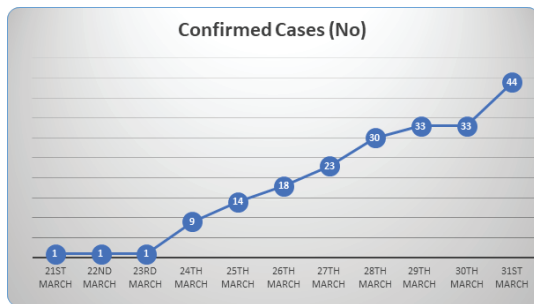

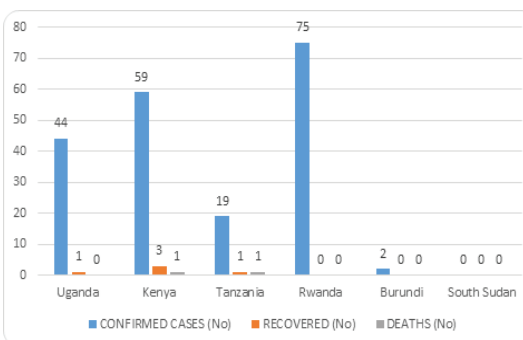
NATIONAL LOCKDOWN CONTINUES TO BITE...

- Only RDCs are authorised to give permission for private vehicles. Only emergencies will be given priority.
- H.E the President has warned that politicians found distributing food will be arrested.
- Government will consider distributing food to some vulnerable groups of people after thorough identification.
- A curfew remains in force for everyday from 7:00 pm to 6:00 am.

As of March 31, 2020 11 more confirmed cases were registered bringing a cumulative total of 44. The 11 cases who are all members of Watoto Children's Choir have been under institutional quarantine after returning from the USA and UK on March 20, 2020.



- Burundi registered its first COVID_19 confirmed cases on March 31, 2020 after two citizens tested positive.
- South Sudan has not registered any case so far.
