PERFORMANCE AT A GLANCE

Net revenue decreased by 19.5 percent to Shs 4.8 trillion in Q3 2020/21 from Shs 6.0 trillion registered in Q2 2020/21.

Tax revenue was the biggest contributor to Central Government revenue accounting for 88.7 percent of total Central Government revenue in Q3 2020/21

Despite a 45.1 percent decline in the Grants, from Shs 600.1 billion in Q2 2020/21 to Shs 329.5 billion in Q3 2020/21, they accounted for 6.8 percent of the total revenue in Q3 2020/21.

Central Government expenditure (including transfers to Local Government and donor disbursements) decreased by 17.1 percent to about Shs 7.4 trillion in Q3 2020/21 from Shs 8.9 trillion registered in Q2 2020/21, see *Table 1*.

Central Government recurrent expenditure (excluding transfers to Local Government) decreased by 1.4 percent to Shs 3.78 trillion in Q3 2020/21 from 3.84 trillion registered in Q2 2020/21 while development expenditure (excluding transfers to Local Government) decreased by 7.4 percent to Shs 2.3 trillion in Q3 2020/21 in comparison to Shs 2.4 trillion recorded in Q2 2020/21.

Transfers to Local Government decreased by 14.6 percent to Shs 881.2 billion in Q3 2020/21 from Shs 1.03 trillion recorded in Q2 2020/21.

Donor disbursements declined by 70.7 percent to Shs 473.1 billion in Q3 2020/21 from Shs 1.6 trillion disbursed in Q2 2020/21.

INTRODUCTION

The principal function of government is to provide public services such as law and order, defense, education, health, and welfare to its citizens as well as redistribute income. To its operations and provide manage accountability to its citizens, government needs an accounting and reporting system. Two kinds of reporting systems are used; fiscal accounting and statistical reporting. A government fiscal accounting system is primarily designed to fulfill the requirements fiscal accountability, which demonstration of compliance in the use of resources allocated by the budgetary process. The Government Finance Statistics (GFS) reporting system is concerned with measuring the effectiveness of spending and the sustainability of fiscal policies. It deals with the stocks and flows in Revenue, Expense, Assets and Liabilities. Therefore Government Finance Statistics (GFS) measure the financial activities of the government in an economy.

Purpose of GFS

- To provide input to the compilation of Government Consumption Estimates (GCE) for the General Government in the compilation of Gross Domestic Product (GDP).
- Used in the computation of the Supply and Use tables.
- Used in analysis of operations of specific levels of government and transactions between levels of

- government as well as the entire general government.
- To provide summary information on the overall performance and financial position of the general government.

Coverage

The bulletin covers Central Government which comprises Ministries, Departments, Agencies and Referral Hospitals. Currently, this includes 23 Ministries, 302, Agencies; 16 Referral hospitals; 38 Missions abroad and 10 Public universities.

GFS COMPILATION PRACTICES

The GFS compilation is in line with the current Government Finance Statistics Manual (GFSM 2014).

Data sources

The primary source of data is the Budget department as run from the IFMS at the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development (MoFPED), Department for Development Assistance and Regional Cooperation (DARC) at MoFPED and Uganda Revenue Authority.

Classification

The classification of transactions is consistent with internationally accepted standards, guidelines and best practices. Data is classified in accordance with the new chart of accounts issued in 2018, which is aligned to the classifications of GFSM 2001/14.

Basis of recording

The general government sector uses a modified cash basis of recording in their accounting and budgeting systems with all its transactions recorded on cash except for interest which is on accrual basis of accounting.

Valuation

All general government transactions are valued at market prices. In respect to the stock of assets, no valuation has been done. This has therefore not enabled compilation of the Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC) estimates.

Periodicity

The bulletin is produced quarterly with a time lag of one (1) quarter.

ANALYSIS OF GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS

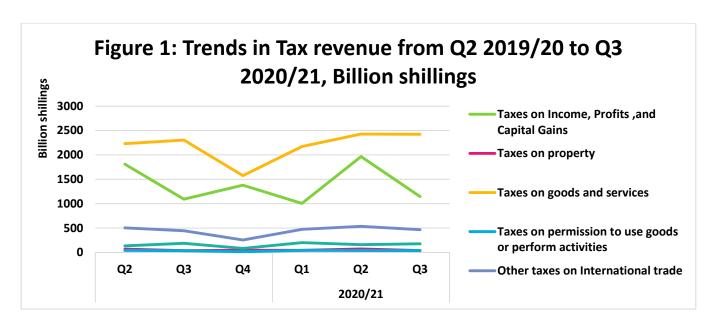
Central Government Revenue

In Quarter three (Q3) of 2020/21, the Net Central Government revenue (excluding tax refunds) was Shs 4.8 trillion compared to Shs 6.0 trillion collected in the Quarter two (Q2) of 2020/21. This was a 19.5 percent decrease in the net quarterly central government revenue in Q3 compared to Q21 2020/21, see *Appendix Table 1a (i &ii)*.

During the period under review, the largest contributor to the net revenue was tax revenue accounting for 88.7 percent while non-tax revenue contributed only 11.3 percent to the total revenue.

Within the tax revenue items, taxes on goods and services was the largest contributor, accounting for 50.1 percent of revenue in Q3 2020/21.

