflation registered 0.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. Annual Recreational services registered 1.7 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.6 percent recorded in November 2023.

However, Annual Cultural services Inflation registered minus 1.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 1.1 percent recorded in November 2023.

10 Education Services

Education Services comprises of Early Childhood and Primary Education, Secondary Education, Post-secondary non-tertiary education, Tertiary Education and Education Not Defined by level.

The Annual Inflation for Education Services registered 6.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Early Childhood and Primary Education inflation that registered 10.4 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. Annual Secondary Education Inflation registered 3.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. Annual Post-Secondary Non-Tertiary Education registered 2.7 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

However, Annual Education Not Defined by level registered minus 0.1 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. Annual Tertiary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services

Restaurants and Accommodation Services comprises of Food and Beverage Serving Services and Accommodation Services.

Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Accommodation Services registered 4.4 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 4.3 recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Accommodation Services Inflation that registered 7.6 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 7.5 percent recorded in November 2023.

Annual Food and Beverage Serving Services Inflation registered 3.0 percent in December the same rate recorded in November 2023.

12 Insurance and Financial Services

Insurance and Financial Services comprises of Insurance and Financial Services.

The Annual Insurance and Financial Services Inflation for the 12 months to December 2023 registered 5.5 percent the same rate recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Financial Services Inflation that registered 6.1 percent in December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

However, Annual Insurance Services Inflation registered minus 0.1 percent for the 12 months to November 2023 compared to minus 0.2 percent recorded in November 2023.

13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods comprises of Personal Care, Personal Effects n.e.c, Social Protection and Other services n.e.c.

The Annual Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation for the 12 months to December 2023 registered 5.3 percent compared to 5.6 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Annual Personal Effects NEC Inflation registered 11.7 percent for the 12 months to December compared to the 10.6 percent recorded for November 2023.

Annual Other Services n.e.c Inflation which recorded 3.2 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 3.4 percent recorded in November 2023.

Annual Personal Care Inflation that registered 4.0 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 compared to 4.6 percent recorded in November 2023.

However, Annual Social Protection Inflation registered 12.2 percent for the 12 months to December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

ANNEX 2: MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

The evolution of Monthly Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs, reference is made to table 4.

01 Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Monthly Inflation for Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages decreased by 1.3 percent for the month of December 2023 compared the 0.3 percent drop recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to the monthly Food Inflation that decreased by 1.4 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.4 percent drop recorded in November 2023.

However, Non-Alcoholic Beverages Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.5 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

02 Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics

The Monthly Inflation for Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics recorded 0.2 percent increase during the month of December 2023 from the 0.3 percent rise registered for the month of November 2023. This was due to Tobacco Inflation that increased by 1.9 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.5 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Alcoholic beverages Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

03 Clothing and Footwear

The Monthly Inflation for Clothing and Footwear registered 0.7 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Clothing Inflation that increased by 1.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.7 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Footwear Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 2.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

04 Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels

The Monthly Inflation for Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other fuels increased by 0.6 percent for the month of December 2023 from 0.2 percent drop recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels Inflation recorded 1.7 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.0 percent recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.3 percent drop registered in November 2023.

Actual Rentals for Housing Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

However, Maintenance, Repair And Security Of The Dwelling Inflation decreased by 0.7 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.3 percent drop recorded in November 2023.

05 Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance increased by 0.1 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of November 2023.

This was mainly due to Household Textiles that increased by 1.6 percent for the Month of December 2023 from the 1.2 percent rise recorded for November 2023. Furniture Furnishings, and Loose Carpets inflation increased by 0.3 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

Tools and Equipment for House and Garden Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.1 percent rise registered in November 2023.

However, Household Appliances Inflation decreased by 0.9 percent during the month of December 2023 from 0.3 percent drop recorded for the month of November 2023. Goods and Services for Routine Household Maintenance Inflation recorded 0.0 percent in December 2023 from the 0.2 percent drop recorded in November 2023. Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils Inflation decreased by 0.1 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to the 0.5 percent rise registered in November 2023.

06 Health

The Monthly Inflation for Health increased by 0.2 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to the 2.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to, Medicines And Health Products Inflation that increased by 0.3 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.3 percent drop registered in November 2023.

Inpatient care services inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 10.8 percent rise recorded for the month of November 2023. Outpatient Care Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate registered in November 2023.

In addition, Other Health Services Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.0 percent registered in November 2023.

07 Transport

Transport Inflation increased by 3.0 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to the 0.7 percent rise recorded for the month of November 2023. This was mainly due to Passenger Transport Services inflation that increased by 5.9 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.0 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Purchase of vehicles Inflation increased by 2.9 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.1 percent drop recorded in November 2023.

However, Operation of personal transport equipment registered 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.6 percent rise registered during the month of November 2023.

08 Information and Communication

The monthly inflation for Information and Communication registered by 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.1 percent recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Information and Communication Equipment inflation that increased by 0.1 percent during the month of December 2023 compared to 0.0 percent recorded in November 2023.

Information and communication services inflation that recorded 0.0 percent during the month of December 2023 compared to 0.1 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

09 Recreation, Sport and Culture

Monthly Recreation, Sport and Culture inflation increased by 0.2 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.2 percent rise recorded in November 2023. This was mainly due to Recreational services Inflation that increased by 0.5 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.3 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

In addition, Newspapers, books & stationery inflation increased by 0.4 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to 0.6 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

Gardens and Pets Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of November 2023 from the 2.7 percent rise registered during the month of November 2023. Cultural Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.9 percent rise recorded in November 2023.

Other recreational goods inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 1.2 percent drop recorded in November 2023.

However, Package Holidays Inflation decreased by 0.2 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.8 percent rise recorded in October 2023

10 Education Services

Monthly Inflation for Education Services recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded in October 2023. This was mainly due to Early Childhood and Primary Education Inflation that registered 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023. Secondary Education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of December the same rate recorded in November 2023. Post-secondary and non-tertiary education Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of November 2023.

In addition, Tertiary education Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of November 2023. Education not Defined by level inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded in November 2023.

11 Restaurants and Accommodation Services

The Monthly Inflation for restaurants and accommodation services decreased by 0.2 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to the 0.1 percent rise recorded for the month of November 2023. This was mainly due to Food and beverage serving services inflation that decreased by 0.3 percent for the month of December 2023 from the 0.2 percent rise registered in November 2023.

However, Accommodation services inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of November 2023.

12 Insurance and Financial Services

Insurance and Financial Services Inflation recorded 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded during the month of November 2023. Insurance Inflation increased by 0.1 percent for the month of December 2023 compared to the 0.2 percent drop recorded in November 2023.

However, Financial Services Inflation registered 0.0 percent for the month of December 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of November 2023.

13 Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods

Personal Care, Social Protection and Miscellaneous Goods Inflation increased by 0.7 percent during the month of December 2023 compared to the 0.3 percent rise recorded for the month of November 2023. This was mainly due to Personal Effects n.e.c Inflation that recorded 3.7 percent during the month of December 2023 compared to the 0.0 percent recorded for the month of November 2023.

Personal care Inflation increased by 0.1 percent during the month of December 2023 compared to 0.4 percent rise recorded for the month of November 2023.

Other services n.e.c Inflation recorded 0.0 percent in December 2023 the same rate recorded for the month of November 2023.