Among the non-tax revenue items, grants contributed 6.8 percent and other revenues contributed 4.4 percent to the total revenue, See *Figure 1* below *and Appendix Tables 1a(i&ii)*.



From the graph above, for the period under review all categories of taxes registered a decline from Q2 2020/21 to Q3 2020/21 with

the exception of Other taxes that registered an increase of 11.1 percent between Q2 2020/21 and Q3 2020/21.

Central Government Expenditure

The total Central Government expenditure including transfers to Local government and donor disbursements was about Shs 7.4 trillion in Q3 2020/21. This was a decrease of 17.1 percent in expenditure in Q3 2020/21 compared to Shs 8.9 trillion recorded in in Q2 2020/21, See Table 1 above, Appendix Tables 1f(i&ii) and Appendix Tables 1j(i&ii)

The Central Government Recurrent expenditure excluding local Government transfers for Q3 2020/21 was Shs 3.78 trillion, representing a 1.4 percent decrease from Shs 3.85 trillion for Q2 2020/21. Central Government recurrent expenditure including grants to local government was Shs.4.5 trillion in Q3 2020/21, which was a decline from Shs.4.7 trillion recorded in Q2 2020/21, see *Appendix Table 1d (i)*, 1g(i).

The Central Government development expenditure excluding transfers to Local Government for Q3 2020/21 was Shs 2.3 trillion, registering a 7.4 percent decrease from Shs 2.4 trillion recorded in Q2 2020/21. Central Government development expenditure including Local Government transfers for Q3 2020/21 was Shs. 2.4 trillion of which Shs. 181.4 billion was transfers to Local government, see *Appendix Table 1h (i)*.

The donor disbursements for Q3 2020/21 were Shs 473.1 billion, reflecting a 70.7 percent decrease from Shs 1.6 trillion recorded in Q2

2020/21. The low disbursement was attributed to the poor absorption of the funds that had been earlier disbursed. The performance of most donor projects in the previous quarters was affected by the current COVID-19 pandemic. The largest portion of donor disbursements made in Q3 2020/21 were for Defence affairs and services accounting for 18.6 percent, followed by Medical products and appliances with 18.2 percent, and Transport accounting for 13.0 percent, see *Appendix Table* 1j(i), 1j(ii)).

Analysis of functional and economic classification of, recurrent expenditure (including transfers to local Government) and development expenditure has been assessed as follows.

Functionally, the largest recurrent Expenditure for GOU in Q3 2020/21 was on the General Public services sector, accounting for 46.8 percent of which, most of the expenditure for **Public** debt was transactions(interest accrued) representing 24.2 percent, while Executive, legislative and other general services represented 12.9 percent. The Defense and Public order and safety subsectors were the second, where each accounted for 8.3 percent of the total Government recurrent expenditure.

Transfers to Local government accounted for 15.6 percent of total Government recurrent expenditure in Q3 2020/21, see Appendix Table 1g (i&ii).

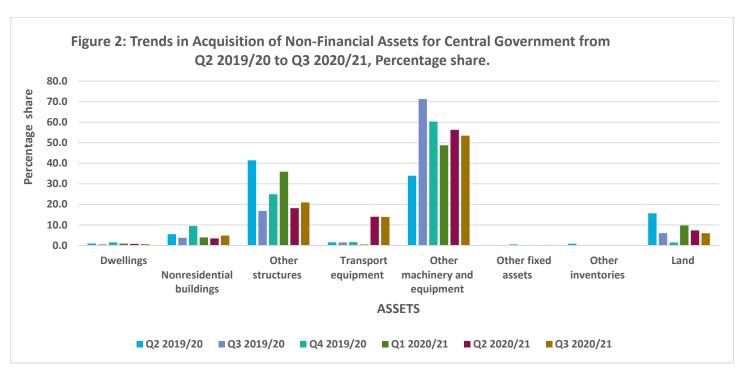
The largest development expenditure was spent on Defence, accounting for 40.3 percent. This was followed by Economic affairs with 37.4 percent of total development expenditure and this was mainly attributed to expenditure in the transport sector (30.8 percent).

The percentage contribution of Health expenditure to the overall development expenditure decreased to 0.7 percent in Q3 2020/21 compared to a 1.0 percent recorded in Q2 FY 2020/21, See *Appendix Table 1 h (i&ii)*).

Economic analysis of the GOU expenses showed that total expense for Q3 2020/21 was Shs 4.8 trillion (including transfers to Local Government) while Shs 5.1 trillion was

expensed in Q2 2020/21. This was a 5.4 percent decrease in the GOU expense in Q3 2020/21 in comparison to Q2 2020/21, see *Appendix Table 1b(i)*).

In Q3 2020/21, Expenditure on acquisition of Non-Financial Assets was Shs. 2.1 trillion, of which Shs 1.4 trillion was spent on Machinery and equipment which accounted for 67.4 percent. This was followed by expenses to acquire Buildings and structures of Shs 544 billion, representing 26.4 percent. About Shs. 122.6 billion shillings was spent on acquisition of Land and this accounted for 5.9 percent, see *Figure 2 below and Table 1c (i) and 1c(ii)*).
